Course: Bible Prophecy as Light on the 21st Century

Class Description: Bible prophecy is a major theme of the New Testament faith, and it is God's will that every believing individual, home, and church be well educated in the events pertaining to Christ's return. Bible prophecy is given for light, not for confusion or for debate. It gives the child of God a right worldview.

It explains Darwinism, communism, secular atheism, humanism, globalism, New Age, apostate Christianity, theological liberalism, worldly Christianity. It tells us where we are on God's calendar, what we are to be doing today, and what is in the future. It explains the phenomena of our times, such as the Covid pandemic and Israel's return to the land. It gives the child of God a pilgrim mindset. It makes him different from conservative unsaved people.

This package consists of a 10-hour video series plus a book containing the course text. It focuses on Bible prophecies that pertain to the end of the church age: 2 Timothy 3-4; Psalm 2; 2 Peter 3; the Rapture; Ezekiel 37; the Third Temple; Daniel's 70 Weeks; Christ's promise in Matthew 28:18-20; and the Parable of the Laborers in Matthew 20.

The course begins with a study of the foundational principle for understanding Bible prophecy, which is the normal-literal method of interpretation.

Texts Required for class:

The King James Bible

Bible Prophecy as Light on the 21st Century by David W. Cloud

Outcomes—At the end of the course, all students will be able to:

1. Understand the importance of studying Bible prophecy.
2. Gain a deeper knowledge of key passages that deal with prophecy pertaining to today.
3. Interpret Bible prophecies correctly and biblically using the normal-literal method of interpretation.
4. Have a greater excitement watching God work and fulfilling His prophecies in these last days.

Evaluation—the class grade will be broken up in the following manner:

Validation:

Outcome 1. Students read *Bible Prophecy as Light on the 21st Century* completely and answer all review questions.

Outcome 2. Students take diligent notes during class over important topics regarding Bible prophecy.

Outcome 3. Students take a test over the material covered in class and read outside of class.

Outcome 4. Students write a Bible Study Lesson over one of the Bible prophecy passages discussed in this course.

There are two options for taking this class. They are the following:

- **Slower Pace-15 Week Option**

This option takes a total of 15 weeks and has regular assignments once a week.

- **Advanced-Two Week Option**

This option takes a total of 2 weeks and has regular assignments six times every week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

Details of Course Assignments:

- **Reading Assignments**

Students are given reading assignments each day and must complete the assignments along with answering the corresponding questions before each lesson begins.

- **Bible Study Lesson Project**

The student should choose one of the prophecy passages discussed in this course and write a Bible Study Lesson teaching that passage and the Bible prophecy it discusses. The student should include an outline and a script of exactly what he would say for the Bible Study Lesson. The student must make sure to include the summary and meaning of the prophecy as well as practical applications that will help those he is teaching.

- **Test**

There will be one test taken at the end of the semester. Including certain review questions and potentially additional important information in the reading, the test will be short answer questions. The test is used to measure how much the student has retained over the course. The test will be cumulative over the whole book.
