
WHEN WAS THE PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE FIRST TAUGHT? ~ By David Cloud

It has long been alleged by those who interpret prophecy allegorically that the pre-tribulation Rapture is a new doctrine and cannot, therefore, be true.

Gary DeMar, President American Vision, says: "A majority of prophecy writers and speakers teach that the church will be raptured before a future tribulational period. But did you know that prior to about 1830 no such doctrine existed. No one in all of church history ever taught pretribulational rapture" (cited from "Why Christians Will Suffer Great Tribulation," Ourdailybreadbyjoeortiz).

When Demar says the pre-tribulation Rapture did not exist prior to 1830, he is referring to the *The Morning Watch* prophecy journal and the writings of John Darby which popularized dispensational theology in the 1800s.

Though this claim continues to be made, it is patently false.



MORGAN EDWARDS (1722-1795)

The Pre-Tribulation Rapture was taught by prominent Baptist leader Morgan Edwards. His *Two Academical Exercises on the Subjects Bearing the Following Titles; Millennium and Last-Novelties* was published in 1744 in Philadelphia.

Morgan Edwards was one of the most prominent Baptist leaders of his day. He was the pastor of the Baptist church in Philadelphia and the founder of Brown University, the first Baptist college in America. A summary of life was featured in the *Baptist Encyclopedia*. He was one of the first Baptist historians of repute, his *Materials Toward A History of the Baptists* (1770) providing a foundation for all subsequent works.

Following is what Edwards believed about Bible prophecy:

"The distance between the first and second resurrection will be somewhat more than a thousand years. I say, somewhat more; because the dead saints will be raised, and the living changed at Christ's 'appearing in the air' (I Thes. iv. 17); and this will be about three years and a half before the millennium, as we shall see hereafter: but will he and they abide in the air all that time? No: they will ascend to paradise, or to some one of those many 'mansions in the father's house' (John xiv. 2), and disappear during the foresaid period of time. The design of this retreat and disappearing will be to judge the risen and changed saints; for 'now the time is come that judgment must begin,' and that will be 'at the house of God' (I Pet. iv. 17)" (Edwards, Two Academical Exercises on the Subjects Bearing the Following Titles; Millennium and Last-Novelties, 1744).

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Bethel Baptist Church 4212 Campbell St. N. London, Ontario, N6P 1A6 Canada 519-652-2619 We should note that Edwards believed that the tribulation would only be 3.5 years, so he was not promoting a "pre-wrath" or mid-tribulation position.

Edwards first wrote the previous statement in an senior essay while at Bristol Baptist College in Bristol, England, before coming to America. At the beginning of the essay, in a comment addressed to his teacher, Edwards said,

"And is it come to my lot to treat of the Millennium, or Christ thousand years reign on earth? Thousand pities, sir, that you had not allotted the task to one of these older and abler students! But since it is your pleasure, I will do my possible: and IN THE ATTEMPT WILL WORK BY A RULE YOU HAVE OFTEN RECOMMENDED, VIZ. 'TO TAKE THE SCRIPTURES IN A LITERAL SENSE, EXCEPT WHEN THAT LEADS TO CONTRADICTION OR ABSURDITY."

This rule of literal interpretation of prophecy is exactly the rule from which Pre-Tribulationists work today. It is the rule that I teach in my courses on Bible interpretation.

Edwards bluntly rejected the allegorical approach. Of the millennial kingdom prophecies, he said, "Miserable work do the Antimillenarians make of these texts."

Edwards was writing 175 years before the destruction of the Ottoman Empire's hold on the land of Israel (1917) and 200 years before the establishment of the modern state of Israel (1948), yet he knew that these things would happen. Consider the following fascinating prediction that he made based on a literal interpretation of Bible prophecy:

"The Turkish or Ottoman Empire will be demolished; for otherwise the right owners cannot posses their inheritance... The twelve tribes (as observed before) will return to their ancient inheritance, else how can the twelve apostles be their judges? ... In this united capacity they will rebuild Jerusalem in its place, and the temple in its place on mount Zion; for in this temple will antichrist sit as god, and be the abomination mentioned by Daniel, and referred to by Christ" (Edwards, *Two Academical Exercises on the Subjects Bearing the Following Titles; Millennium and Last-Novelties*, 1744).

From the case of Morgan Edwards, it is obvious that there were Baptists in the 18th century in England and America

who held the literal principle of interpretation of Bible prophecy as opposed to the allegorical.

We must remember that most preachers do not leave a permanent record of their teaching. From Paul's day to ours, the vast majority of sound preachers have been common men as opposed to scholars.

Typically, they are not writers and do not publish books. In the record church history, we only have a tiny glimpse into what was happening, and that glimpse is based on the pittance that has survived of the little that was ever recorded.

"For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty" (1 Cor. 1:26-27).

EPHRAEM THE SYRIAN (AD c. 303-373)

We now go back to two centuries after the apostles. Ephraem is venerated as a "saint" by the Catholic and Orthodox churches, but they would not allow him to teach his doctrine of prophecy today.

Ephraem is called "the Syrian" because he lived in that region.

He was a voluminous writer. Many of his sermons and psalms are included in the 16-volume *Post-Nicene Library*. (The Council of Nicea was held in AD 325, and historians divide the "fathers" into Ante-Nicene, before 325, and Post-Nicene, after 325).

Some of Ephraem's sermons and hymns are used in the liturgy of Orthodox churches.

In the 1990s some of Ephraem's writings were translated into English for the first time, one of these being *On the Last Times, the Antichrist, and the End of the World*, A.D. 373.

The translation was done by Professor Cameron Rhoades of Tyndale Theological Seminary at the bequest of Grant R. Jeffrey. It was subsequently published in Jeffrey's 1995 book *Final Warning*.

It is obvious that Ephraem believed in a literal fulfillment of prophecy, including a Rapture of New Testament saints prior to the Tribulation.

"For all the saints and Elect of God are gathered, prior to the tribulation that is to come, and are taken to the Lord lest they see the confusion that is to overwhelm the world because of our sins" (Ephraem the Syrian, On the Last Times).

Observe that Ephraem taught that the saints will be taken to the Lord so they will not see the confusion that is to overwhelm the world, which is exactly what 1 Thessalonians 5:3-9 says.

Ephraem taught a literal antichrist who will sit in a literal rebuilt temple in Jerusalem, a literal 3.5 year Tribulation, a literal Two Witnesses or prophets who will preach in Jerusalem, a literal battle of Gog and Magog.

"And when the three and a half years have been completed, the time of the Antichrist, through which he will have seduced the world, after the resurrection of the two prophets, in the hour which the world does not know, and on the day which the enemy or son of perdition does not know, will come the sign of the Son of Man, and coming forward the Lord shall appear with great power and much majesty, with the sign of the word of salvation going before him, and also even with all the powers of the heavens with the whole chorus of the saints. ... Then Christ shall come and the enemy shall be thrown into confusion, and the Lord shall destroy him by the Spirit of his mouth. And he shall be bound and shall be plunged into the abyss of everlasting fire alive with his father Satan; and all people, who do his wishes, shall perish with him forever; but the righteous ones shall inherit everlasting life with the Lord for ever and ever" (Ephraem the Syrian, On the Last Times, the Antichrist, and the End of the World, A.D. 373).

Ephraem believed in the imminency of the return of Christ and urged Christians to live godly lives in expectation of His return.

EARLY CHRISTIANS TO AUGUSTINE

Actually, Ephraem the Syrian was not alone in interpreting Bible prophecy literally in his day.

He was living one generation from the era of Augustine (354-430), at which time there was a dramatic change. When Ephraem died in 373, Augustine was 19 years old.

It was in the era of Augustine that allegoricalism widely replaced the previous method of interpretation. Prior to this, it was common among Bible believers to interpret prophecy literally. They believed that Christ would return literally (and imminently), bind Satan, and establish a literal millennial kingdom on earth.

This is admitted by church historians.

William Newell says: "The early Church for 300 years looked for the imminent return of our Lord to reign, and they were right" (Newell, *Revelation*).

Phillip Schaaf said, "... the most striking point in the eschatology of the ante-Nicene age [prior to AD 325] is the prominent chiliasm, or millennarianism, that is the belief of a visible reign of Christ in glory on earth with the risen saints for a thousand years, before the general resurrection and judgment" (*History of the Christian Church*, 8 vols, Wm. B. Eerdmans Publishing Co., 1960, 2:614).

Henry Thiessen says, "It is clear ... that the Fathers held not only the pre-millennial view of Christ's coming, but also regarded that coming as imminent. The Lord had taught them to expect His return at any moment, and so they looked for Him to come in their day. Not only so, but they also taught His personal return as being immediately, with the exception of the Alexandrian Fathers, who also rejected other fundamental doctrines" (Thiessen, *Introductory Lectures in Systematic Theology*, p. 477).

In fact, Augustine, "the father of amillennialism," once believed in a literal millennium himself. He said, "I myself, too, once held this opinion. ... They who do believe them are called by the spiritual, Chiliasts, which we may literally reproduce by the name Millenarians" (Augustine, City of God, book 20, chapter 7).

The following statement by Irenaeus is an example of what was commonly believed among the early "church fathers," as they looked forward to Christ's return and the establishment of His kingdom:

"The predicted blessing, therefore, belongs unquestionably to the times of the kingdom, when the righteous shall bear rule upon their rising from the dead; when also the creation, having been renovated and set free, shall fructify with an abundance of all kinds of food, from the dew of heaven, and from the fertility of the earth. ... In like manner [the Lord declared] that ... all animals feeding [only] on the productions of the earth, should [in those days] become peaceful and harmonious among each other, and be in perfect subjection to man" (Irenaeus, Against Heresies, The Ante-Nicene Fathers).

The church at Antioch long interpreted Bible prophecy literally. Antioch was an important church founded by Barnabas and Paul, and it is from this church that the first foreign missionaries were ordained and sent out (Acts 11:19-26; 13:1-4). It was at Antioch that the believers were first called Christians.

Some of the preachers associated with Antioch were Lucian (died 312), Theodore (AD 350-428), Chrysostom (AD 354-407), Theodoret (AD 386-458), and Diodorus of Tarsus. These men interpreted Bible prophecy literally and believed in a literal millennium.

In his *History of Interpretation*, F.W. Farrar observed, "Diodorus of Tarsus' books were devoted to an exposition of Scripture in its literal sense, and he wrote a treatise, now unhappily lost, 'on the difference between allegory and spiritual insight'" (Farrar, pp. 213-15).

"The Antioch's school's two greatest exegetes, Theodore of Mopsuestia (AD 350-428) and John Chrysostom (AD 354-407), were 'anti-allegorical'" (Matthew Allen, "Theology Adrift: The Early Church Fathers and Their Views of Eschatology," bible.org).

Some of the early Christians after the apostles even taught a form of dispensationalism. Examples can be found in the extant writings of Justin Martyr, Irenaeus, Tertullian, and Methodius. Justin Martyr (100-165) believed in four phases of history in God's plan: From Adam to Abraham, from Abraham to Moses, from Moses to Christ, and from Christ to the eternal state. Irenaeus (120-202) taught something similar, dividing the dispensations into the creation to the flood, the flood to the law, the law to the gospel, the gospel to the eternal state.

THE ORIGIN OF THE ALLEGORICAL METHOD OF INTERPRETATION

The allegorical method of interpretation was invented by false teachers after the apostolic era as the apostasy was growing and spreading toward the formation of the Roman Catholic Church.

A school was established at Alexandria, Egypt, which became the headquarters for the allegorical method of interpretation. Egypt was a place where false teaching proliferated in the first centuries after Christ. Clement, who headed the school from AD 190 to 202, corrupted the Christian faith by mixing it with the worldly philosophy and allegoricalism of Philo. He taught many false doctrines, including purgatory, and believed that most men would eventually be saved even though Jesus said only a few would be (Mat. 7:14). "Clement saw the literal meaning of Scripture as being a 'starting point' for interpretation. Although it was 'suitable for the mass of Christians,' God revealed himself to the spiritually advanced through the 'deeper meaning' of Scripture. In every passage, a deeper or additional meaning existed beyond the primary or immediate sense" (Matthew Allen, "Theology Adrift: The Early Church Fathers and Their Views of Eschatology," bible.org).

Origen (AD 185-254) was one of the chief fathers of allegoricalism. He led the school at Alexandria from AD 202 to 232. Though he endured persecution and torture for the cause of Christ under the Emperor Decius in 250, Origen was laden down with heresies. Like Clement, he mixed the truth of the Bible with pagan philosophy. He taught that celibacy was a holy state above marriage, contrary to the teaching of the apostles. He taught baptismal regeneration, purgatory, and the pre-existence of the human soul. He taught that all men, even Satan and demons, would eventually be saved. He taught that the Holy Spirit was the first creature made by God, and denied the full Godhead of Jesus. He did not believe that the Scriptures are wholly inspired by God.

Origen claimed that "the Scriptures have little use to those who understand them literally." He described the literal meaning of Scripture as "bread" and encouraged the student to go beyond this to the "wine" of allegoricalism, whereby one can become intoxicated and transported to heavenly realms. Origen's commentaries contained a wealth of fanciful interpretations, abounding in "heretical

revisals of Scripture" (Frederick Nolan, *Inquiry into the Integrity of the Greek Vulgate*, p. 367).

Another father of allegoricalism was Augustine (AD 354-430), one of the fathers of the Roman Catholic Church. He was exalted as one of the "doctors" of Rome. Augustine invented the terrible and unbiblical doctrine of the inquisition that was used by the Catholic Church against Bible believers for more than 1,000 years. The German historian Neander observed that Augustine's teaching "contains the germ of the whole system of spiritual despotism, intolerance, and persecution, even to the court of the Inquisition." Augustine instigated fierce persecutions against the peace-loving, Bible-believing Donatists who were striving to maintain pure biblical churches. He taught that "the sacraments," such as baptism, were the means of salvation. He taught that Mary did not commit sin. He taught the heresy of purgatory. He was one of the fathers of infant baptism, claiming that unbaptized infants are lost and calling all who rejected infant baptism "infidels" and "cursed." He exalted the authority of "the church" over that of Scripture.

"Through Augustine, Origen's allegorical hermeneutic became the backbone of medieval interpretation of the Bible" (Matthew Allen, "Theology Adrift: The Early Church Fathers and Their Views of Eschatology," bible.org).

These heresies grew and became a fundamental part of the Roman Catholic and Orthodox Churches.

When the Protestant denominations (e.g., Anglican, Presbyterian, Lutheran, Methodist) broke away from Rome, one of the errors they brought with them was the allegorical interpretation of prophecy and its Replacement Theology.

THE APOSTLES

When it comes to sound doctrine, the bottom line is not what anyone has or has not taught in church history. It is "what saith the Lord?" Period. The Bible is the *sole* authority for faith and practice. It is not one authority among many, and it is not the authority only as confirmed by "church fathers" and "theologians."

The bottom line is that the apostles and early Christians interpreted prophecy literally.

They believed in an imminent return of Christ.

"For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; And **to wait for his Son from heaven**, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come" (1 Th. 1:9-10).

The apostles and prophets taught that the Lord's return is "at hand" (Ro. 13:12; Php. 4:5; 1 Pe. 4:7; Re. 1:3).

They believed in a Rapture of New Testament saints.

"But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words" (1 Th. 4:13-18).

They believed that the New Testament saints would be saved from the Tribulation to come.

"For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness. Therefore let us not sleep, as *do* others; but let us watch and be sober. For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night. But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Thessalonians 5:3-9).

They believed in a literal Antichrist.

"Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God" (2 Th. 2:3-4).

They believed in a literal return of Christ and a literal fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy.

"Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began" (Acts 3:19-21).

They believed in a literal fulfillment of Israel's covenants following the church age.

"For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins" (Romans 11:25-27).

OTHER PRE-DARBY PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE OUOTES

Irenaeus (AD 130 - 202)

"Those nations however, who did not of themselves raise up their eyes unto heaven, nor returned thanks to their Maker, nor wished to behold the light of truth, but who were like blind mice concealed in the depths of ignorance, the word justly reckons "as waste water from a sink, and as the turning-weight of a balance — in fact, as nothing;"(1) so far useful and serviceable to the just, as stubble conduces towards the growth of the wheat, and its straw, by means of combustion, serves for working gold. And therefore, when in the end the Church shall be suddenly caught up from this, it is said, "There shall be tribulation such as has not been since the beginning, neither shall be."(2) For this is the last contest of the righteous, in which, when they overcome they are crowned with incorruption."

- Against Heresies, Book 5, 5. 29

Cyprian (AD 200-258)

"We who see that terrible things have begun, and know that still more terrible things are imminent, may regard it as the greatest advantage to depart from it as quickly as possible. Do you not give God thanks, do you not congratulate yourself, that by an early departure you are taken away, and delivered from the shipwrecks and disasters that are imminent? Let us greet the day which assigns each of us to his own home, which snatches us hence, and sets us free from the snares of the world and restores us to paradise and the kingdom."

Victorinus (AD 240-303)

"And the heaven withdrew as a scroll that is rolled up." For the heaven to be rolled away, that is, that the Church shall be taken away. "And every mountain and the islands removed from their places intimate that in the last persecution all men departed from their places; that is, that the good will be removed, seeking to avoid persecution."

Thomas Vincent (1634-1678)

"the righteous ... suddenly caught up together in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; which sight will be fearful and amazing to them, when they perceive themselves to be left behind. ... O the fear and trouble which will be upon the spirits of those unbelieving Christ-less, grace-less sinners ... some of them linked in the nearest relations to them, when their believing relations shall be caught away from them, and carried up into the air, with the rest of the glorious train of Saints, when themselves shall remain below upon the earth ... Friends will be together at that day as at other times, not expecting Christ's coming ... Suppose that the heavens should just now open and you should hear the sound of the last Trumpet, and Jesus Christ should descend. ... all you that are impenitent and unbelievers, would be left behind: and think what terror would fall upon you...

Joseph Mede (1586-1639)

"After this, our gathering together unto Christ at His coming...The saints being translated into the air ... and they may be preserved during the conflagration of the earth, and the works thereof: 2 Pet. 3.10. that as Noah and his family were preserved from the deluge by being lifted up above the waters in the ark, so should the saints at the conflagration be lifted up in the clouds, unto their ark, Christ, to be preserved there from the deluge of fire, wherein the wicked shall be consumed."

Jeremiah Burroughs (1600-1646)

Nathaniel Homes (1599-1678)

"all mankind shall rise in their order, Christ the first fruits...afterwards, they that are Christs at his coming...notes a distance of time of above a thousand and a halfe of yeers...the rapture of the Saints into the clouds, to be their present translation into heaven...this our gathering together unto Christ at his coming (so the Apostle calls this rapture, 2 Thess.2.1.) wee shall from henceforth never lose his presence, but always enjoy it, partly on earth, during his reign of the thousand yeers, and partly in heaven, when wee shall be translated thither. [Why] this rapture of the Saints on high to meet the Lord in the clouds, rather then to wait his coming to the earth. What if it bee, that they may be preserved during the conflagration of the earth, and the works thereof, 2 Pet.3.10. That as Noah, and his

family were preserved from the deluge, by being lift up above the waters in the Ark, so should the Saints at the conflagration bee lift up in the clouds unto their Ark, Christ, to be preserved there from the Deluge of fire, wherein the wicked shall be consumed?"

William Aspinwall (1605-1662)

"If God by some voice from heaven, I mean out of his Churches, say Come up hither, Rev.11.12,13. Follow his call, and fear not enemies; though you see them, & they see you ascend up to heaven, you shall be safe. Some commotion or earthquake will ensue, but no detriment to you that obey the voice from heaven, The detriment will be to the enemies themselves..."

John Browne (1582-1659)

"the hundred forty and four thousand, who are called Virgins, cannot be said to be the Virgins that attend the Spouse, the Lamb's Wife, seeing that they are upon the Earth after the said Spouse is taken up. ...then will follow the calling of the two Tribes of Judah and Benjamin to Jerusalem...and then the City is built, which bringing back of the ten Tribes will not be completed till after the Saints are taken up, when as before that time both Jerusalem and the Temple will be built, and Sacrifice offered..."

William Hook (1600-1677)

"There are several Resurrections mentioned in the Scriptures. But great troubles will follow this Resurrection [pre-Trib rapture] after a short time...which will shake the power of the Beast...till it come to Armageddon... The Beast lives in Hell upon Earth [tribulation], the Saints in Heaven...when they ascended up to Heaven in a cloud, their Enemies beheld them. They rise up from Antichrist and his Pollutions, and all his earthly and hellish waies...and at last, they shall come with Christ to judge the world. ...

"Until then they are protected, somewhat like as when the Egyptians pursued the Israelites into the Red Sea..."

Anonymous Tract (1699)

They shall be caught up in the Clouds to meet the Lord in the Air...in this appearing of Christ...but here it's another sight of Christ, viz. as their Judge: for so he will be to the Sinner and ungodly, when he shall come the second time in the Clouds of Heaven...coming to enter upon his Kingdom here on Earth, with all his Saints in a glorified State, after having received their gloried bodies, and after meeting their Lord in the air, prepared for this great Assize and Judgment of the World."

CONCLUSION

Brethren, do not let anyone rob you of a literal interpretation of prophecy and the imminency of the return of Christ, which is the believer's Blessed Hope. We are looking for Christ, not for the Antichrist.

A large portion of the Bible consists of prophecy, and much of it has not yet been fulfilled. The portion that has been fulfilled has been fulfilled literally. We think of the great Messianic prophecies of Christ's first coming in Psalm 22 and Isaiah 53. The prophecies are breathtaking in detail, and every detail was fulfilled "literally."

Further, if we do not interpret prophecy according to the "normal literal" method, there is no way to determine for sure what it means.

A literal interpretation of prophecy results in the doctrine that the church is not Israel, and that Israel's covenants will yet be fulfilled after the church age.

"For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins" (Romans 11:25-27).

The 70th Week of Daniel 9:24-27 pertains to Israel, not to the church. Every event of the 70 Weeks pertains to "thy [Daniel's] people, and the holy city [Jerusalem]" (verse 24). Before God turns His attention, so to speak, to fulfilling Israel's ancient covenants, including the

Davidic covenant of 2 Samuel 7, the Church will be Raptured and will not see the coming of the antichrist and the other signs that immediately precede the glorious return of Christ.

The doctrine of the Pre-Tribulation Rapture is not a minor one. Jesus, Paul, James, and Peter taught that the return of Christ is imminent and is to be expected at any time (Mat. 24:44; Phil. 4:5; Jam. 5:8-9; 1 Pet. 4:7). The early Christians lived in this expectation (1 Th. 1:9-10).

The doctrine of a Pre-Tribulational Rapture is a great motivator for purifying the Christian life.

- 1. It encourages the believer in trials and persecutions. "Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words" (1 Thessalonians 4:17-18).
- 2. It keeps the church's focus on the Great Commission (Mat. 28:18-20; Mk 16:15; Lk. 24:44-48; Acts 1:8). D.L. Moody had it right when he said: "I look upon this world as a wrecked vessel. God has given me a lifeboat and said to me, 'Moody, save all you can.""
- 3. It motivates believers to be busy in the Lord's work (1 Cor. 15:58).
- 4. It motivates believers to live obedient lives (1 Jn. 3:1-3; 1 Th. 5:4-7).
- 5. It motivates believers to separate from evil (Tit. 2:13-14).
- 6. 6. It keeps believers on the outlook for heresy and apostasy (2 Timothy 4:3-4; 1 John 2:24-28).

Recently I received the following communication:

Dear Bro. Cloud,

I just finished reading your statement on responding to emails, and I fully understand. I have been receiving your Friday Church News Notes and O Timothy for many years, and I really appreciate the material you produce.

I will try to keep this short. I can't think of any time I really disagree with you, but some times i see things a little differently. Repentance is one of those things. Your article in O Timothy on the corruption of evangelism was great, I have been preaching the same thing for many years, and I receive the same kind of responses.

I'm a bit older than you (82), and I regret the change in the definition of repentance. It, as well as the other things you mention in your article, has resulted in many being given false assurance of salvation, and leaving them on the road to Hell.

My question is on what we are to repent of? Many years ago I did a search through the Scriptures looking for the answer. I looked up every place in the Bible where the word repent, in any form, is used. Then I looked up every Hebrew and Greek word that they were translated from. I may have missed something, but I could not find any place where a lost person was told to repent of their sin or sins. I did find a passage where Christians were to turn from their sins, but the Greek word used there is never translated repent.

What I did find was, Hebrews 6:1, which says one of the foundational principles of the doctrine of Christ is "repentance from dead works." Every religion I know of, with the exception of Biblical Christianity, including

many so-called Christian denominations, teach that good works are, at least in part, necessary for salvation. I do believe that those who are truly saved will turn from their sin, but it seems to me that we are to repent of our own efforts to save ourselves (good works), and turn to Christ and His work on the cross alone for salvation.

This is longer than I wanted it to be, but your opinion on this, long or short, would be appreciated. I will understand if I don't get any response, but even a short one would be appreciated.

Let me close by saying, keep up the good work you do. I recommend your material to everyone I can because I think the service you give is some of the best available on line.

REPLY FROM BROTHER CLOUD

Hello, Bro. _____. I appreciate the gracious communication. I'm glad to hear that you are still kicking at 82, though probably not as high as in former days.

As for what the sinner is to "repent of," that is a very, very good question. Since it gets right to the heart of the debate about repentance and evangelism, I will answer your question, though I have written many reports and books on the subject.

For the sake of those who don't know me, let me say that I have studied this subject pretty seriously since the first year I was saved. In about 1974, I read Bruce Lackey's "Repentance Is More Than a Change of Mind." That was about the time I encountered the practice of Quick Prayerism. Like you, in subsequent years, I studied and re-studied every passage in the

Bible on the subject of repentance. I've read many reports and books on all sides of the subject and communicated personally with a great many men. That doesn't mean I'm right, of course. It is only to explain my research for those who might not be familiar with it.

Studying Bible words has been my delight for half a century. In defining Bible words, context is king, but there are other important principles. I define Bible words in a multiplicity of ways: by their Hebrew and Greek meanings, including root studies, and by how they are translated in the King James Bible, and by how they are used in biblical context. This is one of the many ways that the King James Bible is the peerless English Bible. It is not just a translation; it is a lexicon of Hebrew, Greek, and Syriac. I examine how the King James translators translated the various biblical words.

You used Hebrews 6:1 to define repentance. Salvation definitely requires repentance from dead works. But that is only one definition from one passage.

As you know, the main Greek word translated "repent" and "repentance" is metanoea (metanoia). Strong defines it as "to think differently or afterwards, i.e. reconsider (morally, feel compunction) ... (subjectively) compunction (for guilt, including reformation); by implication, reversal (of (another's) decision)." The Complete Word Study Bible defines it as "change of mind from evil to good or from good to better." Vine defines it as "to 'perceive afterwards' (meta, 'after,' implying 'change,' noeo, 'to perceive'; nous, 'the mind, the seat of moral reflection') ... hence signifies 'to change one's mind or purpose,' always, in the NT, involving a change for the better, an amendment."

The basic definition of the Greek word doesn't tell us much about what repentance is. It doesn't tell us what the sinner is to repent of, for example. For that, we must examine the context of the word in each passage and look at the examples of salvation in Scripture.

Repentance is not to stop sinning (which is works and has no efficacy). Biblical repentance is a change of mind toward God and sin that produces a change of life by the regenerating power of God. I see this everywhere in Scripture. I see it in John the Baptist's preaching to "bring forth fruits therefore meet for repentance" (Mt. 3:8), in Paul's "do works meet for repentance" (Ac. 26:20), in how the Thessalonians "turned to God from

idols to serve the living and true God" (1 Th. 1:9-10), in how Christ dealt with the rich young ruler (Mt. 19:16-22), in the Prodigal Son's determination to return to the Father and thus leave the old life behind (Lu. 15:17-19), in Zacchaeus' change of mind in regard to his business practices (Lu. 19:8-9), in 2 Timothy 2:19, "The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity," etc. In Acts 17, Paul commanded all men to repent of idolatry (Ac. 17:29-30). We see this in Revelation 9:20-21, where the people "repented not of the works of their hands ... neither repented they of their murders nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts." They are condemned in God's Word for not repenting of their sins. (The second repentance in this passage is the standard Greek word metanoeo.) In the Christian life, repentance definitely has to do with repentance of sin ("repent of her fornication ... repent of their deeds," Re. 2:21-22). See also Re. 2:5; 3:3, 19. (In all of these verses in Revelation 2-3 metanoeo is used.)

Do you believe that someone can be saved when they have no intention to stop worshipping idols, stop fornicating, stop homosexuality, stop thieving business practices, stop a murder plot, stop an adulterous affair, etc.? I recall a pastor who said that if he witnessed to Dennis Rodman (a pro-basketball player with the reputation of a flaming homosexual) and Rodman told him he did not intend to change anything, he would still try to lead him in a sinner's prayer. I recall an evangelistic campaign in Maine some years ago in which people were approached as follows: "If I told you that you can be saved today and you don't have to change anything, would you be interested?" There is a sense, of course, in which you can be saved and not change anything, because there is no change you can make in order to be saved, and the change that does come is by God's regenerating power. But there is no example of salvation in the Bible without change.

In my 50 years of preaching experience, I have seen large numbers of individuals reject the gospel for the simple reason that they intend to hold on to some pet sin or to a sinful lifestyle in general. It is probably the main reason people don't get saved. We have seen thousands of people attend services and Bible studies and preaching meetings in South Asia since 1979 and like what they hear and come near to being saved and even "believe," then disappear because of fear of relatives, love of idols, etc.

We don't preach that people have to turn from sin. We preach that people must repent toward God and exercise faith toward the Lord Jesus Christ. (I don't use the term "repent of your sin," though I don't believe it is wrong to use that term, if properly explained.) We preach what Paul preached, that individuals must repent toward God (Ac. 20:21). The way I see it, to repent toward God is to have a change a mind about who is Boss. It is to repent of breaking God's law, of being at enmity with Him, of being a rebel. Repentance is something that happens in the heart. It is a quiet surrender to God's authority and holiness and justice. This is what happened to me at age 23. Before that, I "believed" in Jesus from my earliest memories and was a reprobate Baptist church member, but the missing element was biblical repentance. God requires this of every sinner who will be saved. According to Paul's summary of salvation, repentance toward God is accompanied by faith toward the Lord Jesus Christ (Ac. 20:21). This is to trust 100% in Christ as only Saviour and in His atoning sacrifice. That part requires rejecting all false religions and false christs and selfworks. Such a repentance and faith results in supernatural regeneration which always results in a change of life (2 Co. 5:17; Eph. 2:10; Tit. 2:11-14, etc.).

We explain to sinners that God, in His love and grace, has purchased the gift of salvation for them at great expense to Himself, and if they will receive Christ, He will give them that gift and change their lives forever. We explain what it means to receive salvation in a biblical fashion.


I have gone into these matters extensively in the Bible courses "Sowing and Reaping" and "Repentance and Soul Winning."

God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. 

STATES TAKING STEPS TO PROTECT CHILDREN FROM **SOCIAL MEDIA** (Friday Church News Notes, October 27, 2023, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - New York officials have introduced two bills to limit children's access to addictive social media feeds and protect their mental health. The bills are supported by Governor Kathy Hochul and Attorney General Letitia James ("New York Introduce Bills," PetaPixel, Oct. 12, 2023). The Stop Addictive Feeds Exploitation for Kids Act (SAFE Act) "requires social media companies to restrict harmful and addictive features on their platforms." It would "allow parents to opt their children out of getting feeds curated by an algorithm" and "ban social media companies from sending notification to minors between 12:00 and 06:00 without parental consent," among other things. New York lawmakers said that "social media is a major factor behind the worsening mental health crisis among children." Multiple states have filed lawsuits against TikTok and Meta (parent company of and Instagram) Facebook "harming the mental health of children and teens" by "leveraging highly powerful algorithms and manipulative design features to entice young users to use the app." Arkansas claims Meta "knowingly designed its

social media apps to create addiction for its younger users" ("Arkansas Sues TikTok and Meta," *Petapixel*, Mar. 29, 2023). Other states are Utah, Texas, and Indiana. If the world sees great danger in social media, how much more should Bible-believing parents and churches! (See the book *Spiritual Safety in the Facebook Age*, https://www.wayoflife.org/publications/books/spiritual_safety_in_the_facebook_age.php.)

INTERVARSITY PRESS PROMOTING NEW AGE ENNEAGRAM (Friday Church News Notes, October 27, 2023, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "InterVarsity Press Claims Success," Lighthouse Trails, Oct. 12, 2023: "The InterVarsity Press news release announced the seven-year anniversary of the release of The Road Back to You by Ian Morgan Cron, a book about the Enneagram. ... The release goes on to claim that because of that book, over a million people have been introduced to the Enneagram. The release's author says: 'So, today I am celebrating that 1 million people have found a way to better understand their own motivations and move toward becoming their truest self.' You see, contemplatives believe that we all have a 'true self,' which, they teach, is a good pure self, and through meditative practices, we can gain awareness of this true pure self. They believe this because they believe that



within each person, there is divinity (God). ... In 2019, we published a booklet titled The Enneagram—An Enlightening Tool or an Enticing Deception? by Lois Putnam and the LT Editors. We believe it has more than ample evidence to show the erroneous and unbiblical nature of the Enneagram. And the real name behind the Enneagram is not Ian Morgan Cron but rather the Catholic mystic panentheist priest Richard Rohr ... [T]he Enneagram, a nine-pointed diagram [is] used to determine personality traits and character tendencies. While it may seem harmless and nothing more than a useful tool, the Enneagram is a seducing lure to deception and an example of what the Bible refers to as 'the wiles of the devil.' ... After Rohr learned about the Enneagram in the 1970s, he shared his Enneagram teaching on ten tapes, later writing his classic best-selling book, Discovering the Enneagram: An Ancient Tool for a New Spiritual Journey (now titled The Enneagram: A Christian Perspective). In Rohr's book, he explains that the underlying premise behind the Enneagram is that each person has a 'true self' and a 'false self,' and with the help of the Enneagram, we can identify our true selves, and thus having identified it, we can now be spiritually transformed to live in that true self. ... When Rohr, who is an outspoken panentheist, says 'True Self in God,' he is referring to his belief that the true self is the God within every human being."

GEORGIA SUPREME COURT RULES ABORTION BAN CONSTITUTIONAL (Friday Church News Notes, October 27, 2023, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Georgia Supreme Court," The Hill,



Oct. 24, 2023: "Georgia's 'heartbeat' abortion ban is constitutional and will remain in place for now, the state Supreme Court ruled Tuesday. The 6-1 ruling rejected a lower court's reasoning that the six-week abortion ban was unconstitutional. ... The ruling means access to abortion in the state will continue to be restricted, and most abortions will remain illegal once a physician can detect fetal cardiac activity, which is usually around six weeks gestation, before many people know they are pregnant. The ruling was praised by anti-abortion groups, including Susan B. Anthony (SBA) Pro-Life America. ... The ruling is not the end of the legal fight over the state's abortion ban. The case was remanded back to the trial court to rule on the remaining claims brought by the plaintiffs that the ban violates Georgians' rights to privacy and equal protection under the state constitution. The abortion ban in Georgia was one of a wave of 'trigger ban' laws across the country that took effect shortly after Roe was overturned. The law includes some exceptions for rape and incest, as long as a police report is filed, and allows for later abortions when the mother's life is at risk or a pregnancy is deemed 'medically futile."

FROM UNISEX FASHION TO DRAG QUEENS (Friday Church News Notes, October 27, 2023, www.wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143)

- The contemporary worship band Caedmon's Call was formed in 1993 with six founding members (Cliff Young, Danielle Glenn, Todd Bragg, Cari Harris, Doug Elmore, and Aaron Tate). Derek Webb joined early on and wrote many of the group's songs. Webb left in 2003 to pursue a solo career, and he has been on and off with the band since then (2007-2011, 2022). As with the vast majority of contemporary worship groups, there was always a unisex emphasis in Caedmon's Call (founded 1993). It is one of the many ways that they are conformed to the world in direct disobedience to God's Word (Romans 12:2). Some of the men wear earrings and long hair, while the female of the group wears pants. This unisex theme has been taken to its logical conclusion by Derek Webb, who now wears dresses, makeup, and wigs. Unisex fashion is not innocent. Scripture says God made man "male and female" (Ge. 1:27), and this distinction is to be maintained in dress. "The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the LORD thy God" (De. 22:5). "Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him? But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering" (1 Co. 11:14-15). Mary Quant and other fashion designers of



1960s understood the the revolutionary nature of unisex dress. In 2019, the Victoria & Albert Museum in London had a major exhibit on Quant, who put women in men's attire: pants, ties, suit jackets, and short hair. One display, entitled "Boys Will Be Girls," says that Quant "subverted menswear." Another display said, "Trousers are considered inappropriate for women [but] Quant wears them anywhere she wants." Mary Quant knew that trousers on women is not an issue merely of comfort and freedom of movement. There is a direct path from unisex fashion to the homosexualtranssexual movement. In 2023, Derek Webb published the song "Boys Will Be Girls," which presents transsexualism as something Jesus would support. This is exactly how Victoria & Albert Museum described Mary Quant's fashion revolution. On Twitter, Oct. 13, 2023, Webb promoted the sale of a cup bearing an image of him in a dress (drag queen attire) and the slogan "but i say unto you, you're beautiful and free" from his song "God in Drag." Webb presumptuously uses the words of Jesus ("But I say unto you") from the Gospels to claim Christ's support for homosexuality.

The pontiff spoke with the cochairs of the Global Network of Rainbow Catholics, a coalition that draws together LGBTO Catholic organizations from across continents. Among U.S.-based members are DignityUSA, New Ways Ministry and Fortunate Families. In an interview with National Catholic Reporter shortly after the encounter, co-chair Marianne Duddy-Burke ... called the meeting 'a big day for LGBTQ Catholics.' 'I was in tears,' she said. 'We have great hope for what he is trying to do to make the



church more inclusive.' ... Francis has focused on LGBTO Catholics in an uncommon way over the past few weeks. On Oct. 17, the pope held an historic, 50-minute meeting with Loretto Sr. Jeannine Gramick, a lifelong advocate for LGBTQ ministry who had previously been reprimanded by the Vatican and several U.S. bishops for her work. Francis also met on Sept. 29 with Jesuit Fr. James Martin, editor of the LGBTQ Catholic publication Outreach, and indicated in a letter released on Oct. 2 that he is open to allowing Catholic blessing ceremonies for same-sex couples. The pope also recently wrote a note to the executive director of Fortunate Families, a Lexington, Kentuckybased Catholic ministry for the LGBTQ community that is part of the Rainbow Catholics coalition. 'Thank you for your ministry,' Francis told Stan 'JR' Zerkowski."

EUTHANASIA IN CANADA **MAKES UP 4% OF ALL DEATHS** Church News (Friday Notes. November 2023. 3, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) -The following is excerpted from "Canadian government reports," Fox News. Oct. 2023: 26, government of Canada published its fourth annual report on 'Medical Assistance in Dying' (MAID) this month, a document revealing that the number of MAID deaths--commonly referred to as euthanasia or assisted



suicide--in the country last year was 13,241 accounting for 4.1% of all deaths in Canada. It noted that this represented a 'growth rate of 31.2%' for the procedure compared to the previous year. The report added the total number of euthanasia deaths in Canada since MAID was legalized in 2016 amounts to 44,958 deaths. ... This month, Conservative MP Ed Fast told *The Toronto Star* he worried that the procedures--now that it could potentially be implemented on those suffering mental illness-could contribute to a 'culture of death' in the country." At least 463 of the people who died by assisted suicide in 2022 "were individuals whose natural deaths were not reasonably foreseeable."

EUTHANASIA'S SLIPPERY SLOPE IN THE NETHERLANDS (Friday Church News Notes. November 2023. 10, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "The Netherlands is euthanizing children," The Bridgehead, Apr. 11, 2023: "[In] the Netherlands, which on April 1, 2002, became the first Western country to legalize euthanasia since Nazi Germany, euthanasia deaths continue to rise. According to Dutch News: 'Euthanasia killings rose by nearly 14.1 percent in 2022, totaling 8.720 deaths. That's 5.1 percent of all deaths in the Netherlands. Since about half of deaths come from things such as accidents or sudden heart attacks, that means around 10 percent of deaths in which a patient was under medical care were from lethal jabs. The same percentage of USA deaths would be about 170,000 annually. (The USA totals about 3,400,000 deaths per year.) 115 mentally ill people were euthanized



in the Netherlands (sometimes conjoined with consensual organ harvesting). 379 elderly couples received joint euthanasia. ... 288 with people dementia were euthanized. In the Netherlands, killing can be ordered ahead of time by filling out an advance directive.' The Netherlands and Canada are now on the cutting edge of medical killing, with the Dutch Ministry of Health recommending back in 2019 the government legalize euthanasia for terminally ill children between the ages of one and 12, with a majority of 72 doctors polled for the report stating that it is morally acceptable to euthanize preteen children who are suffering without prospect of improvement deliberately vague framing) if their parents request it."

The margaritaville web site eulogizes Buffett in these words: "We celebrate his life, believe his spirit lives on like a never-ending encore, and will see his radiant smile and that twinkle in his eye when we look towards the sun and will continue to share his way of life wherever, whenever we can." Actually, the glorification of a margaritaville lifestyle was



deception. He admitted years ago that longer lived he no drinking/smoking lifestyle. He said, "[P]eople start dying, you know. And having nervous breakdowns. And then you go, 'Wait a minute here'" (Jimmy Buffett's Life Is Nothing Like It Seems," Nikiswift.com, Feb. 3, 2023). It is obvious that you can't party very long without facing destruction. He "cleaned up his act," sought therapy for his "alcoholic addiction," and gave up marijuana. Building on his mindless hit song, Buffett built a billion dollar financial empire, with Margaritaville tours, restaurants, hotels, casinos, resorts, cottages, sea cruises, and other products. increasingly-"[T]he wealthy musician compartmentalized, keeping the trappings of the beach bum in his businesses while moving on to a much more lavish life for himself.
