1. What is the meaning of “Isaiah”?

Answer: Jehovah is salvation

2. What is the first reason Isaiah is called “a little Bible”?

Answer: both Isaiah and the Bible have 66 chapters, and both are further divided into 39 chapters and 27 chapters

3. What are the two major divisions of Isaiah?

Answer: 1-39 Warnings; 40-66 Grace, comfort, hope

4. Isaiah prophesied during the reigns of what four kings?

Answer: Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah

5. What is the “deutero-Isaiah” doctrine?

Answer: The book of Isaiah was written by two men, one wrote Isa. 1-39 and another wrote Isa. 40-66

6. What passage (book and chapter) in the New Testament quotes both major parts of Isaiah and attributes both to the prophet Isaiah?

Answer: John 12

7. How do we know that the prophecies of Isaiah are for the whole world?

Answer: Isaiah calls on all the world to hear

8. What verse in Isaiah says, “Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth”?

Answer: Isa. 45:22

9. How does the revelation of God in the Bible prove that it is divinely inspired?

Answer: Man could not conceive of such a God

10. What are three names by which God is revealed in Isaiah as the all powerful?

Answer: Lord of hosts, Almighty, God of everlasting strength

11. What verse in Isaiah describes God as omniscient?

Answer: Isa. 40:28

12. What is the Hebrew word for “Redeemer”?

Answer: Gawal or Gaal

13. Who was the redeemer in the book of Ruth?

Answer: Boaz

14. In what verse in Isaiah does God say, “My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure”?

Answer: Isa. 46:10

15. In what verse in Isaiah does God say, “For my thoughts are not your thoughts”?
Answer: Isa. 55:8
16. How many times is the Hebrew *hesed* used in Isaiah?
Answer: 13 times
17. What are five ways *hesed* is translated in English?
Answer: lovingkindness, mercy, goodliness, kindness, pity
18. What verse in Isaiah says, “if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them”?
Answer: Isa. 8:20
19. What verse in Isaiah says, “the word of our God shall stand forever”?
Answer: Isa. 40:8
20. What verse in Isaiah says, “but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word”?
Answer: Isa. 66:2
21. In what chapter of Isaiah does God invite all sinners to partake of His salvation “without money without price”?
Answer: Isa. 55
22. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies Israel’s rejection of the Messiah?
Answer: Isa. 53
23. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies Israel’s covenant with the Antichrist?
Answer: Isa. 28
24. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies the nations coming to Jerusalem to hear God’s Word?
Answer: Isa. 2
25. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies the lifting of the veil of deception from the earth?
Answer: Isa. 25
26. What three chapters in Isaiah prophesy the shaking of the heavens and the earth?
Answer: Isa. 13; 24; 34
27. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies the Messiah beat, spit upon, and his beard plucked?
Answer: Isa. 50
28. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies the Messiah buried in a rich man’s tomb?
Answer: Isa. 53
29. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies God coming with chariots of fire to punish the earth?
Answer: Isa. 66

30. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies the Messiah sitting on David's throne forever as the mighty God?

Answer: Isa. 9

31. What three chapters in Isaiah prophesy the Messiah bringing salvation to the Gentiles?

Answer: Isa. 11; 42; 49

32. What two chapters of Isaiah prophesy the earth filled with the knowledge of God?

Answer: Isa. 11; 26

33. What chapter in Isaiah prophesies that the desert will blossom as the rose?

Answer: Isa. 35

34. What chapter of Isaiah prophesies that the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped?

Answer: Isa. 35

35. What two chapters prophesy God's judgment on the final Babylon and her head, Lucifer?

Answer: Isa. 13-14

36. What chapters of Isaiah are a historical interlude?

Answer: Isa. 36-39

37. In what chapter of Isaiah does God say that Israel "swear by the name of the Lord, and make mention of the God of Israel, but not in truth, nor in righteousness"?

Answer: Isa. 48

38. In what chapter of Isaiah does God liken Israel to Sodom and Gomorrah?

Answer: Isa. 1

39. What is "the remnant" that is mentioned many times in Old Testament prophecy?

Answer: The remnant of Jews who believe in God during the apostasy

40. In Isaiah 1, God commands Israel to give ear to what?

Answer: The law of our God

41. Why did God reject Israel's religious rituals?

Answer: They were taught by the precept of men

42. In what two ways were Israel's hands full of blood?

Answer: They sacrificed their children to Molech; they murdered the prophets.

43. In what chapter of Isaiah does God say, "I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people"?

Answer: Isa. 65

44. In what verse in Isaiah does God invite men to come to Him and reason with Him?

Answer: Isa. 1:18

45. What chapter of Isaiah prophesies that the nations will beat their swords into plowshares?

Answer: Isa. 2

46. What is the general meaning of “the last days”?

Answer: That period of time during which God will complete His plan for mankind

47. When do “the last days” begin and end?

Answer: From Christ’s first coming to the final judgment

48. The term “mountain” in Isaiah 2:1-4 refers to what?

Answer: A kingdom, a nation

49. The entire period of “the day of the Lord” lasts from what event to what event?

Answer: The Tribulation to Christ’s kingdom

50. What do the “trees,” “towers,” “and walls” depict in Isaiah 2?

Answer: Everything pertaining to man’s pride and idolatry

51. What do the seraphim cry in Isaiah 6?

Answer: Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

52. What five men in the Bible saw God’s throne?

Answer: Moses, Isaiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, John

53. What is the difference between the face and wings of the seraphims and the cherubims?

Answer: The seraphims have one face and 6 wings, and the cherubims have 4 faces and 4 wings

54. What effect did the vision of the seraphims have upon Isaiah?

Answer: He saw himself as a man of unclean lips

55. How was Isaiah cleansed from his uncleanness?

Answer: A coal from the altar was applied to his lips

56. What did this signify?

Answer: Christ’s atonement

57. How did Isaiah respond to the cleansing and the call of God, “Whom shall I send??

Answer: He said, “Here am I, send me.”

58. What message was Isaiah called to preach?

Answer: A message of judgment on Israel

59. What would happen to Israel’s land?

Answer: There will be a great forsaking in the midst of the land

60. How did God promise in this prophecy that Israel would not be completely destroyed?

Answer: He said a tenth shall return.

61. What are three reasons for God's judgment on the nations?

Answer: Sin, pride, hatred of Israel

62. How do the prophecies of the nations in Isa. 13-27 have a double fulfillment?

Answer: They depict God's judgment on ancient nations and His judgment on nations in the last days.

63. In Bible prophecy, "island" means what?

Answer: The ends of the earth far from Israel

64. Who are the "treacherous dealers" of Isaiah 24?

Answer: The Antichrist and those associated with him

65. How many times are earthquakes mentioned in Revelation?

Answer: Seven

66. How is Jesus proven to be Jehovah God by comparing Isa. 24:23 with Mt. 25:31?

Answer: Isaiah 24 says the LORD of hosts will reign in Zion, and Matthew 25 says Jesus will reign.

67. What are four lessons about God's Word in Isa. 25:1?

Answer: God's Word is "thy counsels"; God's Word is of old; God's Word is faithful; God's Word is truth

68. What is "wine on the lees"?

Answer: Old wine in which the yeast and particles settle to the bottom

69. When will death cease?

Answer: In the new heaven and the new earth

70. Why is the destruction of Moab repeated in Bible prophecy?

Answer: Moab is an example of the destruction of God's enemies.

71. How do we know that Isa. 26:2 does not describe Israel today?

Answer: Israel today is not righteous and does not believe the truth.

72. What is the excellency of Carmel and Sharon?

Answer: This is the most fruitful part of Israel

73. What chapter of Isaiah prophesies "streams in the desert"?

Answer: Isa. 35

74. What is happening in Israel today is _____, not _____.

Answer: manmade - divine

Answer: Isa. 35

Answer: Isa. 35
