1. What is the theme of 2 John?

Answer: The necessity of standing in the truth and separating from error.

2. What was the elect lady's dangerous situation?

Answer: She was in danger of being led astray by false teachers.

3. John's love was grounded in and defined by what?

Answer: Truth

4. In what verse did Jesus say, "As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent"?

Answer: Revelation 3:19

5. What verse says the love of God is to keep His commandments?

Answer: 1 John 5:3

Answer: That we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward

12. How does John emphasize the importance of "doctrine" in his 2nd epistle?

Answer: He mentions it three times

13. How does John emphasize the necessity of abiding in the doctrine of Christ?

Answer: He says those who do not abide in the doctrine of Christ have not God.

14. What is the theme of 3 John?

Answer: The support of preachers and the abuse of pastoral authority

15. What was John's greatest joy?
Answer: That his children walk in truth
16. What does it mean to "bring forward on their journey"?
Answer: To meet their needs

Answer: Fellow helpers
18. What is the name of the pastor who was abusing his authority?
Answer: Diotrephes
