Course: Jews in Fighter Jets

Class Description: Students will gain knowledge on the past, present, and future history of God's chosen people, the Jews. With this knowledge, the student will be able to see God's handiwork and protection. The student will also be made aware of many traditions, customs, and false teachings, surrounding the Jews and their nation Israel.

Texts Required for class:

Jews in Fighter Jets: Israel Past, Present, and Future by David W. Cloud, 555 pages, 2018 Edition

Outcomes—At the end of the course, all students will be able to:

1. Thoroughly understand the Biblical history of the Jews during the “silent years” between the Old and the New Testament.
2. Recognize many false teachings that have come out of Israel's rejection of Jesus Christ and their love for their own vain traditions.
3. Learn the fascinating miracles of how modern Israel became a nation again in fulfillment of the Word of God.
4. Have a clearer understanding of the true spiritual state of Israel as they gear up for the coming of the Antichrist.
5. Grow in knowledge of the future of Israel and correctly interpret the Bible prophecies for the coming age.
6. Gain a deeper love for God's chosen people, and a deeper burden to see more Jews saved.

Validation:

Outcome 1. Students read *Jews in Fighter Jets* completely and answer all review questions.

Outcome 2. Students take diligent notes during class over the past, present, and future history of the Jews.

Outcome 3. Students memorize verses pertaining to the history of Israel.

Outcome 4. Students take tests and quizzes over the material covered in class and read outside of class.

Outcome 5. Students write three articles on specific events that pertain to the Nation of Israel and Bible prophecy.

There are two options for taking this class. They are the following:

- **Slower Pace-15 Week Option**

This option takes a total of 15 weeks and has regular assignments three times every week: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

- **Advanced-One Month Option**

This option takes a total of 4 weeks and has regular assignments six times every week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. The assignments for this option combine two of the assignments from the slower pace option into one day so that the student can complete the class in a month.

Details of Course Assignments:

- **Reading Assignments**

Students are given reading assignments for most days and must complete the assignments along with answering the corresponding questions before each lesson begins.

- **Quizzes (10)**

Quizzes will be given on Mondays, except following an exam or test, (*this applies only for the slower pace option*). These quizzes will **only** be verse quizzes. The student must write out the verses completely.

- **Articles (3)**

Each article must be over a topic that has been covered in the book *Jews in Fighter Jets*. Article #1 will be over a topic covered in the “Past” section of the book; Article #2 will cover a topic included in the “Present” section; and Article #3 will cover a topic from the “Future” section. The student is able to select any topic that has been covered in the designated section of the book.

He must research additional information regarding that topic from at least 3 other sources. He will then record his findings in a 3-5-page, double-spaced paper. His paper must include an introduction, body, conclusion, and bibliography page. The introduction must include why this topic is important to Israel’s history, and the conclusion must use Scripture to show how the selected event fulfills or will fulfill Scripture.

- **Tests (4)**

There will be a total of four tests taken during this semester. Including certain review questions and additional important information in the reading, the tests will include a section of short answer questions. The tests are used to measure how much the student has retained over the course. Tests 1 and 3 will not be cumulative, while the midterm (Test 2) and final (Test 4) will cover previously learned material as well as any new material.
