1. What is the meaning of the name “Ezekiel”?

Answer: God will strengthen

2. The River Chebar was a canal that branched off of what river?

Answer: Euphrates

3. How does Ezekiel’s prophecy begin?

Answer: The vision of the glory of God and the cherubims

4. What chapters contain God’s witness against the nations?

Answer: Eze. 25-32

5. In what chapter of Ezekiel do we find the prophecy of the valley of dry bones?

Answer: Eze. 37

6. What chapters of Ezekiel contain the prophecy of the millennial temple and the millennial Jerusalem?

Answer: Eze. 40-48

7. The cherubims are mentioned at least how many times in Scripture?

Answer: 95

8. What chapter of Ezekiel says Satan was the anointed cherub?

Answer: Eze. 28

9. What are the four faces of the cherubims?

Answer: man, ox, lion, eagle

10. What kind of hands do they have?

Answer: Man’s

11. How many wings do they have?

Answer: Four

12. How quickly do they move?

Answer: Like lightning

13. What do the cherubims transport on a platform over their heads?

Answer: God’s throne

14. What does “the sword of the Lord” signify in Ezekiel 21?

Answer: Judgment on Judah at the hands of the Babylonians

15. Who wields the sword?

Answer: God

16. What is “furbished”?

Answer: polished

17. What does Eze. 21:10 mean when it says “it contemneth the rod of my son”?

Answer: the rod is the king of Judah of the line of David; the Lord’s sword will cut him off

18. In the prophecies against the nations in Ezekiel, what is the main reason that is given for God’s judgment on them?

Answer: Their hatred of Israel and participation in her destruction

19. The prophecies of the nations look ahead to what prophetic event?

Answer: The day of the Lord

20. What do the “isles” refer to in Ezekiel 27?

Answer: Nations far from Israel

21. In what four ways are the prophecies of historical Tyre an allegory?

Answer: (1) Historical Tyre illustrates the world with its evil characteristics. (2) The judgment on historical Tyre points to the judgment on the nations in the day of the Lord. (3) The lamentation of Tyre points to the lamentation of Babylon in Revelation 18. (4) The lamentation over the king of Tyre is an allegory of the fall of Satan.

22. The prophecy that Tyre’s dust would be scraped was fulfilled by what king in what century?

Answer: Alexander the Great - 4th century BC

23. What does Eze. 28:12 mean when it says Lucifer “sealed up the sum”?

Answer: He was the highest of created beings

24. What is the meaning of “Lucifer”?

Answer: Shining one

25. What is the meaning of “the anointed cherub that covereth”?

Answer: Lucifer was the highest cherub

26. How does Ezekiel describe Satan’s pride?

Answer: His heart was lifted up

27. What was the cause of his pride?

Answer: His beauty

28. What chapter of the Bible describes Satan's final judgment?

Answer: Revelation 20

29. The prophecy of the valley of dry bones describes Israel's return to the land in what two stages?

Answer: (1) Spiritually dead (2) Spiritually converted

30. How do we know that the temple described at the end of Ezekiel is a literal temple?

Answer: The precise measurements and the unique architectural terms

31. In what three chapters of the Bible is the third temple mentioned?

Answer: Mt. 24; 2 Th. 2; Re. 11

32. The prophecy of Ezekiel 40-48 is identified as pertaining to what people?

Answer: The house of Israel

33. What verse says church-age saints will appear with Christ in glory?

Answer: Colossians 3:4

34. What passage (2 verses) says church-age saints will rule the nations with a rod of iron?

Answer: Revelation 2:26-27

35. Other than Ezekiel, what five prophets mention the restoration of sacrifices in the millennial kingdom?

Answer: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Zechariah, Haggai, Malachi

36. The river of life will flow out of what gate in the millennial temple?

Answer: East

37. The river heals what sea?

Answer: Dead Sea

38. Fishermen will cast nets from what place on the west side of the sea?

Answer: Engedi
