

TWO AMERICAS: THE OLD AND THE NEW ~ By David Cloud

love America. Even with America in steep decline, I believe it is the greatest nation on God's green earth, as one radio personality likes to say.

As long as I can remember, I have been thankful to God for America and glad to be an American citizen. Spending a large portion of my life overseas has given me a different perspective of America than most of its citizens, but I know America. I have traveled its length and breadth, from sea to shining sea. I've lived in many states (Florida, Tennessee, Missouri, Louisiana, Washington, Oklahoma) and visited every state. I've seen the purple mountain majesties, the fruited plain, the sun rising over the Atlantic and setting over the Pacific.

Forgetting for a moment America's vast interior, with its mountains, canyons, plains, plateaus, deserts, gigantic lakes, rivers, waterfalls, wetlands, and rain forests, America has 84,000 miles of coastline. I've seen all of the coastlines in the American mainland, from Miami to



northern Maine on the Atlantic Coast, from Fort Meyers to Galveston on the Gulf Coast, from San Diego to Bellingham on the Pacific Coast. It is too bad that the vast majority of American visitors see *very* little of the nation's scenic magnificence.

I've not only traveled America and looked atAmerica, I've studied America. I've read hundreds of books on every aspect of this unique nation, including biographies of a great many of its most prominent men and women.

Everyone is confused about America today. What's going on with the homeless camps defacing once beautiful cities such as Seattle, San Francisco, and Portland; the mass shootings; organized mobs of thieves bankrupting stores; murderers, rapists, and anarchists released on bond; schools locked down like prison camps; profligate spending; mountainous debt; calls for defunding the police; censorship of ideas; colleges and universities having deteriorated into bastions of totalitarianism; the cancel culture; the imperial presidents; the ultra extreme party spirit in politics; the gross breakdown in law and order in the cities; the insane wokeness destroying the morale of the military's best warriors; senile American presidents; America's sports stars refusing to honor the flag; an open southern border which is beyond insane; drag queens twerking for children in public libraries; the breakdown of the nuclear family; vast numbers of illegitimate children; totalitarian public school officials running roughshod over parents; widespread support for men who pretend to be women entering women's restrooms and participating in women's sports, to mention a few things.

The eyes of the world have been upon the American experience since the colonial days when its founders purposed that the fledgling nation be "a city on the hill" to shine the light of truth and liberty across the globe.

What's happened to America? In a nutshell, there are two Americas today: the Old and the New, and they are at war, knowingly or unknowingly.

THE OLD AMERICA

America was a mixed multitude even from the beginning. The colonies were composed of the most zealous of Christians as well as secular-minded heathen. Many of the colonists were seeking liberty for truth and godliness; others were seeking filthy lucre just as passionately. These two things have always composed the heart and soul of America: righteousness and covetousness. The percentage of born again Christians has always been relatively small even when "Christianity" predominated. Few, if any, of the nation's presidents were born again. The central principle of "old America" is liberty, as enshrined in the Declaration of Independence, the U.S. Constitution, the First Amendment (the magnificent Bill of Rights), and the Second Amendment (the right to bear arms). America was created to be an Empire of Liberty, a Beacon of Liberty, the Sweet Land of Liberty. America, the land of the Liberty Bell, the Liberty Tree, the Statute of Liberty. The home of men who proclaimed, "Give me liberty or give me death." The land of liberty of religion; liberty of speech; liberty of press; liberty of selfgovernment; liberty from injustice; liberty of economics. America has been called an Idea, and that idea is liberty. Though the liberty was not enjoyed by all at first, that error has been rectified by the 13th Amendment (which abolished slavery), the 15th Amendment (the guarantee of voting rights regardless of race or color), and the 19th Amendment (voting rights for women).

"Liberty was stitched into the fabric of American federalism. In a sense that is hard to appreciate today, throughout the nineteenth century the federal government had little impact on daily life, apart from the local U.S. Post Office" (David Reynolds, *America, Empire of Liberty*).

Whatever its failures, and there were many, Old America was a nation that was more mightily influenced by the Bible than any nation in history, other than Israel. Even the more skeptical founding fathers like Ben Franklin and Thomas Jefferson were mightily influenced by the Bible. Everyone was.

The Bible was used as a textbook and reader in the nation's schools, both private and public, for the first 250 years. Everything was taught from the standpoint of a biblical view of God and morality.

America's first indigenous reader, other than the Bible, was *The New England Primer* (pronounced prem'-ur). It was filled with quotations from the King James Bible, Scripture truths, prayers, catechisms, and hymns. It was the first textbook printed in America and was the most important educational textbook from 1690 to 1790. An estimated two million copies were sold during that time, and it continued to be published until the 1930s. The introduction to the 1900 edition said, "*The New England Primer* was one of the greatest books ever published. It went through innumerable editions ... [It] contributed, perhaps more than any other book except the Bible, to the molding of those sturdy generations that gave to America its liberty and its institutions."

The New England Primer was followed by Noah Webster's American Spelling Book (popularly called the Blue-Back Speller), which was "an essential part of the curriculum of all elementary school children in the United States for five generations." Webster's influence on American education was so great that he has been called "The Schoolmaster of the Republic." Nearly 100 million copies of the Speller have been printed. It taught biblical principles to millions of Americans. Webster also taught the nation to define words with the American Dictionary of the English Language (1828), which contained 6,000 quotations from the King James Bible.

By the use of the Bible and Bible-based textbooks, Americans of the 17th through the 19th centuries were steeped in Scripture from a young age, and this had a powerful influence on society, even among the unsaved.

It was the Bible's influence that produced Old America's greatest qualities: the belief that the Bible is God's Word; near universal belief in the almighty Creator God revealed in the Bible; acceptance of absolute truth based on biblical principles; the emphasis on good character

traits such as honesty, purity, humility, self-restraint, benevolence; exalted concepts of human liberty (as summarized in the magnificent Bill of Rights); love of neighbor; civic mindedness; pursuit of universal literacy; strong law and order; respect for authority; the centrality of the "nuclear family" (composed of mother, father, children); private ownership of property; small government under the control of the people.

This is the old America. It was "the land of the free." With all its faults, it was "one nation under God," to a large degree.

THE NEW AMERICA

The New America is simply a portion of America that is in rebellion to the Old America. In brief, it is rebellion against almighty God and His holy laws.

The rebellion isn't new. It existed in incipient form even in the early years after the nation's founding. Thomas Paine, whose *Common Sense* was the best-selling book of the Revolutionary War era, was also one of the most brazen skeptics of the time. In *The Age of Reason*, Paine attacked the divine inspiration of the Bible and exalted human reason as the final authority.

In the 19th century, this rebellion took the form of the enlightenment, existentialism, transcendentalism, unitarianism, German theological liberalism, Darwinian evolution, Social Darwinism, Freudian psychology, Marxism, and socialism, to name a few.

In the 20th century, there was the addition of New Age, Secular Humanism, Feminism, abortion rights, homosexual rights, the sexual revolution, globalism, socialism (e.g., the New Deal and the Great Society), and many other isms.

In the 21st century, there is the addition of cultural Marxism (e.g., Black Lives Matter, Antifa), Analytic Philosophy, Woke, and others.

Influential voices in the destruction of the Old America and the creation of the New America include Charles Darwin, Karl Marx, Julius Wellhausen, Sigmund Freud, Friedrich Nietzsche, Henry David Thoreau (transcendentalism, Hinduism), Jean-Paul Sartre (nihilism, existentialism, moral relativism), Margaret Sanger (abortion rights, free love, feminist liberation, founder of

Planned Parenthood, author of The Woman Rebel, with its slogan "No Gods! No Masters"), John Dewey (Secular Humanism preached by education), Michael Foucault (Maoist lecturer at the University of California, a homosexual who died of AIDS), Havelock Ellis (philosopher of "free love"), Carl Sagan (evolution), Noam Chomsky (the power of media to transform society), Jacques Derrida (deconstructionism, Marxism), Rachel Carson (radical environmentalism), Betty Friedan (feminism, co-founder National Organization for Women and author of The Feminine Mystique), Martin Luther King, Jr., and Alice Walker (black feminism), Elvis Presley, Hugh Hefner, Alfred Kinsey and Margaret Mead, Oliver Wendell Holmes, Harry Blackmun, Earl Warren, Oprah Winfrey, Steven Spielberg, George Lucas, Stephen Hawking, Michael Jackson, Beyonce, Barak Obama, Madonna, Snoop Dogg, Kim Kardashian, Ellen DeGeneres, and Eminem.

All of these people and all of their isms are various forms of rebellion against the Old America and its belief in the almighty Creator God, absolute truth, Bible-based morality, law and order, equity, freedom of thought, freedom of religion, freedom of speech, freedom of association, the divine distinction of the sexes, the centrality of the nuclear family, the sacredness of life, respect for authority, love of neighbor, civic mindedness, private ownership of property, and small government under the control of the people.

America's world influence has been great, but it has been a two-edged sword. The Old America had a vast influence for good, though never *only* good: the gospel of Jesus Christ, liberty and justice, democracy, republicanism, equity, benevolence, civic mindedness, etc.

While the Old America is not dead and its influence continues for good, today, the New America's influence predominates, and it is evil: narcissism, licentiousness, sensuality, immodesty, covetousness, cultural Marxism, atheism.

Born in 1949, I have witnessed both Americas. The New America existed in incipient form in the 1940s and 1950s. It was spreading like ivy, which first sleeps, then creeps, then leaps. It was creeping around in the shadows and had not yet exploding into the limelight. The Old America was definitely in the dominion then, but we are approaching the tipping point when the Old America will be under dominion.

The major political parties have come to represent the two Americas. Generally speaking, the Republicans tend to represent the Old America, and the Democrats tend to represent the New America.

MAGA (Make America Great Again)

Donald Trump's Make America Great Again program is misguided. The only way to make America great again is to make America the America it was when it was great, and there is no evidence that Trump has a clear concept of what that is or how to get there.

To Make America Great Again would be to re-create the Old America, and that isn't possible today.

There is something that God's people can do, and it is no small thing. They can pray. Effectual prayer by redeemed people on "praying ground" is the most powerful thing on this earth. The Bible teaches us how to pray: to pray a lot, to pray persistently, to pray earnestly, to pray individually, to pray corporately, to pray in secret, to pray in pubic, and to pray with prayer partners.

One of the things we are instructed to pray for is the nation.

"I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty" (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

Fundamentalism as a movement had serious weaknesses, as we have documented in this book, but the strength of Fundamentalism was its stand for the infallible inspiration of Scripture, its testing mindset, its zeal for the truth, its willingness to fight for the truth, to defend the truth, to preach *against* error as well as *for* truth, and to separate from error.

This is biblical and right. In fact, no Christianity that lacks this is biblical and right.

"Therefore I esteem all *thy* precepts *concerning* all *things to be* right; *and* I hate every false way" (Psalm 119:128).

"Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them" (Ro. 16:17).

"Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?" (2 Co. 6:14).

"And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove *them*" (Eph. 5:11).

"As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest charge some that they teach no other doctrine" (1 Ti. 1:3).

"Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck: Of whom is Hymenaeus and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto Satan, that they may learn not to blaspheme" (1 Ti. 1:19-20).

"Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself" (1 Ti. 6:5).

"O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane *and* vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called" (1 Ti. 6:20).

"But shun profane *and* vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some" (2 Ti. 2:16-18).

"Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away" (2 Ti. 3:5).

"I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith" (2 Ti. 4:7).

"Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world" (1 Jo. 4:1).

"Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into *your* house, neither bid him God speed: For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds" (2 Jo. 1:9-11).

"Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints" (Jude 1:3).

Growing up Southern Baptist, I didn't know anything about Fundamentalism. But after I was saved and began to love and study the Bible, I came across fundamentalist preaching, and it resonated with me, because this is the type of Christianity I see in Scripture. There I see serious discipleship, soldiering, fighting, disciplining, earnest contending, reproving and rebuking, marking and avoiding, withdrawing from, coming out from among, touching not the unclean thing, not being yoked together with. This is not the sum of New Testament Christianity, of course, but it is a major element.

When the world attacked God's Word, fundamentalists took their stand. They stood up on their hind legs like a grizzly bear and said, "Bring it on!" They took on the newly rising philosophies in Western society. The fact that they were in the extreme minority didn't stop them. They had the spirit of Athansius who, when he was told, "The whole world is against you," replied, "Then I am against the whole world." He was known as Athansius Contra Mundum (Athansius against the World). Every Bible-believing Christian should be known as Contra Mundum. The Bible record is filled with Contra Mundums who pleased the Lord. James was Contra Mundum! "Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God" (Jas. 4:4). John was Contra Mundum. "And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness" (1 Jo. 5:19).

True fundamentalists walk in the footsteps of the spiritual warriors of all ages. We think of Abraham, who armed his servants and pursued the army of five Mesopotamian kings to Dan and defeated them. What a warrior!

We think of Enoch who was such a warrior against sin and error, so worked up in preaching prophetically against this present age, that he used the word "ungodly" four times in one sentence (Jude 1:14-15).

We think of the sons of Levi who, responding to Moses' call, "Who is on the LORD's side?" strapped on their swords and killed 3,000 of the Lord's enemies (Ex. 32:26-28). There was no peace with compromisers for those warriors! No softy priests, these!

We think of Joshua and Caleb, who alone of the 12 spies, said, "Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it" (Nu. 13:30). While the other 10 said,

"The people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there," Joshua and Caleb said, "With God as our help, we can take on the whole lot of those giants in their fortified cities and their well-equipped armies. Let's go!" What warriors!

We think of Caleb 45 years later, at age 85, saying, "Now therefore give me this mountain, whereof the LORD spake in that day; for thou heardest in that day how the Anakims were there, and that the cities were great and fenced: if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the LORD said" (Jos. 14:12). Through a half century of living and fighting, his warrior zeal hadn't faded. We know that his faith in God was not disappointed, for we are told, "Hebron therefore became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite unto this day, because that he wholly followed the LORD God of Israel" (Jos. 14:14). God was pleased with this soldier.

After Joshua and Caleb, the warrior spirit largely died out of Israel. There arose "another generation after them, which knew not the LORD" (Jdg. 2:10). Instead of going on and conquering the remaining Canaanites and capturing all of the Promised Land as God had commanded, the next generation settled down, content to live among the enemies of God. Whereas Joshua and Caleb's fundamentalist generation sang, "the fight is on," their compromising evangelical offspring sang, "the fighting is over."

We think of Deborah, the female judge of Israel who urged Barak to lead the army of Israel against Jabin's Canaanites. She called Barak to Mt. Ephraim and told him that God had commanded them to fight Jabin's great army led by Sisera, but Barak was not eager. He said, "If thou wilt go with me, then I will go: but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go." Deborah did not hesitate, "I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman" (Jdg. 4:6-9). Barak gathered an army from the tribes of Zebulun and Naphtali and went with Deborah to Mt. Tabor. There they could see the multitude of Canaanite soldiers with their 900 chariots of iron gathered in the valley of Jezreel by the river Kishon. When Barak still hesitated, Deborah said, "Up; for this is the day in which the LORD hath delivered Sisera into thine hand: is not the LORD gone out before thee?" (Jdg. 4:14). Barak and his men did the

fighting, but it was Deborah who was the chief warrior that day. "Up, men! Let's go, boys!"

We think of David accepting the challenge of Goliath, the blasphemous, boasting giant, "a man of war from his youth," the champion of God's enemies, the Philistines. He was about nine and a half feet tall and was armed with a brass helmet, brass greaves that covered the lower parts of his legs, a brass shield that covered his upper back, a huge spear with a 15 pound tip, and a coat of mail (made of brass plates arranged like the scales of a fish) that weighed about 125 pounds. David told Saul, "Let no man's heart fail because of him; thy servant will go and fight with this Philistine" (1 Sa. 17:32). David had decided to take care of this business. He selected five stones from the brook Elah. He took a few moments to tell the giant, "I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied. This day will the LORD deliver thee into mine hand; and I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee; and I will give the carcases of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air, and to the wild beasts of the earth; that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel." Then David ran toward the giant, sunk a stone in his forehead, and cut off the champion's head with his own sword. What a warrior!

We think of Elijah. Oh, we cannot forget Elijah! He was a prophet in a time of nearly complete apostasy in Israel, and he determined to have a showdown with Baal: one prophet of Jehovah God facing off with 850 prophets of Baal. He told Ahab to bring the people of Israel and the prophets to Mt. Carmel and called for two altars to be built, one for Baal and one for Jehovah. He said, "the God that answereth by fire, let him be God." For hours, the prophets of Baal acted like maniacs in an attempt to get the attention of their god, crying out, leaping, cutting themselves "till the blood gushed out," but Baal was silent. Elijah didn't watch the demonstration quietly; "he mocked them, and said, Cry aloud; for he is a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, or peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked." When the Baal liturgy was over, Elijah called for twelve barrels of water to be poured on his altar, then calmly, but fervently, prayed, "Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God," and "then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench" (1 Ki. 18:37-38). For good measure, the prophet of God had the

850 prophets of Baal taken down to the river Kishon and killed. What a warrior for truth!

We think of John the Baptist who said to impenitent, hard-hearted, prophet-killing Israel, "O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?" (Lu. 3:7), and told the fearsome Herod, who had taken his brother's wife as his own, "It is not lawful for thee to have her" (Mt. 14:4).

We think of the Lord Jesus Christ, who even in His humility (Php. 2:8) publicly called the Pharisees and scribes hypocrites, children of hell, blind guides, fools, serpents, and generation of vipers (Mt. 23:1-36), and twice chased the money changers out of the temple with a whip (Mt. 21:12; Joh. 1:13-17)! How much more do we see Christ's warrior spirit when He appears on a white horse at the head of the armies of heaven, in righteousness judging and making war, His eyes as a flame of fire, clothed with a vesture dipped in blood, smiting the nations, and ruling with a rod of iron (Re. 19:11-15). Indeed, "The LORD is a man of war" (Ex. 15:3)!

The apostle Paul was a warrior. His bodily presence might have been weak, as his enemies claimed (2 Co. 10:10). We don't know and it doesn't matter; he was large when it came to fighting for the truth. On the very first stop of his first historic missionary journey, he publicly called out a prominent member of the city of Salamis with these shocking words, "O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord," and struck him with blindness for good measure (Ac. 13:10-11)! What a fireball! As for two preachers of that day, Hymenaeus and Alexander, Paul turned them over to the devil "that they may learn not to blaspheme" (1 Ti. 1:20). In an epistle meant to be read by all of the churches, Paul called out two other preachers by name, Hymenaeus and Philetus, labeling their teaching "profane and vain babblings" (2 Ti. 2:16-18), not caring a whit if he hurt their poor feelings. In the same epistle, Paul publicly exposed Alexander the coppersmith's evil (2 Ti. 4:14-15) and mentioned the preacher Demas by name, a former coworker, for "having loved this present world," holding him up as a bad example before all the churches. Paul rebuked Peter publicly for hypocrisy (Ga. 2:11-14). The apostle to the Gentiles taught a vast amount of really deep "positive truth," but he wasn't finished. He got very "negative" when he fought against Galatian judaizers and Corinthian spiritualizers and Colossian gnostics. Paul

stood against false christs and false gospels and false spirits of any and every sort, but he didn't stop there. He stood against carnality, worldliness, man-centeredness, pride of scholarship, unqualified pastors, and every type of sin in the churches. He was an unwavering disciplinarian (1 Co. 5). He was big on rebuking (2Ti. 4:2; Tit. 1:13; 2:15). Unlike many warriors since then, Paul never backed down, never softened his stance, never regretted or repented of fighting for the truth's sake. At the very end, Paul summarized his Christian life with these words, "I have fought a good fight" (2 Ti. 4:7). Indeed! Any preacher who is not a fighter is not walking in the footsteps of Paul.

True fundamentalists are pilgrims and strangers, soldiers, come outers, walk aloners, when necessary. In their defense of the faith, fundamentalists have offended relatives and friends, lost salaries, retirement benefits, insurance policies, positions, church properties, and prestige. They have endured willful misunderstanding, misrepresentation, slander, ridicule, and disdain. They have turned their backs on comfortable denominationalism and institutionalism to found independent churches and ministries by faith in God alone, often without the pledge of any human support. They have literally become the offscouring of the world in the eyes of secular society and of Christianity at large.

Fundamentalist Bob Schuler said, "I have come, thank God, to where I believe I could stand up and vote my convictions if I were the one lonely man on my side of the question. ... Such are times when men need to know their own souls and to be fortified with a loyalty that is to God alone. If standing true and courageous amid the storms that now assail they can look up and go forward, it will matter little whether other men are their friends or their foes" (cited from Richard Clearwaters, *The Great Conservative Baptist Compromise*).

William Ashbrook, author of Evangelicalism The New Neutralism, renounced the liberal northern Presbyterians and lost "his pulpit and his pension." He identified lack of courage as a chief characteristic of the time. "It is indeed a question of whether we of this generation have the courage to stand up for our convictions and maintain a bold testimony in the face of encroaching unbelief and compromise. ... Many, from weakness or fear of reproach, are quitting the fight. It is sad indeed to see those who were speaking out boldly a few years back, now remaining in silence, apparently wearied of the conflict.

... God's challenge was never more needed than in this day. 'Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong' (1 Co. 16:13)."

J.C. Ryle said, "We want more boldness among the friends of truth. There is far too much tendency to sit still, and wait for committees, and number our adherents. We want more men who are not afraid to stand alone. It is truth, not numbers, which shall always in the end prevail. We have the truth, and we need not be ashamed to say so. The judgment day will prove who is right, and to that day we boldly appeal" (cited from Iain Murray, J.C. Ryle: Prepared to Stand Alone, p. ii).

We think of the old fundamentalist papers, such as W.B. Riley's *Christian Fundamentals* and John Straton's *Calvary Call* and A.J. Gordon's *Watchword* and J. Frank Norris's *Searchlight* and Oliver Van Osdel's *Baptist Temple News* and Marion Reynolds' *Foundation* and T.T. Shields' *Gospel Witness* and Gerald Winrod's *Defender* and G. Archer Weniger's *Blue Print* and Don Jasmin's *Fundamentalist Journal*. They were bold and forthright about heretics and compromisers. There was no beating around the bush, no soft and gentle "neutralist" mood! No speaking in generalities. These fundamentalist periodicals were scented with the smoke of battle rather than the perfume of positivism.

In fundamentalist books such as Evangelicalism The New Neutralism by William Ashbrook and New Neutralism II: Exposing the Gray of Compromise by John Ashbrook and The New Evangelical Experiment by Rolland Starr and The New Evangelicalism by Charles Woodbridge and The Challenge of a New Religion by Carlton Helgerson, theological modernists are called "evil"; they are called "heretics"; their theology is called "poison," "damnable"; New Evangelicals are called compromisers, dangerous, pragmatists, popularizers, latitudinarians, neutralists. New Evangelicalism is called "a virus," "tragedy," "menace," "deadly," "deviant," "the deadliest ism of all," "theological and moral compromise of the deadliest sort."

The old fundamentalists named names--lots of them! They named names when preaching, and they named names when writing. Heresy and compromise is a public issue, and they made a public issue of dealing with it.

They knew they would be misunderstood and charged with hate-mongering; they knew that they were in the minority and that by so speaking they were closing doors

of fellowship and ministry. They knew they were choosing a limited fellowship by refusing to limit their message. They knew that "to identify oneself with the truth is to place one's self in the heart of a storm from which there is no escape for life." But they did it anyway, because this is the biblical example and therefore it is the will of God, and because they loved God and had a zeal for God's truth in their hearts and souls. Like lonely Jeremiah, they could say, "But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay" (Jer. 20:9).

Until today, fighting is what sets fundamentalists apart from even the most conservative of evangelicals. The latter might wear gloves, but they are velvet ones. They might point out a theological disagreement with someone, but typically in gentle, intellectual, "let's still be friends," non-separatist terms.

They aren't warriors. They say that they esteem all of God's precepts concerning all things to be right, like the Psalmist, but unlike the Psalmist, they don't "hate every false way" (Ps. 119:128). To hate false ways is shocking to their sensibilities. It's not their kind of Christianity.

But fundamentalists are warriors. We think of W.L. Pettingill in his warning about the liberal Harry Emerson Fosdick: "[T]he fight is on and it grows hotter. Let us praise God for that. A fight is much better than a disgraceful surrender and a fight is necessary just now that the truth of the Gospel may continue with us" (Serving and Waiting, January 1925, Philadelphia School of the Bible).

A.J. Gordon said, "Satan is the real Pope [and] demons the real cardinals."

No velvet gloves there.

We think of David Otis Fuller who often ended his letters with the words, "The battle is getting hotter and hotter, and I like it better and better." I received many of those letters.

We think of **JOHN ROACH STRATON** (1875-1929), pastor of Calvary Baptist Church in New York City from 1918 until his death in 1929, during the "Roaring Twenties." He was called "a crusader, a two-fisted hard-hitting man of God, always the defendant at the bulwarks of Christianity." Calvary Baptist was founded

in 1847 and had prominent pastors, including John Dowling, author of *The History of Romanism*.

Straton was the son of a Baptist preacher, but when he was 18 he attended law school and embraced humanism and evolution and was on a moral spiral downward. He visited services at First Baptist Church of Atlanta and was born again. He attended Mercer University and Southern Seminary. He started preaching, and by the end of World War I in 1918, he rejected postmillennialism for premillenialism. That was the year he was called to the pastorate of Calvary Baptist.

Straton published *The American Fundamentalist* (later called *The Calvary Call*) to broadcast his preaching and warnings. The *New York Times* reported regularly on his hard-hitting sermons, sometimes on the front page and sometimes publishing his entire Sunday sermon, which reminds us of how dramatically America has changed. The media was not universally positive of course. "Hostile journalists and cartoonists dipped their pens in acid and satirized Straton as 'the Fundamentalist's Pope,' the 'Witch Doctor of Gotham,' and the 'Meshuggah (Yiddish for crazy) of Manhattan'" ("John Roach Straton," *Baptist Bible Tribune*, Jan. 25, 2013).

He was a tall, distinguished looking man, but he preached on the streets, and he preached *against* things. He designed and built a pulpit platform on an automobile from which he preached to crowds in the city (David Beale, *In Pursuit of Purity*, p. 213). He aimed to call America to repentance. He preached against Unitarianism, theological modernism, German skepticism, the social gospel, denominationalism, and communism. He preached against the popular press of his day for "engaging in a plot to ruin moral forces and bring them into national contempt" (George Dollar, *A History of Fundamentalism in America*). What would he say today when the press is promoting free sex, pornography, homosexual rights, sex education for children, and abortion on demand!

Pastor John Straton named names. He called the very popular, very liberal Harry Emerson Fosdick "a religious outlaw--the Jesse James of the theological world." He called out S. Parkes Cadman, president of the Federal Council of Churches, for saying there is no hell. Straton said that Cadman was one of those who were "sprinkling cologne upon the putrid iniquities of

a rebellious race." He preached against liberal Baptist historian H.C. Vedder of Crozer Seminary. He preached against the budding tendency for American courts to capitulate to humanistic psychology and to coddle criminals rather than punish them. He said God is "not a mollycoddle ... and the present wave of crime and vice that is simply devastating America is the direct result of this false and flimsy teaching."

Straton also preached against worldliness. His books included *The Menace of Immorality in Church and State* (1920), *The Scarlet Stain on the City and How to Wipe It Out* (c. 1921), and *Satan in the Dance Hall* (c. 1925). Chapter titles in the latter included "Flappers and the Dance of Life" and "The Devil's Music and the Scopes Trial." There were 750 dance halls in New York City in Straton's day.

Of female fashions, he said, "When it comes to women's dress today there is not enough to talk about." What would this warrior pastor say today! He preached against church dances and the use of theater stars and starlets to attract a crowd. He reproved parents who let their children choose between the picture show and Sunday School. He said the result of worldly homes was "the cigarette smoking boy who develops into the girl-ogling, sap-headed dude who would not recognize a sound thought or a sound ethical principal if he met it in the street; and the female flapper and flirt who knows more at 16 than her grandmother knew at 60, who hasn't a speaking acquaintance with the art of sweeping a room, sewing a dress, or making a biscuit, but is past mistress with the lip-stick, the powder puff, and the bunny bag" (from Straton's sermon "New York as Modern Babylon"). (A bunny bag was a small bag for cosmetics and other female accouterments.)

Straton took on prominent skeptics and heretics in public debates. The interest was so large that they were held in Madison Square Garden. He also debated at Harvard, Dartmouth, Columbia, and other leading schools.

At the Northern Baptist Convention in 1923, Straton stood from the floor and denounced W.H.P. Faunce of Brown University as an infidel who was unfit to deliver the keynote address.

There isn't a prominent "conservative evangelical" alive today who knows anything of the fundamentalist prophet-warrior spirit. There are no A.J. Gordons, no John Stratons, no William Bell Rileys, no J. Frank Norrises, no Bob Jones, Srs., no Marion Reynoldses, no Robert Ketchams. The spirit of these old fighters does exist today, but it doesn't exist anywhere in conservative evangelicalism.

The essence of Fundamentalism was its warrior spirit, and that was biblical and right and good and godly, though the fighting wasn't done with any perfection. Poor redeemed sinners haven't done *anything* with perfection since Adam's fall.

The warrior spirit was right, and from the warrior spirit flowed testing, reproofs, rebukes, warnings, and separations.

But conservative evangelicals don't believe in fighting after this manner. They don't even like fighters. If they find a fighter battling against sin and error, it is far more likely that they will attack him than join him.

The essence of Fundamentalism was, and is, its warrior spirit, and may the Lord multiply that spirit ten thousand fold today, regardless of the label! When living in such a wicked, apostate age, if a preacher doesn't get worked up like Enoch of old and start firing off a bunch of well-aimed "ungodlys," something is seriously wrong with him.

Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. (2 Timothy 2:3-4)

DIGGING IN THE WALLS

God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. "Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall ... And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. So I went in and saw. ..." (Ezek. 8:7-10).

Ezekiel was then instructed to preach against the errors of the leaders and to tell the people the things he had witnessed.

"Therefore prophesy against them, prophesy, O son of man. ... Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the Lord had shewed me" (Ezek. 11:4,25).

The hour in which we live is very similar to that of Ezekiel's day. Many of those who profess to be the people of God are apostate. It was prophesied in the New Testament Scriptures that such would be the case in the closing hours of our age. This will culminate in the brief worldwide rule of an utterly apostate Harlot "church" (2 Tim. 3-4; 1 Tim. 4; 2 Pet. 2-3; Jude; Rev. 17).

As in Ezekiel's day much of the apostasy of our hour is hidden from the view of the average Christian. We intend by God's grace to "dig in the walls" of modern ecumenism and to expose and cry out against the things we find. In this section we also report on secular events which are relevant to Christians. May God give us ears to hear, minds to understand, and hearts to obey. Is the truth of God not worthy of defense?

The bill, the Respect for Marriage Act (H.R. 8404), defines marriage as 'between 2 individuals' and overturns the 1996 Defense of Marriage Act, which defined marriage as the union of one man and one woman. Supporters say it ensures that samesex marriage remains legal even if the U.S. Supreme Court overturns its landmark decision Obergefell v. Hodges(2015), which struck down traditional marriage laws nationwide. ... Although the bill includes an amendment that supporters say protects religious liberty, critics say its impact is too narrow. The amendment protects churches and other houses of worship. ... Alliance Defending Freedom, a religious liberty legal group that opposed the bill, said in an analysis that the law ignores 'the true threats to religious individuals and organizations.' As written, the new law 'can be used to punish social-service organizations that work closely with government,' such as 'adoption or foster placement agencies that serve their communities in accordance with their religious belief that marriage is the union of one man and one woman.' The new law

also could be used by the government to threaten a religious organization's tax-exempt status, ADF said. ... 'It only applies to religious organizations in the solemnization or celebration of a marriage, not to religious individuals or to any entity in any other context.' ... For example, the new law would not protect Christian-owned florists and bakers who have been involved in prominent lawsuits nationwide."

MEGACHURCH PASTOR WANTS TO REACH YOUNG **MEN** BY **GROWING** MARIJUANA (Friday Church News Notes, December 23, 2022, www.wavoflife.org. fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Pastor Jamal Bryant of Atlanta's New Birth Missionary Baptist Church has announced his plan to grow marijuana on the church property as an outreach. The church is "the largest land-owning Black church in America." He said he is looking for male congregants that "smell like weed" ("Megachurch Pastor," Relevant, Dec. 9, 2022). He says, "So if the guy, Black boy, in Bankhead said, 'They growing weed at the church? Where do I join?' I don't need no pamphlet for him." So Pastor Jamal wants to use marijuana as a church promotion! This is beyond dumb, even if marijuana were legal in Georgia, which it is not (cultivating marijuana for any reason is a felony offense). Marijuana is not



a harmless drug. Proponents of marijuana recreational typically ignore proven dangers such as addiction, psychosis, marijuana as a gate-way drug, long-term effects on learning, cognition, and personality, amotivational syndrome (lethargy and loss of interest in achievement), bronchitis and respiratory infections, and increased risk of cardiovascular disease. There is a long line of evidence that marijuana is not an innocent relaxation drug. I know this all too well, having been a drug user before I was saved, beginning with my Army tour in Vietnam in 1970-71. Although he asked his brother, Gary, to 'bust him out' as soon as possible, within a month of going into hospital he'd submitted a request to be euthanized. He listed only one health condition-hearing loss--as the reason, but that was enough to satisfy his keepers and he was killed. 'Alan was basically put to death,' said his brother Gary. Erin Smith said her 71-year-old father, Rod McNeill, went to an Ontario hospital after suffering a fall. A month later, he ... was euthanized for a condition--end-stage obstructive chronic pulmonary disease--that an autopsy shows he didn't have, Smith said. ... Canada is set to allow people to die

exclusively for mental health reasons. Starting March 2023, Canada's medically assisted suicide eligibility will expand to people who do not have a physical ailment. ... also Canada is considering extending euthanasia to 'mature' minors--children under 18 who meet the same requirements as adults. and human **Doctors** campaigners say Canada's easycome, easy-go euthanasia laws are particularly dangerous disabled people who are being 'devalued' as a result. ... Professor Tim Stainton, director of the Canadian Institute for Inclusion and Citizenship at the University of Columbia, described British Canada's law as probably the existential threat to disabled people since the Nazis' programme in Germany in the 1930s'. Being compared to the Nazis is surely the last thing that Justin Trudeau and his achingly woke allies would expect to ever hear but as they turn their country into an assisted suicide Wild West, they are losing any claim to common humanity."

They must be born again, converted, supernaturally changed, and by God's grace we have seen every sort of sinner converted and go on to live

The latest evidence is that Stanford University administrators in May published an index of forbidden words to be eliminated from the school's websites and computer code, and provided inclusive replacements to help re-educate the benighted. Call yourself an 'American'? Please don't.



Better to say 'U.S. citizen,' per the bias hunters, lest you slight the rest of the Americas. 'Immigrant' is also out, with 'person who has immigrated' as the approved alternative. It's the iron law of academic writing: Why use one word when four will do? You can't 'master' your subject at Stanford any longer; in case you hadn't heard, the school instructs that 'historically, masters enslaved people.' We can't imagine what's next, except that it will surely involve more make-work for more administrators, whose proliferation has driven much of the rise in college tuition and student debt. For 16.937 students, Stanford lists 2,288 faculty and 15,750 administrative staff." 

The 'Growing Pains' star said a library in Alameda County, Calif., rejected a solicitation while instead continuing to schedule what he characterized as a 'gender name-change clinic' later in the week. 'I'm thinking, Wow, if we're so committed to diversity, why am I being excluded? Why can't I use your facility to read my book? You're a library.' He said a Providence, R.I., library rejected another offer, with a worker telling publisher Brave Books they are a 'very queer-friendly library; our messaging does not align.' 'My understanding of history is that the family and the church are two great pillars of Western civilization,' Cameron said. 'And those two things need to be removed and taken out of the way in order to fundamentally change the power structure and the moral value code of the nation.' However, the actor added that since the news broke of his dozens of rejections, parents and librarians are contacting him or his publisher to solicit appearances to read his book."

THE RAPID, DESTRUCTIVE EFFECT OF DARWINISM ON

SOCIETY (Friday Church News Notes. December 30. 2022, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Charles Darwin published On the Origin of Species in 1859. Though he gave zero evidence for how the species originated by naturalistic means, his atheistic philosophy received a sympathetic hearing in England, Europe, America, and beyond. It was a major event in the onslaught of end-time apostasy. Less than 30 years later, the following observation was given at the International Prophetic Conference in Chicago, 1886, the second of five such conferences: "A man is what he thinks. If he thinks mud he will be mud. That is why, under the reign of Huxley, Darwin and the prurient biologic school, reverence is dying away, the sacredness of womanhood dying away, dignities, titles, selfrespect dying away, and London becomes like to Sodom and Paris like to Gomorrah." This statement was made by George Sayles Bishop, a Reformed pastor. Already, Darwin's wicked hypothesis had exercised a terrible effect on society. The prophetic conferences marked the dawn of the fundamentalist revival. (I see the fundamentalist movement in all of its broad aspects as one of



America's Great Awakenings.) The major themes of the conferences were the infallible inspiration of Scripture, end-time apostasy, the defense of the faith once delivered unto the saints, and the literal interpretation of Bible prophecy, with an emphasis on the return of the Jews to their homeland and the establishment of a Jewish state. At the time, this appeared to be impossible. The land of Israel was controlled by the Muslim Ottoman Turks, and they were dead set against a Jewish state in "Palestine." But Bible believers knew that it would happen, because it is prophesied in Scripture. In 1864, Charles Spurgeon had preached on Ezekiel 37:1-10 at a gathering of the British Society for the Propagation of the Gospel among the Jews, saying, "The meaning of our text, as opened up by the context, is most evidently, if words mean anything, first, that there shall be a

political restoration of the Jews to their own land and to their own nationality. And then, secondly, there is in the text and in the context a most plain declaration that there shall be a spiritual restoration--in fact a conversion--of the tribes of Israel." The first part of this prophecy was fulfilled in 1948 with the founding of the modern state of Israel. This is a preparation (unknowingly on Israel's part) for the coming of the Antichrist his peace covenant prophesied in Daniel 9:27. Its low weight (14 grams), plain appearance, and scratchy voice belie its migratory prowess. Two ornithologists from the University of St. Andrews, with a colleague in Nigeria, outfitted 40 of the birds with geologgers weighing only half a gram and recorded their flight paths. These lightweight contenders were measured traveling 5,000 km in just 52 days, including 2,000 km nonstop across inhospitable barriers like the Sahara Desert and the Mediterranean Sea. How's that for a home run? The scientists published the stats in PLOS ONE: 'Departures from breeding grounds took place between July and August in a south-westerly direction. During spring migration individuals travelled longer distances at faster rates making its



overall duration shorter than autumn migration. We suggest that, while Whitethroats can cross the Sahara Desert and Mediterranean Sea in a single flight, they are likely to refuel before and after crossing.' [Emphasis added.] The small champions sometimes stop at the bases, but occasionally make home runs. 'If under severe time constraints, however, individuals can successfully undergo a flight without making stopovers.'"

widespread slander. On Dec. 29, he tweeted, "New Twitter policy is to follow the science, which necessarily includes reasoned questioning of the science." Congressman Mike Gallagher called on all Americans to delete TikTok from their phones, saying, "TikTok is owned by ByteDance, and ByteDance is effectively controlled by the Chinese Communist Party The editor-in-chief of (CCP). ByteDance, for example, is a CCP Secretary" (Fox Business, Jan. 2, 2023). Gallagher said a large percentage of young Americans get their news from TikTok, and there is the danger of the Chinese government selectively editing their news. He said it would be like in 1958 if America allowed Russia's propaganda organization Pravda to buy the *New York Times*, the *Chicago* and other major news Post. publications. Florida Congressman Mike Waltz agrees. He says, "We need to ban TikTok as a country. BIOLOGICAL SEX (Friday Church News Notes, January 6, 2023, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Federal appeals court," Fox News, Dec. 31, 2022: "A federal appeals court has ruled in favor of a Florida school district's policy that separates school bathrooms by biological sex. The 11th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals announced its 7-4 decision on Friday, ruling that the St. Johns County School Board did not discriminate against transgender students based on sex, or violate federal civil rights law by requiring transgender students to use genderneutral bathrooms or bathrooms matching their biological sex. The court's decision was split down party lines, with seven justices appointed by Republican presidents siding with the school district and four justices appointed by Democratic presidents siding with Drew Adams, a biological female, who sued the district in 2017 after not being allowed to use the boys' restroom. ... Judge Barbara Lagoa wrote in the majority opinion that the school board policy advances the important governmental objective of protecting students' privacy in school bathrooms. She said the district's policy does not violate the law because it's based on biological sex, not gender identity. ... Two other federal appeals courts have ruled that transgender students can use bathrooms that accord with their

identities. Friday's decision increases the likelihood that the U.S. Supreme Court will take up the issue."

Pew Research Center's 13th annual report on restrictions on



analysis of how public health measures related to the coronavirus affected religious groups the year the pandemic took hold globally. The report also shows that overall government restrictions and social hostilities relating to religion remained fairly stable from 2019 to 2020. ... In 69 countries (35% of the total analyzed), one or more religious groups defied public health measures that were imposed during the ... Religious groups pandemic. criticized government-mandated public health measures in 54 countries (27% of all analyzed), often stating the rules were a violation of religious freedom. ... In nearly a quarter of countries, governments used physical force, such as arrests and raids, to make religious groups comply with COVID-19 public health measures. ... In 18 countries, authorities linked religious groups or gatherings to the spread of COVID-19. And in 39 countries (20% of all studied) private individuals or groups attributed the spread of the virus to religious groups. ... Meanwhile, the number of countries with either 'high' or 'very high' levels of government restrictions remained the same, at 57 countries (29%) from 2019 to 2020, a peak number for the study."

NASA LEARNING FROM THE ALBATROSS (Friday Church News Notes, January 6, 2023, www.wayoflife.org,



fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following excerpted from David Coppedge, "Capabilities of Migrating Birds," Evolution News & Science Today, Dec. 15, 2022: "Moving up to the heavyweight class, the wandering albatross is a fascinating bird that can travel thousands of miles without flapping its wings. With its 11-foot wingspan (the longest of any living bird), this iconic soaring champion of the southern oceans attracted the attention of the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute. Researchers show maps of its wanderings, and describe how it tilts and swoops in clever ways to take advantage of the wind's energy. Wandering albatrosses lack sufficient musculature to sustain continuous flapping flight for long periods of time; however they have a shoulder lock that mechanically holds their wings outstretched so that little energy is expended while soaring, according to the paper. The wandering albatross is so good at efficient use of wind energy, NASA has taken notice. The BBC News reported that an albatrossinspired glider has been designed for future flights on Mars. Unlike rovers or the highly successful Mars demonstration helicopter, a flyer designed like an albatross could fly for free on the Martian wind, swoop up the slopes of volcanoes, and stay aloft for long periods of time. A

demonstration Mars sailplane has been designed at the University of Arizona. With looks similar in proportions to the albatross, it can pack a small camera, and temperature and gas sensors to reconnoiter much farther than its battery-powered explorers can. While these other forms of transport have been partly limited by power needs, the glider would use energy available in the atmosphere itself, explained Adrien Bouskela, an aerospace engineering doctoral student at the University of Arizona. 'It's kind of a leap forward in those methods of extending missions,' he said."



Netanyahu also had a major role in developing Israel's now extensive economic relationships with nations all over the world. His family roots are deep in the Jabazinsky (non-socialist) side of the Zionist movement. His paternal grandfather was a rabbi and Zionist. His father immigrated to Israel before statehood. Born in 1949 in Tel Aviv, Benjamin spent part of his youth in the States (1956-58, 1963-67, 1972-76) and was educated at MIT. He and his two brothers were members of Sayeret Matkal, one the most elite Israeli military units. He participated in the Six-Day War

of 1967 and took a break from MIT in 1973 to fight in the Yom Kipper War. His older brother, Yanatan (Yoni), was killed in 1976 in the raid on Entebbe that resulted in the rescue of more than 100 Israelis. Netanyahu gives an insider's perspective of this raid. He writes with firsthand knowledge about Israel's wars against the Muslim nations and the war on terror within Israel's own borders. He describes his relationship with American presidents Ronald Reagan, George H.W. Bush, Bill Clinton, George W. Bush, Barack Obama, Donald Trump, and Joe Biden. It is clear that Israel is still living in the Times of the Gentiles, meaning she is under Gentile control to some extent. Also interesting are Netanyahu's
