Answer: To be cleansed from a conscience that does not have full assurance of salvation in Christ
5. What verse says baptism is not putting away the filth of the flesh but a good conscience toward God?
Answer: 1 Peter 3:21
6. Why is it that the believer can hold the profession of his faith without wavering?
Answer: Because God is faithful and true to His Word
7. What does “provoke” mean?
Answer: Inciting, stirring up
8. What verse says the church is the pillar and ground of the truth?
Answer: 1 Timothy 3:15
9. What verse warns about neglecting the assembly?
Answer: Hebrews 10:25
