

## PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES BANNED BY MAJOR SOCIAL MEDIA MOGULS ~ By David Cloud

In an historic move with far-reaching implications, the Ipresident of the United States has been banned by Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, Twitch, Pinterest, Reddit, TikTok, Discord, and Snapchat. Though President Trump doesn't have an account with most of these social media platforms, they are banning such things as videos of Trump speeches and unofficial Trump forums. The e-commerce platform Shopify shut down shops run by the Trump campaign and the Trump organization. At least four banks have closed Trump accounts: Bank United and Professional Bank in Florida and Signature Bank and Deutsche Bank in New York, and Bill de Blasio, the mayor of New York City, said the city will terminate business contracts with Trump ("Banks Close Trump's Accounts," Epoch Times, Jan. 22, 2021). Trump has lost two realestate brokers, and the Professional Golf Association announced that it would not allow Trump to host the 2022 PGA Championship ("Florida-based bank," The Washington Post, Jan. 22, 2021).



Twitter suspends accounts which violate the Twitter Rules



Parler, the free speech alternative to Twitter, has been removed from Google Play (Android) and the Apple store. Amazon shut down all of Parler's servers on Jan. 10, and Parler's CEO John Matze has not yet been able to find a company that is willing to host the social media. He is also receiving death threats.

The chairwoman for Mozilla, the creator of the Firefox web browser, called for additional actions to alter "the dangerous dynamics" of the internet and to silence "disinformation campaigns" by "bad actors," meaning those who refuse to toe the Leftist line.

This is totalitarian language that flies in the face of the U.S. Bill of Rights.

Where were these people when Black Lives Matter and Antifa caused \$2 billion in destruction across America?

We're never been great fans of President Trump and have disagreed with a lot of things that he has said. In fact, he has not taken a salary from the government and has probably harmed his personal business empire by his effort to make America great again. He has most definitely done *many* good things for America. He is convinced the election was stolen, believes he has evidence of it, and has complained loud and long about it. But he *did not* call for an attack on the Capitol Building. Rather, he publicly and plainly condemned it. He cannot be compared to Leftist ideologues who have openly called for violence, even against the president himself. And Trump's supporters aren't insurgents. Whatever part they had in the attack on the Capitol Building on Jan. 6, it was out of character.

The anti-American totalitarianism and gross hypocrisy of the moguls behind the major social media platforms is evident in this move.

The assault on speech accelerates ... Friday morning, CNN announced that it is working to force the Fox News Channel off the air and run this company out of business. A number of prominent Democrats, including officeholders, support that effort. CNN staffers have already contacted the six major cable carriers in this country, the companies that carry our signal into your home, and pressured them to drop Fox News" (Tucker Carlson Tonight, Jan. 8, 2021).

Donald Trump, Jr., warned, "We are living in Orwell's 1984. Free-speech no longer exists in America. It died with big tech and what's left is only there for a chosen few" (@DonaldJTrumpJr, Jan. 9, 2021).

U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said, "Silencing speech is dangerous. It's un-American. Sadly, this isn't a new tactic of the Left. They've worked to silence opposing voices for years. We cannot let them silence 75M Americans. This isn't the CCP" (@mikepompeo, Jan. 9, 2021)

Liberal reporter Michael Tracey also sees clearly where this is heading. "The new corporate authoritarian liberalleft monoculture is going to be absolutely ruthless--and in 12 days it is merging with the state. This is only the beginning, The most extreme, coordinated corporate censorship offensive in modern history and liberals/leftists are in a mindless celebratory stupor. Pathetic shills" (@mtracey, Jan. 9, 2021).

Kate Ruane, a senior legislative counsel at the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), released a statement condemning Facebook and Twitter's decision to suspend the president's account, warning of "unchecked power."

#### All of that is true, but God's people have far more light than the world. Concerning such times, God's Word says,

"Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity. For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb. 



A merica's fundamental problem is not systemic racism; it is systemic wickedness. And we are convinced that the root problem is the nation's corrupt, worldly, lukewarm churches. That is the root problem in the black communities and in every community. "Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away" (2 Timothy 3:5). "Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent" (Revelation 2:4-5).

Since the church is the pillar and ground of the truth (1 Timothy 3:15), the New Testament church is the most important institution on earth. The greatest need of every community and every nation is New Testament churches. Nothing can take its place. But in fulfillment of Bible prophecy, the vast majority of churches today are entirely apostate. I think of Roman Catholic, Greek Orthodox, Unitarian, Seventh-day Adventist, Jehovah's Witness, Mormon, World Council of Churches and all of their affiliates, and many others.

What about "evangelicals" such as Southern Baptists? Most are leavened with rock & roll worldliness and cultural liberalism (they are friends with, and conformed to, the world, which is spiritual adultery), no repentance easy believism, charismatic and contemplative mysticism, *nothing* versions (e.g., The Message, the New Living, the Good News), textually corrupt versions (e.g., the NIV, the ESV), kingdom now theology, the social justice gospel, positivism and judge not-ism. They have renounced "separatism" even though it is a clear Bible doctrine.

But what about "fundamentalists"? A few exceptions notwithstanding, most of the old non-denominational

fundamentalist churches are New Evangelical today. The fight is gone. The outspoken have become silent. The holy have become worldly. The black of an unhesitating stand for the truth of God's Word is blending into evangelical gray.

That leaves fundamental Baptists. But they, too, *overall*, are morphing into a wishy-washy, "Baptist-flavored" evangelicalism. Large numbers of them, in our experience, are NEARLY POWERLESS. They might still have the right Bible and be sound in doctrine and even have "separation" in their church covenant and still hold to sacred music. *But they are so pathetically powerless*. An older preacher, who founded and pastored a large church with a Bible college and has preached in hundreds of churches, said, "I'm sure I couldn't join 50 churches in America, and I'm being generous. Even many pastors who have [good] music and dress standards are weak and won't 'rock the boat' for anything. It's a sad day. Most of the churches that I could recommend are new works pastored by young men."

**Consider a simple test**. How many churches in America could pass this very basic biblical test, and in truth the test should be much expanded.

(1) The test of conversions. How many churches have regenerating power? A massive number of "Biblebelieving" churches are seeing frighteningly few lifechanging, "turn around and go the other way," biblical conversions. If the baptismal waters are stirred, it is for children who, when they reach maturity, launch right out into the world, thus demonstrating their unregeneracy.

(2) The test of the family. How many churches have the power to build godly homes? A New Testament church is tasked with building godly homes that can raise a godly seed for Christ. Yet a great number of Bible-believing

churches don't have the power to make fathers who are the spiritual leaders of their homes and mothers who are the spiritual keepers of the home. Look at the worldly character of the homes. Look at the the conversation, the priorities, the entertainment, the content of the social media. The homes are the products of churches.

(3) The test of discipleship. How many churches have the power to produce real disciples of Jesus Christ? God's Word plainly states that every church member is to be equipped to observe all things that Christ has commanded and to be presented perfect in Christ (Matthew 28:20; Col. 1:28). That is the work of a New Testament church, and if a church can't do what Christ has commanded there is something deeply, fundamentally wrong. Where are the churches that are taking this seriously and where this is really, effectually happening?

(4) The test of Bible skill. How many churches have the power to produce passionate, skillful Bible students? The Bible plainly says that every saint is to be skillful in Scripture, both in ability to use it and to apply it to daily living so that he or she has a biblical testing mindset (Hebrews 5:12-14).


(5) The test of prayer. How many churches are churches of serious prayer? A mid-week prayer meeting that I

attended at an independent Baptist church a year or so ago is all too typical. It consisted of about four minutes of silent prayer closed by a brother who prayed for about 30 seconds.

An evangelist friend wrote as follows of a recent experience: "Many are just putting in their time in prayer. We were in one church this year for prayer meeting. When they divided for prayer, my wife and I knelt to pray. Within 2-3 minutes, the auditorium became quiet. I looked up and everyone was talking in the back of the church. SAD!" I asked a friend who attends one of the stronger independent Baptist churches in the South if he sees a lot of praying going on. He replied, "No. None at all."

(6) The test of the youth. How many churches have the power to win the hearts of youth to Christ and holiness? Youth are the product of the church and the home; neither institution can escape responsibility. I often ask pastors, "How many of the young people are on fire for the Lord?

Are they passionate to become skillful Bible students? Are they surrendered to seeking God's perfect will by the standard of Romans 12?" Powerless churches have produced a wicked nation that is under the judgment of God.

Black Lives Matter and others claim that there is "systemic racism" in America. Indeed, the evidence can be seen everywhere. Consider some examples:

America liberated all black slaves in 1865, and the federal government under a Republican majority set out to empower blacks with the same civil rights enjoyed by others.

The Thirteenth Amendment abolishing slavery passed with the support of 100% of Republicans and 23% of Democrats. This shows that a large number of white people in America cared for the rights of black people and wanted to help them. A great many whites gave their lives for this cause, both before, during, and after the war.

In 1866, Republicans in Congress passed the Fourteenth Amendment granting citizenship to former slaves and equal protection under the law. Under President Ulysses Grant (1868-1876), Republicans, backed by federal troops, sought to "Reconstruct" the South by enforcing the federal laws granting liberties to blacks. Republicans campaigned on the Fourteenth Amendment in the 1866 midterm elections and voters rewarded them with vetoproof majorities in both houses of Congress. Again, it is obvious that a majority of whites outside of the South were sympathetic to black civil rights.

In 1869, Congress passed the 15th Amendment granting the right to vote to all men regardless of race.

In 1872, the first seven black members of the United States Senate and House of Representatives were seated. Between then and 1900, nearly 40 blacks would serve in the U.S. Congress (all Republicans).

After the Civil War and the liberation of blacks from slavery, there was a massive movement to educate them

and to otherwise lift them out of their desolate condition. Literacy among southern blacks increased from 5% in 1870 to 70% by 1900.

It was an unprecedented event in history. Booker T. Washington, who was in the midst of the phenomenon both as a learner and as a teacher, described it as follows: "This experience of a whole race beginning to go to school for the first time, presents one of the most interesting studies that has ever occurred in connection with the development of any race" (*Up from Slavery*, 1901).

The American Bible Society and the American Tract Society distributed millions of copies of Bibles and religious materials among freed blacks.

Blacks made great progress in the decades after the Civil War, in spite of starting out from the depraved condition created by 200 years of slavery and in spite of the southern Democrats' ferocious attempt to put them back under bondage.

From the beginning of the 20th century, there was growing pushback against Jim Crow segregation.

In 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt issued an executive order opening government jobs and defense contracts to all Americans regardless of race.

In 1948, President Harry Truman issued an executive order ending segregation in the military.

Though there was still white supremacist thinking in the South in the mid-20th century, the mood had changed greatly. Most were opposed to the type of violence that the KKK had perpetrated in previous times. Law enforcement, judges, and juries could no longer be depended on to justify these things (David Chalmers, *Hooded Americanism: The History of the Ku Klux Klan*, 2007).

In 1957, the Civil Rights Act was signed into law by President Dwight D. Eisenhower. It removed the restrictions to voting rights which had been used against minorities.

In 1964, the Civil Rights Act was signed into law by President Lyndon Johnson. It prevents employment discrimination due to race, color, sex, religion or national origin.

In 1965, President Johnson issued an executive order requiring firms under contract with the federal government to take "affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, creed, color, or national origin." During the Richard Nixon administration, this was expanded to set quotas for hiring minority-owned firms.

There have been 25 minority race governors and lieutenant governors.

162 blacks have served in Congress. The 116th Congress (2019) was the most racially diverse in the nation's history with 116 non-white members. This was an 84% increase over the 107th Congress (2001) which had 63 minority members.

America has more than 6,000 black public officials. About 330 of America's cities have black mayors, including many cities in the South (e.g., Atlanta, GA; Baton Rouge, LA; Birmingham, AL; Augusta, GA; Shreveport, LA; Jackson, MS). 39 of the 100 largest American cities have black mayors; 40% of them serve in cities that do not have black majority populations. Black women lead seven of the nation's largest cities.

From 2009 to 2017, a black man held office as the 44th president of the United States. He was elected to two terms of office though blacks only formed 13% of the population. A majority of his total votes nationwide for this black man were cast by whites.

About 30% of America's police nationwide are nonwhite. The number almost doubled between 1987 and 2013. In 2013, there were 130,000 non-white police officers, including 58,000 blacks, about 12% of the total. In Los Angeles, nearly 65% of the police force is non-white. The Detroit police department is so dominated by blacks that it was sued in 2005 for discrimination against whites. There are many black sheriffs and police chiefs. North Carolina, in the deep South, has 20 black sheriffs.

America has spent trillions of dollars in support of non-white "minority" communities. In 2018, Baltimore alone received more than \$5 billion in federal aid.

"From 1950 to 2000, Black people in the United States experienced much larger income gains than whites did. The group that had the largest income gains, by far, was Black women. Their incomes nearly doubled over that period (after inflation). The race gap persists, but it is much lower today than it was in 1950. Does this sound like the financial results from a systemically racist country? ... The Census Bureau report released earlier this month finds that from 2016 to 2019, Black incomes rose more than in any three years in the history of the United States. The median household income for Blacks is now \$45,438. ... The highest-income group in America today is not white-skinned workers. It is Asians. Astonishingly, the median household income of Asian Americans reached just shy of \$100,000 a year. One of America's wonders as a land of opportunity is that an immigrant can come to America dirt-poor from China or India and, within 20 years, move into the middle class or even become wealthy. ... This couldn't have happened in America if this were a nation that hates brown-skinned Americans. It could not have occurred in a xenophobic country. ... The average Hispanic household in America makes more than \$56,000 a year today. That is a *massive* leap forward from what Hispanics earn in Mexico, El Salvador or Cuba. ... I would submit from all this that America isn't the most but rather the least racist nation on Earth when it comes to upward economic mobility" (Stephen Moore, The Washington Examiner, Sep. 24, 2020).

"While it might not be popular to say in the wake of the recent social disorder, the true plight of black people has little or nothing to do with the police or what has been called 'systemic racism.' Instead, we need to look at the responsibilities of those running our big cities. Some of the most dangerous big cities are: St. Louis, Detroit, Baltimore, Oakland, Chicago, Memphis, Atlanta, Birmingham, Newark, Buffalo and Philadelphia. The most common characteristic of these cities is that for decades, all of them have been run by liberal Democrats. Some cities -- such as Detroit, Buffalo, Newark and Philadelphia -- haven't elected a Republican mayor for more than a half-century. On top of this, in many of these cities, blacks are mayors, often they dominate city councils, and they are chiefs of police and superintendents of schools. Democratic-controlled cities have the poorest-quality public education despite their large, and growing, school budgets. Consider Baltimore, Maryland. In 2016, in 13 of Baltimore's 39 high schools, not a single student scored proficient on the state's math exam. In six other high schools, only 1% tested proficient in math. Only 15% of Baltimore students passed the state's English test. That same year in Philadelphia only 19% of eighth-graders scored proficient in math, and 16% were proficient in reading. In Detroit, only 4% of its eighth-graders scored proficient in math, and 7% were proficient in reading. It's the same story of academic disaster in other cities run by Democrats. ... White liberals and black politicians focus most of their attention on what the police do, but how relevant is that to the overall tragedy? According to Statista, this year, 172 whites and 88 blacks have died at the hands of police. To put police shootings in a bit of perspective, in Chicago alone in 2020 there have been 1,260 shootings and 256 homicides with blacks being the primary victims. That comes to one shooting victim every three hours and one homicide victim every 15 hours. Three people in Chicago have been killed by police. If one is truly concerned about black deaths, shootings by police should figure way down on one's list--which is not to excuse bad behavior by some police officers" (Walter Williams, "The True Plight of Black Americans," Townhall, June 10, 2020; Williams is Professor of Economics at George Mason University).

"So when people start to talk about systemic racism, built into the system, what they're really doing is expanding the territory of entitlement. We want more. We want society to give us more. Society is responsible for us, because racism is so systemic. Well, that's a corruption, and I know it's a corruption, because the truth of the matter is blacks have never been less oppressed than they are today. Opportunity is around every corner. In all of this, no one ever stops to say, well, you're unhappy with where minorities are at in

American life, and blacks continue to be at the bottom of most socioeconomic measures. You're unhappy about that. Well, why don't you take some responsibility for that? Why don't you take more responsibility? I would be happy to look at all the usual bad guys, the police and so forth, if we had the nerve, the courage to look at black people. To look at black Americans, minority Americans, and say, you're not carrying your own weight. ... We're farther behind than we've ever been, and we keep blaming it on racism, blaming it on the police. I'm exhausted with that. I grew up in a time when there was real segregation. Blacks during the '50s took a lot of responsibility for their lives, because the government didn't. My father bought three ramshackle houses, rebuilt them, rented them out, kept clawing his way up the ladder. A man with a third-grade education from the South. What civil rights bill is going to replace that? That value system? And he was not exceptional. Across the community we lived in, those were the values. That is the problem. We have allowed ourselves to be enabled in avoiding our real problems by a guilty white society. ... There's always going to be some racism, in every society. My own sense is that it is endemic to the human condition. ... We have let this sort of guilty society, and our grievance industry, put us in this impossible situation where we are a permanent underclass. Before the '60s, there was no black underclass. That's a new phenomenon" (Shelby Steele, Life, Liberty, and Levin, June 7, 2020; Steele is former Lt. Gov. of Maryland, conservative political analyst, columnist, senior fellow at the Hoover Institution).

"This is not 1960. You got Democratic cities--Chicago, Atlanta, LA--run by Democrats, run by people of color. There's chaos in those cities and they're calling 'systemic discrimination. They need to look in the mirror. This is not 1960. This is not Bull Connor. This is not German Shepherds chasing black folks down the street and yet they play this game of using a word, a term, a phrase that does not apply in 2020. ... Let me be as clear as possible: I, as a black man, as an American, do not support Black Lives Matter. Why? Very simple. Black Lives Matter doesn't care about all black lives. ... They are profiteers. You will see Al Sharpton--you'll see him at a police case involving a black man and a white officer, but other than that, those are the only black lives that matter" (Leo Terrell, "Civil Rights Attorney Talks about Being Shunned," Daily Caller, July 15, 2020).

#### DIGGING IN THE WALLS

God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. "Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall ... And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. So I went in and saw. ..." (Ezek. 8:7-10).

*Ezekiel was then instructed to preach against the errors of the leaders and to tell the people the things he had witnessed.* 

"Therefore prophesy against them, prophesy, O son of man. ... Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the Lord had shewed me" (Ezek. 11:4,25).

The hour in which we live is very similar to that of Ezekiel's day. Many of those who profess to be the people of God are apostate. It was prophesied in the New Testament Scriptures that such would be the case in the closing hours of our age. This will culminate in the brief worldwide rule of an utterly apostate Harlot "church" (2 Tim. 3-4; 1 Tim. 4; 2 Pet. 2-3; Jude; Rev. 17).

As in Ezekiel's day much of the apostasy of our hour is hidden from the view of the average Christian. We intend by God's grace to "dig in the walls" of modern ecumenism and to expose and cry out against the things we find. In this section we also report on secular events which are relevant to Christians. May God give us ears to hear, minds to understand, and hearts to obey. Is the truth of God not worthy of defense?



GOOGLE **NOTIFIES CHILDREN IF PARENTS ARE** MONITORING THEIR **ACCOUNTS** (Friday Church News Notes. January 1, 2021, <u>www.wayofl</u>ife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Google confirms," Just the News, Dec. 21, 2020: "Google's childnotification policies received attention when film director Robby Starbuck claimed on Twitter that his 7-year-old child had received a warning from Google that his account was being monitored. Reached for comment, the company confirmed it does notify young children when parents are monitoring their account activity. The company pointed to both the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child and the recently passed UK Age Design Code Appropriate as examples of child-privacy advocacy to which it adheres. The UN Convention on the Rights of the Child--which dates to September 1990--holds, in part, that 'no child

shall be subjected to arbitrary or unlawful interference with his or her privacy, family, home or correspondence, nor to unlawful attacks on his or her honour and reputation.""

'Police also informed us that they will bar our congregation from entering the church on Christmas Eve, contrary to Section 176 of the Criminal Code and the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. We are deeply grieved by these unlawful and immoral acts, having already been banned from meeting on Good Friday and Easter Sunday,' a statement from the church reads. The church says that the Windsor-Essex County Health United has not responded to any written communication from the church while police close the premises. ... Pastor Rock said that legal action against



provincial governments that infringe journalist, 37-year-old Zhang Zhan, on religious freedoms is coming soon. 'Yes there will be lawsuits, they will start in the western provinces, with the goal to overturn their draconian rules. Then they will move to Ontario." Pastor Rock told the Post Millennial, "I think our justice system is under the spell of foolishness, but in all honesty whatever the courts decide or not decide, makes very little difference to me. The Chinese Communist Party lied to cover up the coronavirus pandemic early on, and waited until after 5 million people had already left Wuhan before locking down the city at the center of the outbreak. The party also reportedly destroyed early samples of the virus and silenced doctors who tried to warn the world about it. A University of Southampton study found that if the Communist Party had enacted quarantine measures three weeks earlier, the coronavirus spread would have been reduced by 95 percent. When the World Health Organization (WHO) tweeted that the coronavirus might transmit from person to person, the Chinese government told the WHO to remove that statement, and the WHO complied. 

Then it's one click to launch the drone. Onboard cameras provide a live video stream to the Joe app so the rancher knows what's happening in real time. The cows (or camels in Dubai's case) need to have GPS tags attached so the system can track them. ... The drones can fly up to five kilometers and a single drone can move up to 1,000 head of cattle. ... Israel. BeeFree's After first international market will be Texas. home to 10% of all the cattle in the United States. BeeFree aims to have 10 to 20 pilot programs around the world running in 2021. ... The name 'Joe' comes from Azran's favorite shepherd dog. 'Joe displays all the characteristics of a good herding pal: he's intelligent, loyal, follows orders, is autonomous and fast,' Azran notes."

**U.S. DIVORCE RATE HITS 50-**YEAR LOW, BUT MARRIAGES **ALSO ON THE DECLINE** (Friday Church News Notes, January 8, 2021, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "U.S. Divorce Rate," Christian Headlines, Nov. 11, 2020: "The new data shows that 14.9 marriages per 1,000 ended in divorce in 2019, a rate that is the lowest it's been since 1970. according to an analysis by author Wendy Wang, director of research for the Institute for Family Studies. This number was 35 a decade ago in 2010 and 86 in 1970,' Wang wrote."

**COURT CIRCUIT STRIKES DOWN** BAN AGAINST **"CONVERSION** THERAPY" (Friday Church News Notes, January www.wayoflife.org, 8. 2021, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Court Strikes Down," PJMedia, Nov. 25, 2020: "Last week, a panel on the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals effectively struck down two Florida bans on sexual orientation change efforts (SOCE) that sought to ban counselors from putting minors through 'conversion therapy.' The therapists argue that 'their clients typically have sincerely held religious beliefs conflicting with homosexuality, and voluntarily seek SOCE counseling in order to live in congruence with their faith and to conform their identity. concept of self, attractions, and behaviors to their sincerely held religious beliefs.' ... As Judge Grant wrote, 'The ordinances thus codify a viewpoint--sexual particular orientation is immutable, but gender is not- and prohibit the therapists from advancing any other perspective when counseling clients.' ... This involves an unconstitutional restriction of free speech. 'Whether therapy is prohibited depends only on the content of the words used in that therapy, and the ban on that content is because the government disagrees with it. And whether the government's disagreement is for good reasons, great reasons, or terrible reasons has nothing at all to do with it. All that matters is that a therapist's speech to a minor client is legal or illegal under the ordinances based solely on its content,' Judge Grant against wrote. Lawsuits ... 'conversion therapy' bans received a new lease on life thanks to *NIFLA v*. Becerra. In that decision, Justice

Clarence Thomas explicitly struck down California's law forcing crisis pregnancy centers to advertise abortion under the argument that states can regulate 'professional speech.' In striking down California's law, Thomas referenced a case (*King v. Governor of New Jersey*) involving bans on sexual orientation change efforts. *Otto v. Boca Raton* represents a landmark case for therapy freedom."

This was the big, never-ending news, but in the meantime there were million deaths from 11 communicable diseases other than tuberculosis, 8.2 million deaths from cancer, 5.1 million deaths from smoking, 2.5 million from alcohol, 1.8 million deaths from tuberculosis, 1.4 million deaths from road accidents, and 1.1 million from suicide. But the largest loss of life by far were the 46 million deaths by abortion ("More than 42.6 million abortions," Christian Headlines, Jan. 5, 2021). And we are convinced that 42 million is much lower than the terrible reality, since many high abortion countries do not keep accurate statistics. "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

SOUTH KOREA CRACKING **DOWN ON OPERATION TO** SEND BIBLES INTO NORTH KOREA (Friday Church News Notes, January 15, 2021, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Christian leader awaits charges," Mission Network News, Nov. 23, 2020: "South Korean police began cracking down on balloon launches by Voice of the Martyrs Korea this summer following threats from North Korea. ... 'Essentially, the police charges recommending the guarantees that I'll be charged; it's just a question of when. Could be tomorrow, could be next week, could be next month; we don't know,' Eric Foley of VOM Korea says. ... Confusion surrounds the prosecutor's charges and possible outcomes. 'Our



case asks, [Should] launching Bible balloons, which has been legal up until this point in time, be considered illegal not just going forward, but related to past launches?' Foley clarifies. 'For 15 years, we've had a good relationship with the authorities. ... God is finding ways to get Bibles into North Korea. We're amazed at the avenues He's opening. Please pray that continues. Pray that God is glorified.'"

**ALLIGATORS** IN **ALASKA** (Friday Church News Notes, January www.wayoflife.org, 15. 2021, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) The following is \_ from creationmoments.com, December 25, 2020: "Both archaeology and the Bible suggest that the world was once quite different from the world we know today. Each agrees that the Earth's climate was once much more uniform than it is today. At one time, the tropics may have extended into what are today polar regions. However, the Bible and evolutionary geology don't agree on how long ago



that was. Bible-believing geologists, on the other hand, are reporting evidence to support the Bible's story of history. In the last few years, scientists have been surprised to discover dinosaur fossils in Alaska. Dinosaurs need warm temperatures-warmer than Alaska was thought to have been. In 1986, on Canada's Axel Heiberg Island, only 600 miles from the North Pole, scientists found a huge, dense forest. Some of the trees were well over 125 feet tall. They have been snapped off at the stump and are neither fossilized nor petrified, but remain as fresh wood. Even some of the leaves are still intact. The area was filled with spruce, hickory, dawn redwood and cypress trees and was evidently a swamp, since tropical turtle and alligator remains have also been found. Tree rings show that the area was warmer in the recent past, while the size of the rings tell us that there were short, hot summers during which rapid growth occurred, followed by long, dark winters as there are today. The most interesting conclusion reached by the scientific team is that the entire region must have been subjected to a huge flood! 
been a bastion of fundamentalism because of the presence of Bob Jones University, but it is fast becoming a bastion of emerging churchism. A sign of the times is Hymns & Hops, which has grown from a gathering of 80 in 2016 to gatherings of over 1,000 in 2020. Hymns & Hops "creates the space for families and people to celebrate the Gospel through community, song, and drink." The motto that is featured prominently on its web site is "Sing loud, die happy," which sounds like the theme song for 2 Timothy 4:3-4. One of the testimonials says, "There is nothing like worship at a brewery." The rapid change in attitude toward drinking among "Bible believing" Christians is a major sign of the times. Baptist pastor Charles Spurgeon said, "Next to the preaching of the Gospel, the most necessary thing to be done in England is to induce our people to become abstainers" (1882), and, "Those beer shops are the curse of this country-no good ever can come of them, and

the evil they do no tongue can tell ... the beer shops are a pest ... the sooner their licenses are taken away, the better" (1884). According to Baptist historian Gregory Wills, since at least the mid-1800s Baptists have held "that a minister who drank alcoholic beverages was disqualified to preach" (The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary 1859-2009). When I was a kid growing up in a Southern Baptist church, evangelicals and Baptists in America did not drink and did not go to bars. Exceptions were rare. Schools such as Wheaton and Baylor had rules against drinking. By the 1960s, due to the influence of the anti-separatist, loose, New Evangelical philosophy, evangelicals were beginning to accept "social drinking." In the 1980s and 1990s Contemporary Christian Music continued to push the boundaries of worldliness. In 1993, Michael W. Smith, one of the most prominent voices in CCM, complained in an interview, "... you're always going to have those very, very conservative people. They say you can't do this; you can't do that ... you can't DRINK, you can't smoke. ... It's a pretty bizarre way of thinking" (The Birmingham News, Feb. 1993, p. 1B). By the turn of the 21st century, many evangelicals were embracing drinking with enthusiasm. The book Listening to the Beliefs of Emerging



Churches: Five Perspectives contains probably a dozen references to the joys of drinking. They all condemn drunkenness and call for drinking in moderation, but very few drunks have ever set out to become drunks. Commenting on Proverbs 20:1, Bruce Lackey, who played piano in bars before he was saved, said, "How is alcoholic wine deceptive? In the very way that people are advocating today, by saying that drinking a little bit will not hurt. Everyone admits that drinking too much is bad. Even the liquor companies tell us not to drink and drive, but they insist that a small amount is all right. However, that is the very thing that is deceptive. Who knows how little to drink? Experts tell us that each person is different. It takes an ounce to affect one, while more is necessary for another. The same person will react to alcohol differently in different situations, depending on the amount of food he has had, among other things. So the idea that 'a little bit won't hurt' is deceptive." "Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise" (Proverbs 20:1).

NASA LOWERS ESTIMATE OF **NUMBER OF GALAXIES** (Friday Church News Notes, January 22, www.wayoflife.org, 2021. fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Using technology from its New Horizons spacecraft, NASA now estimates that the number of galaxies is in the hundreds of billions rather than 2 trillion as previously thought. The New Horizons craft, launched in January 2006, captured the first close-up photos of Pluto and is now at the edge of the Milky Way galaxy, about 4.4 billion miles from Earth. estimates are based The on interpretations of "cosmic optical




background" readings. The previous estimate was based on data collected by the Hubble Space Telescope. Scientists admit that they really don't know how many galaxies there are or how vast the universe is. They are making guesses based on unproven presuppositions. The NASA website admits, "There may be many more faint, distant galaxies than theories suggest" ("New Horizons Spacecraft Answers Question," Jan. 12, 2021, hubblesite.org). Regardless if there are hundreds of billions of galaxies or 2 trillion or many more, the fact is that the universe is unimaginably vast and the number of stars beyond counting. There are 100 billion stars in our Milky Way galaxy alone. The universe star count announced in July 2003 was 70 sextillion observable stars (70,000,000,000,000,000,000, 000). This was the conclusion of the Two-Degree Field Galaxy Redshift Survey. Before the invention of the telescope, man could see only a few hundred stars with the naked eye, but the very first book of the Bible, written about 3,400 years ago, says they are without number as the sand of the seashore (Gen. 22:17). The prophet Jeremiah, writing in about 600 BC, said the heaven cannot be measured (Jer. 31:37). This has been confirmed by current science. "Modern" man has discovered nothing that disproves the ancient Bible prophets. "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. *There is* no speech nor language, *where* their voice is not heard" (Psalm 19:1-3).

NEW **MEXICO CHURCHES** FINED \$10,000; **ONTARIO** PASTORS FACE POSSIBLE FINE OF \$10,000 (Friday Church News Notes, January 22, 2021, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "New Mexico megachurches fined," The Christian Post, Dec. 31, 2020: "Calvary Church and Legacy Church, both based in Albuquerque, have been fined for violating restrictions



on in-person worship services and mask mandates implemented by the New Mexico Department of Health to stop the spread of the coronavirus. The restrictions, effective Dec. 15, require churches located in 'redlevel' counties to cap attendance at 25% of capacity. ... After noting that the churches 'operated at or close to capacity' during their respective Christmas Eve services, the letters informed them that they would face 'a civil administrative penalty of \$5,000 for operating in violation of the public health order and a \$5,000 policy for violating the COVID Safe Practices by failing to wear masks or face coverings.' In a statement, Legacy Church defended its decision to hold a Christmas service: 'We have taken the pandemic seriously from the start, and have prudent measures in place. But when governments exceed their constitutional authority and contradict what we are called on by God to do, we answer first to His authority." The following is excerpted from "6 Ontario Elders Fined," The Christian Post, Jan. 4, 2021: "Six elders of a church in Ontario, Canada, have been asked to appear in a criminal court for holding

in-person services in violation of COVID-19-related restrictions. The elders, who face a fine of up to \$10,000, say the action is 'a violation of God-given rights.' The members of Trinity Bible Chapel in Waterloo were charged last week under Section 10.1 of the Reopening Ontario Act for exceeding the number of permitted people in attendance--10 people indoors and 10 people outdoors--during a worship service on Dec. 27, according to CBC News. Officers from the Waterloo Region Police Service visited the homes of the elders at night and gave them each a summons to court. The church says no outbreak has been traced back to its services since they reopened in June. But they 'have heard a plethora of stories from many of our congregants about how they were negatively affected spiritually, emotionally, mentally, and financially during the first lockdown,' the elders said in a statement. 'We are peaceful family men seeking to pastorally care for our families and our church in sincere obedience to God. We are not criminals,' they said."





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

'It's easy to see how the Stasi in East Germany were able to operate so effectively-it appears it doesn't take much to turn neighbours into informants, and police into petty tyrants.' ... The JCCF will be attending multiple first appearances over the next several months, on behalf of these churches and their leaders."
