## Course Syllabus

**Course:** The Satanic Attack on Sacred Music

**Credit Hours:** 2

**Class Description:** This large course consists of a book and a video series with about 17 hours of teaching, packed with photos, graphics, audio and video clips. We study the Bible's most important teachings on the issue of music. We look at the amazing changes that are happening among fundamental Baptists and the role of contemporary music in these changes. We also learn about many dangers represented by Contemporary Christian Music. We show that these dangers are not "out there" somewhere; they are a very near danger to the churches.

### Texts Required for class:

The King James Bible

*The Satanic Attack on Sacred Music* by David W. Cloud

**Outcomes**—At the end of the course, all students will be able to:

1. Discern soft rock and learn how chords are used in contemporary music to create an unresolving sound and "feel."
2. Understand why contemporary music always transforms churches.
3. Examine the great changes in Southern Gospel today.
4. Observe the role of good congregational singing in protecting a church from CCM.
5. Understand how the most important issue is to have spiritual homes and spiritual churches.

**Evaluation**—the class grade will be broken up in the following manner:

### Validation:

**Outcome 1.** Students read *The Satanic Attack on Sacred Music* completely and answer all review questions over what was read.

**Outcome 2.** Students take diligent notes during class over important topics regarding the music issue.

**Outcome 3.** Students memorize foundational verses regarding music.

**Outcome 4.** Students take tests over the material covered in class and read outside of class.

**There are two options for taking this class. They are the following:**

- **Slower Pace-15 Week Option**

This option takes a total of 15 weeks and has regular assignments two times every week: Tuesday and Thursday.

- **Advanced-One Month Option**

This option takes a total of 4 weeks and has regular assignments six times every week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. On occasion, the student must complete two days' worth of material from the slower paced option in order to complete the course in one month.

**Details of Course Assignments:**

- **Reading Assignments**

Students are given reading assignments for most days and must complete the assignments along with answering the corresponding questions over what was read before each lesson begins.

- **Quizzes (5)**

Quizzes will be given on five Tuesdays (*for the slower-paced option*) scattered throughout the semester. These quizzes will **only** be verse quizzes.

- **Tests (4)**

There will be a total of four tests taken during this semester. Including certain review questions, and potentially extra important information just found in the reading, the tests will consist of a section of short answer questions. The tests are used to measure how much the student has retained over the course. Tests 1 and 3 will not be cumulative, while the Midterm and Final will cover previously learned material as well as the new material.
