1. What are eight ways Christ's priesthood is better than Aaron's?
Answer: (1) Christ is after the order of Melchisedec. (2) His priesthood is eternal. (3) He brings a better hope and perfection. (4) He was called by an oath. (5) He does not die. (6) He is sinless. (7) He offered a perfect sacrifice. (8) He is the Son of God.
2. In what two Old Testament passages (book and chapter) is Melchizedek mentioned?
Answer: Genesis 14; Psalm 110
3. Who was Melchizedek? Was he Shem or Christ or a real human king of Abraham's day who is used as a type?
Answer: A real king of Abraham's day
4. What does "Salem" mean?
Answer: Peace
5. What is the meaning of "Jerusalem"?
Answer: Righteousness - peace
6. List three verses that prove that Christ had no beginning?
Answer: Isaiah 9:6; Micah 5:2; John 1:1; Colossians 1:17; 1 John 1:3
7. What does "surety" mean?
Answer: One who pledges to stand for a debt
8. What are four ways in which the New Covenant is better than the Old?
Answer: (1) The Old Covenant was a covenant of works and condemnation, the New is a covenant of grace and blessing. (2) The Old Covenant pertained to earthly things, the New pertains to heavenly. (3) The Old was temporal, the New is eternal. (4) The Old Covenant pertained only to Israelites; the New is offered to all men.
9. What does "save to the uttermost" mean?
Answer: Entirely, completely, utterly
10. What does it mean that Jesus was "separate from sinners"?
Answer: He has no sin.
11. What does it mean that Jesus is "harmless"?
Answer: He has never wronged God or man.
12. In what way was the Old Covenant defective?
Answer: It could not make man righteous and reconcile him with God.
13. According to Hebrews 9:10-12, what are three things that we find in the New Covenant that were not in the Old?
Answer: (1) God writes His laws on men's hearts. (2) Every man personally knows the Lord. (3) Sins are entirely forgiven.
14. Who is the recipient of the New Covenant?
Answer: Israel

15. What are three national aspects of the New Covenant, according to Jeremiah 31?
Answer: (1) Israel will be regathered. (2) Israel will be blessed and enlarged. (3) The city of Jerusalem will be glorified.
16. When will the New Covenant be established, according to Jeremiah 33?
Answer: When the Messiah is exalted and Judah will be saved and Jerusalem shall dwell safely
17. What New Testament passage says the New Covenant will be fulfilled in Israel when Christ comes?
Answer: Romans 11:25-27

Answer: They participate in the spiritual blessings.

Answer: The ten commandments

Answer: Satisfy a debt
25. What did the mercy seat typify?
Answer: Christ's atonement whereby God's law is propitiated
26. How many cherubims were over the ark of the covenant?
Answer: Two
27. What Old Testament prophet described the cherubims in some detail?
Answer: Ezekiel
28. Who was allowed to enter the holy of holies?
Answer: The high priest
29. How often and on what occasion could he enter?
Answer: Once a year on the day of atonement
30. What verse in the New Testament says, "by his own blood he entered in once having obtained eternal redemption for us"?
Answer: Hebrews 9:12
31. What is a term that the New Testament uses for eternal security?
Answer: Eternal redemption

32. What is the meaning of “redemption”?
Answer: To ransom, to purchase with a price
33. What does it mean that Christ offered Himself “without spot” unto God?
Answer: He was sinless and offered Himself in the place of sinners.
34. What verse in Hebrews mentions all three members of the Trinity?
Answer: Hebrews 9:14
35. What does it mean that Christ provided redemption for the transgressions that were under the first testament?
Answer: God has saved men in all ages on the basis of Christ’s sacrifice.
36. What verse says God calls men through the Gospel?
Answer: 2 Thessalonians 2:14
37. What does “remission” mean?
Answer: Forgiveness
38. What Old Testament verse is referenced in Hebrews 9:22?
Answer: Leviticus 17:11
39. What two things were required for the atonement?
Answer: Blood and death

Answer: Romans 6:23
