Answer: (1) Enduring trials (2) Waiting on answered prayer (3) Waiting on God's sanctifying work (4) Waiting on Christ's return

3. What is the Greek word for "brotherly kindness"?

Answer: Philadelphia

4. What is the Greek word for the highest love?

Answer: Agape

5. What verse uses this word to describe God's love for the world?

Answer: John 3:16

6. In what passage is this love defined (book and chapter)?

Answer: 1 Corinthians 13

Answer: Denying the Lord’s atonement
21. In what way can it be said that Christ “bought” false teachers who deny Him?
Answer: He paid their sin debt and thus made it possible for them to be saved
22. In what way do the false teachers in 2 Peter 2 promise liberty?
Answer: They promise liberty to sin.
23. What is the Greek for “feigned words” and what is the English word that is derived from this?
(2 answers)
Answer: Plastos - plastic
24. How does Paul describe feigned words in Romans 16?
Answer: Good words and fair speeches
25. What is the “way of Balaam”?
Answer: Covetousness

28. What are three ways that Peter confirmed the Genesis account of Sodom and Gomorrah? (3 answers)
Answer: (1) They were burned into ashes. (2) They were judged because of ungodliness. (3) Lot was delivered.
