Answer: He uses “words” plural.

Answer: He mentioned the prophets and the apostles.
7. What are six things that arose in the 19th century in fulfillment of the prophecy in 2 Peter 3?
Answer: Theological modernism; humanism; unitarianism; Darwinian evolution; Marxism; Freudianism

21. How does Peter describe the destruction of the present heavens and earth?

Answer: They will be burned up.

22. Peter teaches that Bible prophecy should have what two affects upon the believer?

Answer: (1) It should produce holy conversation. (2) It should produce watchfulness.
