I HOLD TO THE DOCTRINES OF GRACE ~ By David Cloud


hold to the doctrines of grace that are clearly taught in Scripture. I absolutely love God's grace.

I am a Bible man. I love everything about the Bible. I've been a Bible man ever since the night I was converted in a motel room in Daytona Beach, Florida, in 1973.

That night I came to believe that the Bible is God's infallible Word, verbally and plenarily, though I didn't yet know those terms. I have never doubted a word of the Bible since then. I don't understand it all, but I believe it all.

The kind man that led me to Christ gave me a large King James Bible, and that has been the Book of my life ever since. He taught me to study the Bible diligently and to rightly divide it and to test absolutely everything through the lens of Scripture.

I believe the following doctrines of grace, and I rejoice daily in this great light:



I believe in the sovereignty of God, and I delight in it.

I believe God is Almighty, all-wise, infinite, eternal, King of kings, the only God, the most High. He "sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof *are* as grasshoppers ... That bringeth the princes to nothing; he maketh the judges of the earth as vanity" (Isa. 40:22-23). "The LORD sitteth upon the flood; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever" (Isa. 29:10).

The heaven is His throne and the earth is His footstool (Isa. 66:1). He "worketh all things after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11). He is working all things together according to His eternal plan "that in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him" (Eph. 1:10).

God--not revolutions or politics or economics or dynasties--is the Author of human history. He "changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding" (Da. 2:21).

No matter what men determine to do, God is in charge. "The lot is cast into the lap; but the whole disposing thereof *is* of the LORD" (Pr. 16:33). The God who made the world and all things therein "hath made of one blood all nations of men, for to dwell on the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation" (Ac. 17:24-26).

I can say with Abraham Kuyper, "There is not a square inch in the whole domain of our human existence over which Christ, who is Sovereign over all, does not cry: 'Mine!'"

I believe every son of Adam is unrighteous and undone before God, having a heart that is desperately wicked, not good, spiritually blind, dead in trespasses and sins, estranged from God, at enmity with God, under the power of the devil, totally unworthy of salvation; and it is absolutely impossible for a sinner to save himself by any means whatsoever, not by "good" works, not by willing to be righteous, not by sincerity, not by devotion, not by religion, not by sacraments, not by priestcraft, not by asceticism or self-abuse or mysticism, not by peyote or LSD, not by psychology or any other of man's devices.

I believe salvation is 100%---I repeat, 100%---a work of God's grace on the basis of the vicarious atonement of Jesus Christ which is the full and acceptable propitiation whereby the sinner is forgiven, cleansed, justified, adopted and given an eternal inheritance in Christ. Salvation is 100% God's grace, God's work, God's provision. "So then *it is* not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy" (Ro. 9:16).

"For by grace are ye saved through faith, and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast" (Eph. 2:8-9).

I can sing with Isaac Watts, "Forbid it, Lord, that I should boast save in the death of Christ, my God! All the vain things that charm me most, I sacrifice them through his blood."

I agree with Isaac Watts' father, "Avoid their doctrine of meriting by works of obedience, for there is some sin that pollutes our best duties, and we can deserve nothing at God's hand but wrath. All the good we receive comes of His free grace."

I sing with Elvina Hall, "For nothing good have I whereby Thy grace to claim, I'll wash my garments white in the blood of Calv'ry's Lamb. Jesus paid it all, all to Him I owe."

I believe that God wants all men to be saved, because He says He does.

That is God's sovereign will and desire. He "will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth" (1 Ti. 2:4) and He is "not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance" (2 Pe. 3:9) and He "hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all" (Ro. 11:32). Thus I believe that all men can be saved. The gospel is good news for all men. Christ commanded the gospel to be preached to all men and, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned" (Mr. 16:15-16). I don't believe Christ is playing games with sinners by having good news preached to all of them when it isn't actually for all of them. I believe the angel's message of "good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people" (Lu. 2:10). Comparing Scripture with Scripture, I don't believe that merely means all types of people.

I believe that Christ died for all men in the sense that He made it possible for all men to be saved.

I believe this because the Bible plainly teaches it. He "gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time" (1 Ti. 2:5). He "is the propitiation for our sins: and not

for ours only, but also for *the sins of* the whole world" (1 Jo. 2:2). "To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation" (2 Co. 5:18).

I believe that sinners cannot draw themselves or enlighten themselves or awaken themselves or raise themselves from the dead or bring themselves to Christ.

All of that is God's work of grace. Scripture plainly teaches that Christ draws all sinners (Joh. 12:32) and enlightens all sinners (Joh. 1:9) and the Spirit of God operates in all sinners through the preaching of the gospel (Joh. 16:8-11; Ac. 1:8) to make it *possible* for men to be saved.

I believe that a sinner *can* respond to this work of God and believe in Christ savingly, and a sinner *can* reject the work of God.

I believe this because the Bible plainly teaches it.

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, *thou* that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under *her* wings, and YE WOULD NOT!" (Mt. 23:37).

"Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. And YE WILL NOT COME to me, that ye might have life" (Joh. 5:39-40).

I believe in, and rejoice in, election, predestination, and foreknowledge.

"For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate *to be* conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified" (Ro. 8:29).

"Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied" (1 Pe. 1:2). "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will" (Eph. 1:4-5).

I believe that the gospel invitation is a genuine "whosoever" invitation, not an invitation reserved for a certain part of mankind. I believe this because the Bible teaches it in multiple passages, the plain meaning of which cannot be mistaken.

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH in him should not perish, but have eternal life" (Joh. 3:14-15).

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (Joh. 3:16).

"Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And WHOSOEVER liveth and BELIEVETH in me shall never die" (Joh. 11:25-26).

"I am come a light into the world, that WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH on me should not abide in darkness" (Joh. 12:46).

"And it shall come to pass, *that* WHOSOEVER SHALL CALL on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Ac. 2:21).

"To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH in him shall receive remission of sins" (Ac. 10:43).

"As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH on him shall not be ashamed" (Ro. 9:33).

"For the scripture saith, WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Ro. 10;11-13).

"And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And WHOSOEVER WILL, let him take the water of life freely" (Re. 22:17).

I believe that the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on Calvary and His resurrection three days later are the central events of human history.

His sacrifice was substitutionary. He is the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world (Joh. 1:29). "... he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised

for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all" (Isa. 53:5-6). His blood and death was the propitiation for the sins of the world to satisfy man's infractions against God's holy law. It was sufficient to save all men. It was accomplished fully on the cross and was finished there. "For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified" (Heb. 10:14).


Mastering the English Bible is practical throughout. Bible teaching does not accomplish God's will until it produces born again salvation and holy living (2 Ti. 3:16-17). We emphasize the believer's life as a priest (1 Pe. 2:5), pilgrim (1 Pe. 2:11), ambassador (2 Co. 5:20), builder of the New Testament church (1 Co. 3:9-15), builder of the home (Eph. 5:22 - 6:4), teacher (Heb. 5:12-14), spiritual warrior (Eph. 6:10-19), and minister of spiritual gifts (Ro. 12:3-8).

Mastering the English Bible is a package that consists of textbooks (totaling 3,000 pages), syllabi, student assignments, review questions, tests, and test scores. Many of the segments also have video classes (242 in total). These contain the lectures plus multi-7,500 featuring media presentations maps. archaeology photos, Bible pictures, reconstructive drawings of ancient sites, video clips, and other visual aids gleaned from museums plus research trips to Israel, Greece, Turkey, Jordan, Egypt, and Europe. e have been working on this project for 50 years. I published my first book in 1974, the first year I was saved. I published my first Bible course in 1980. It was on Bible prophecy. Beginning in 2002, we published the *Advanced Bible Studies Series*, consisting of 21 courses. The Way of Life Bible College replaces that series. All of the courses are either brand new or highly revised.

The Way of Life Bible College is both a concept and a curriculum.

First, the Way of Life Bible College is a concept that a sound New Testament church is a serious training institution.

Our passion is for sound New Testament churches. The church we see in Scripture doesn't merely *have* a Bible college, it *is* a Bible college. It is not merely a college in knowledge, it is a college in living. The New Testament church is God's premier institution for the teaching and practice of truth in this dark world. It is *the pillar and ground of the truth* (1 Ti. 3:15). Christ is truth, and the Bible is truth, and the church is the pillar and ground for the preservation and proclamation of truth. It is the headquarters for evangelism and world missions. The New Testament church should be a college of the gospel, theology, hermeneutics, philosophy, origins, history, prophecy, preaching, teaching, sacred music, prayer, spiritual warfare, marriage, child discipline, archaeology, apologetics, and everything else pertaining to the truth of God's Word.

That the church is to be a Bible training, discipling institution for every member, from the youngest to the oldest, is clearly taught in Scripture. There we see that every member of a Bible-believing church is a born again disciple of Jesus Christ, and every member is aiming to be a skillful, obedient Bible student, and the church is geared to educating each member toward this end. That is the teaching of Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:41-42; Ephesians 4:11-16; Colossians 1:28; 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; and Hebrews 5:12-14, for example. This should start with the training of children in the homes, which requires that the fathers and mothers be skillful Bible students and true disciples of Christ. It is the church's job to build up the homes in God's Word so they can raise a godly seed for the glory of Jesus Christ. This is obvious from the fact that the instructions about the Christian home are given to churches or to church planters (e.g., Ephesians 5:22 - 6:4; Col. 3:18-21; 1 Ti. 5:4-16; Tit. 2:3-5). Every youth in a Bible-believing church should be on the way to becoming a skillful Bible student and fruitful disciple of Christ.

Every church should be raising up and training pastors, evangelists, preachers, and teachers. This was a major objective in Paul's ministry (2 Ti. 2:2), and he is our

example (1 Co. 11:2). The Pastoral Epistles were written for this purpose, and in these epistles we see how extensively Paul trained God-called men. This work requires lots of prayer for God to raise up laborers (Lu. 10:2) and creating an environment in the home and church that is filled with challenge and exhortation for the people to surrender to God's will.

We are thus convinced that the equivalent of a Bible college education *is the mere starting point* to be equipped for God's will in this present world, and it is the church's job to give this education. We're not talking about being equipped to be a pastor; we're talking about being equipped to be a "normal Christian"! Every believer is <u>an</u> <u>ambassador</u> for Christ (2 Co. 5:20), <u>a priest</u> of God (1 Pe. 2:5, 9), <u>a minister of spiritual gifts</u> (Ro. 12:3-8), <u>a builder of the church</u> (1 Co. 3:9-15; Eph. 4:16), <u>a soldier</u> in Christ's army (Eph. 6:10-19), <u>a teacher</u> of the Word of righteousness (Heb. 5:12-14). In addition there are the large ministries of <u>the husband as the spiritual head of the home</u> (Eph. 6:4) and <u>the wife as the keeper of the home</u> (Tit. 2:5). All of this requires serious education.

Imagine trying to be a priest, soldier, ambassador, teacher, and builder with little or no training! But this is exactly what is happening in a vast number of churches.

The Way of Life Bible College is a concept that Bible training is a life-long project. It isn't something you complete; it is something you pursue for your entire life.

So the Way of Life Bible College is, first of all, a concept that a sound New Testament church is a serious training institution that aims to disciple every believer toward perfection in every area of Christian life and ministry.

Second, the Way of Life Bible College is a curricula of courses.

Way of Life Literature publishes a full range of Bible courses on practically every subject touching the Bible and Christian life and ministry.

(The *Advanced Bible Studies Series*, which we published for many years, has been replaced by new courses.)

Currently there are about 40 Bible courses. Each course consists of a textbook, a syllabus to guide the teacher and student through the course, student projects, review questions, sectional tests, a final test, and the test

scoresheets. Many of the courses also feature class videos and PowerPoints.

The syllabus, review questions, tests, and answer keys come as a free Course Material Download.

The Way of Life Bible College does not offer diplomas or degrees. The courses are for teachers to download and use in classes and for individuals to download for self study.

Degree in Bible Theology

This curricula is equivalent to a degree in Bible Theology. In Scripture we see that *every* member of a Biblebelieving church is a born again disciple of Jesus Christ; *every* member is aiming to be a skillful, obedient Bible student; and the church is geared to educating *every* member toward this end. That is the teaching of Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:41-42; Ephesians 4:11-16; Colossians 1:28; 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; and Hebrews 5:12-14, for example.

The following training can be done privately or in classes at church or a combination of both.

Each year's curricula is designed for a commitment of about 250 hours. That would be 5 hours a week for 12 months, 6 hours a week for 10 months. The class hours (video sessions) and textbook studies for each year are about 200 hours, and we are estimating 50 hours for review and testing. This is an educated guess, of course, and it will differ from student to student.

The full curricula is set out for a 5 year program to allow for part study in an otherwise busy schedule. If the student doubles his study time, the program can be done in 3 years.

Students can do as little or as much as they want, of course, but it is good to follow a schedule and to make a commitment to pursue specific goals.

DIGGING IN THE WALLS

God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. "Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall ... And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. So I went in and saw. ..." (Ezek. 8:7-10).

Ezekiel was then instructed to preach against the errors of the leaders and to tell the people the things he had witnessed.

"Therefore prophesy against them, prophesy, O son of man. ... Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the Lord had shewed me" (Ezek. 11:4,25).

The hour in which we live is very similar to that of Ezekiel's day. Many of those who profess to be the people of God are apostate. It was prophesied in the New Testament Scriptures that such would be the case in the closing hours of our age. This will culminate in the brief worldwide rule of an utterly apostate Harlot "church" (2 Tim. 3-4; 1 Tim. 4; 2 Pet. 2-3; Jude; Rev. 17).


As in Ezekiel's day much of the apostasy of our hour is hidden from the view of the average Christian. We intend by God's grace to "dig in the walls" of modern ecumenism and to expose and cry out against the things we find. In this section we also report on secular events which are relevant to Christians. May God give us ears to hear, minds to understand, and hearts to obey. Is the truth of God not worthy of defense?



THE CHURCH AS A WALLED SHEEPFOLD AND A WATERED GARDEN (Friday Church News Notes. January 19, 2024. www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - It was common in the 17th and 18th centuries for Baptist churches to refer to the New Testament assembly as a walled sheepfold and a watered garden. The First London Confession of 1644 said the members are "under heavenly conduct His and government, to lead their lives in His walled sheepfold, and watered garden, to have communion here with the saints..." In 1815, Benjamin Keach (who pastored the church later made famous by Charles Spurgeon) wrote, "Some part of a wilderness [of this world] hath been turned into a garden or fruitful vineyard: so God hath out of the people of this world, taken his churches and walled them about, that none of the wild beasts can hurt them" (Gospel Mysteries Unveiled). This is the language of a regenerate church membership and a pilgrim Christianity, which is the church we see beginning in Acts 2:41-42. The term a "walled sheepfold" speaks of a fold in which Christ's sheep are kept, fed, and protected. Christ's true sheep are defined in John 10:27-28, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck


them out of my hand." The term "watered garden" is from Song 4:12, "A garden enclosed is *my* sister, *my* spouse; a spring shut up, a fountain sealed." The redeemed are Christ's delight, Christ's jewels. He has purchased them at great price. They are the joy that was set before Him as He set His face like flint to Gethsemane and Calvary (Heb. 12:2).

WHAT KEEPS THE LIGHTS **ON?** (Friday Church News Notes, January 19, 2024, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from PowerLineBlog.com, Jan. 17, 2024: "Most of the country is in the grip of a cold snap, and demand for electricity is high. So where is our power coming from? Fossil fuels and nuclear energy. [Consider the] chart from the invaluable Grid Brief on energy usage from Jan. 10-16. America runs on natural gas, coal and nuclear power. Everything else is an afterthought. A WIFE TOO MANY (Friday Church News Notes, January 26, www.wayoflife.org, 2024. fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from Michael Haykin, Kiffen, Knollys, and Keach: Rediscovering Our English Baptist Heritage: "During [William] Kiffen's final years he continued to be active in his pastorate at Devonshire Square and in the life of the English Calvinistic Baptists as a whole. ... However, these were also years of domestic tragedy. Three of Kiffen's children, as well as his first wife Hanna, had already died by this time. William, his eldest, at the age of twenty in 1669; a second son in Venice, whom Kiffen asserted was poisoned by a Roman Catholic priest; a daughter, Priscilla, in 1679; Hanna in 1682. Respecting Hanna's life and death, Kiffen wrote later: 'It pleased the Lord to take to himself, my dear and faithful wife, with whom I had lived nearly forty-four years; whose tenderness to me, and faithfulness to


God, were such as cannot, by me, be expressed, as she constantly sympathized with me in all my afflictions. I can truly say, I never heard her utter the least discontent under all the various providences that attended either me or her; she eyed the hand of God in all our sorrows, so as constantly to encourage me in the ways of God: her death was the greatest sorrow to me that ever I met with in the world.' Kiffen's second wife. Sarah. however, was cut of a different cloth. On 2 March 1698 she was charged with a number of misdeeds by Devonshire Square Church. Upon examination, she was found guilty of, among other things, defrauding her husband of two hundred pounds and making false accusations about him. When she refused to appear before the congregation, Sarah was suspended from communion on 24 April 1698."

BATS THAT FEED TREES (Friday Church News Notes, January 2024, www.wayoflife.org, 26. fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) The following is from -CreationMoments.com, Jan. 16, 2024: "The surface of the Earth 50 to 150 feet below the great living canopy of the rainforest is a dark, humid, still world dominated by great columns of tree trunks. Within those trunks and some of the giant hollow branches extending from them lies the secret of the life of the canopy itself. A rainforest typically receives 12 or more feet of rain per vear. That much rain washes out of the soil most of the nitrates needed by the trees for growth. What the trees need is a rich source of nitrates that is constantly being replenished. And that's where the bats come in. Typically, these huge trees are hollow inside. Many different kinds



of creatures, including fruit bats, enter the hollow trees through various openings. Fruit bats find ideal daytime sleeping rooms inside the great hollow branches that extend like caverns from the hollow tree trunk. The accumulating layer of bat guano inside the tree itself is one of the richest sources of nitrates known. So the bats provide the tree with the nitrates it needs in exchange for a protected home during the day! In a very real sense, the fruit bats are the collection and transport system for the raw materials that make possible the tropical rain forest canopy with its millions of residents. The Creator has devised an ingenious way to provide for the needs of many creatures. Truly, the Lord does provide all living things with their food in precisely the way they need it! By comparison with Heidelberg and Tübingen, Harvard and Yale were gentlemen's clubs, where students paid more attention to football than to physics. Albert Einstein reached the pinnacle of his profession not in 1933, when he moved to Princeton, but from 1914 to 1917, when he was appointed professor at the University of Berlin, director of the Kaiser Wilhelm Institute for Physics, and as a member of the Prussian Academy of Sciences. Even the finest scientists produced by Cambridge felt obliged to do a tour of duty in Germany. ... Anyone who has a naive belief in the power of higher education to instill ethical values has not studied the history of German universities in the Third Reich. A university degree, far from inoculating Germans against Nazism, made them more likely to embrace it. The fall from grace of the German universities was personified by the readiness of Martin Heidegger, the greatest German philosopher of his generation, to jump on the Nazi bandwagon, a swastika pin in his lapel. He was a member of the Nazi Party from 1933 until 1945." [Conclusion by Way of Life: Throughout human history, higher education has tended to be the fountainhead of error, not only antisemitism but every error. This is

because of man's corrupt fallen nature, the pride of intellect ("the pride of life," 1 Jo. 2:16), and demonic delusion. In these end times, the spirit of apostasy and the mystery of iniquity is nearing full bloom.]


THE **GETTYS** AND THE **RAPPER** (Friday Church News February Notes, 2, 2024, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The Gettys featured rapper Shai Linne at their Sing! 2022 conference, and he is scheduled to return for Sing! 2024. The Gettys (Keith and Kristyn) are hugely influential. "Up to 100 million people worldwide sing Keith Getty's hymns in church services each year" ("Hitting the right notes," Belfast Telegraph, Aug. 11, 2018). The Getty-Townend hymn "In Christ Alone" is hugely popular, with an estimated 40 to 50 million people singing it in church services each year. At least eight of the Gettys' songs are included in Majesty Music's Rejoice Hymns. Twenty-nine of their songs are featured in Hymns Modern and Ancient compiled by Fred Coleman who heads up Bob Jones University's Department of Church Music. Both Crown Baptist College and West Coast Baptist College have performed Getty-Townend material in their services. Typically, the lyrics to the Getty-Townend contemporary hymns are



Scriptural and the tunes are *fairly* conservative, but the Gettys have no boundaries in music or in association. Their concerts featured a mixture of traditional hymns mixed with outand-out rock & roll, blues, jazz, rap, Irish jigs, anything. They don't believe in separation. They are positive-only, non-judgmental. Keith Getty says to the large mixed multitude crowds at the Sing! conferences, "We are one in Christ; the things that unite us are far greater than the things that divide." Yet the vast majority of these people are strangers to him. He doesn't know who most of these people are, whether they have actually been born again, how they live, what churches they attend, if any, or what doctrines they hold. The Gettys are representative of evangelicalism today, at the heart of which is "a renunciation of separatism," as Harold Ockenga stated in the 1940s. The Gettys don't draw clear lines as the Bible requires. They don't speak out against error and issue warnings as the Bible demands. They don't contend for the faith once delivered unto the saints or mark and avoid those who teach false doctrine, as God's Word clearly demands. Because of the lack of boundaries, the Gettys are a bridge to the exceedingly dangerous world of the "broader church" with all of its sins and heresies, as surely as Hillsong or any of the other contemporary worship groups. 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THE CLIMATE MODELS ARE WRONG (Friday Church News



February 2, 2024. www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "The Climate Models," PowerLineBlog.com, Jan. 27, 2024: "Dr. Roy Spencer, a top scientist specializing in climate [he helped design the NASA temperature tracking satellites], wrote a report for [the Heritage Foundation] which he summarized on his own web site. Spencer compared observed warming in the U.S. corn belt during the summer, between 1973 and 2022--a 50-year period--with the warming that was predicted by the major climate models. He found that all of the models yielded more warming than actually occurred, most to an absurd degree. The chart shows the results. It should not need to be said that a model is not evidence of anything. A model is a hypothesis. Like any scientific hypothesis, it is confirmed or refuted by observation. A model that is refuted by observation is worthless. And vet, these models. which have repeatedly been shown to be wrong, are the basis for enormously destructive policies that have been adopted across much of the western world. Someone pointed out with respect to these data--I would credit him, but I can't now find the reference--that if it were simply a matter of mathematical errors or

inconsistencies, one would expect some models to err on the 'hot side' and others on the 'cold side' of actual observations. But that isn't the case: all of the models run hot. That suggest that global warming alarmism is a political, not a scientific, movement."



SPURGEON AND A **CHURCH** REGENERATE **MEMBERSHIP** (Friday Church News Notes, February 2, 2024, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The Metropolitan Tabernacle, from its earliest days under the pastorates of William Rider and Benjamin Keach (1640-1704), was careful to maintain a regenerated church membership. This continued under Charles Spurgeon's leadership. Prospective candidates baptism for and membership were required to go through a multi-step process. First, the enquirer met with one of the elders or deacons to share his or her testimony. Second, if the elder or deacon was satisfied with the testimony, the enquirer was recommended to meet with Spurgeon. Third, if Spurgeon was satisfied, he nominated a church member to visit the candidate "to enquire as to the moral character and



repute." Fourth, if the visit was satisfactory, the candidate was invited to attend a special congregation meeting to appear before the church family. There the candidates would again give their testimonies and answer any questions from church members. These meetings were not rushed and could last several hours, beginning at 2pm and "lasting till a late hour at night." Fifth, the church then voted whether to receive the candidate as a member. Sixth, if approved by the vote of the church, the candidate was baptized and received into membership and participated in the next communion service. Members who were not present and active were removed from membership. In his final message to the Pastors' College, Spurgeon said, "Let us not keep names on our books when they are only names. ... Keep your church real and effective ... A merely nominal church is a lie. Let it be what it professes to be."

PLANTS SKILLED IN ANIMAL HUSBANDRY (Friday Church News February Notes. 2, 2024, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) following The is from CreationMoments.com, Jan. 23, 2024: "It occurred to scientists only about 30 years ago that insect pests might be controlled through hormones. If, for example, a hormone that prevented a destructive insect from reaching



maturity was applied to a crop, the interrupted lifecycle of the insect might prevent damage to the crop. Yet. the hormone would be a safe, natural substance. However. scientists found that synthesizing such hormones was much more difficult than they thought. Several years into the research, Japanese scientists discovered that certain plants were already making these hormones for self-defense. In fact, many of the plants were manufacturing what they called "super-hormones." 'Superhormones' are hormones that work in far lower concentrations than the juvenile hormones made by the insects themselves. These juvenile hormones prevent insects from reaching their adult, and usually most destructive, stage. Among those plants that make juvenile insect hormones are ferns and certain evergreens. One result of this research is the development of a mosquito juvenile hormone. This hormone can be time-released from briquettes in swamps, preventing mosquito wigglers from ever maturing to their flying, biting, adult stage. Again, the incredible design and balance that could only have been built into the world by a wise Creator are evident in the creation. How else could plants have gained such skill in animal chemistry? Ref.: Science Digest, March, 1979, page 67."

CALIFORNIA TO PAY \$200,000 TO SETTLE GENDER LAWSUIT FROM CHRISTIAN



PRESCHOOL (Friday Church News Notes, February 9, 2024, www.<u>wayoflife.org</u>, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "California to Pay," Christian Headlines, Jan. 31, 2024: "The state of California has agreed to pay a Christian preschool and its attorneys some \$200,000 as part of a settlement to a lawsuit that began when the state tried to force the school to change its biblical beliefs on gender and sexuality. The controversy began when the California Department of Social Services, citing new federal and state rules, told The Church of Compassion in El Cajon, Calif., that its preschool, Dayspring Learning Center, could only participate in the government-assisted food program if it agreed with a nondiscrimination policy that includes 'sexual orientation' and 'gender identity.' The state even told the church it must stop 'requiring Church employees to sign or abide by' a handbook that includes a statement of faith and affirms biblical teaching on gender and sexuality, according to court documents. Dayspring filed suit, alleging violations of the U.S. Constitution's Free Exercise, Free Speech, Free Association, and Establishment Clauses. The suit also claimed the state was violating the Religious Freedom Restoration Act and Administrative Procedure Act. 'While the Church and Preschool

serve all families, they will not teach or promote all messages,' the suit said. Following the lawsuit, the state agreed to settle. ... The school was represented by Alliance Defending Freedom, the National Center for Law & Policy, and Advocates For Faith & Freedom. ... The church's beliefs on gender and sexuality, the suit said, were 'uncontroversial for more than 2,000 years and continue to be held by most major world religions.""

EVANGELIST RETURNS TO CHURCH AFTER BEING SHOT WHILE STREET PREACHING (Friday Church News Notes, February 2024, www.wayoflife.org, 9. fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Evangelist Hans," Christian Post, Jan. 30, 2024: "Hans Schmidt, the 26-year-old military veteran and outreach director of Victory Chapel First Phoenix in Arizona, who was shot in the head while street preaching last November and wasn't initially expected to recover, has returned to his church. his wife announced Sunday, saying, 'he walks, he talks, [and] he even plays the drums.' In a fresh update on her husband's 'miracle' recovery, Zulya Schmidt, who shares two young children with the preacher, published videos and photos in an Instagram post ... 'God has done an incredible work in Hans' life, and every day, he continues to improve. Please continue to prav for a full restoration.' ... Schmidt, a



former military medic, was shot in the head on the evening of Nov. 15, 2023, at the intersection of 51st Ave and Peoria in Glendale, Arizona, while doing church outreach before a Wednesday night service. 'Single entry point on the side on the left temple. The bullet traveled through his brain. ... No one heard the shot or saw where it came from,' family friend Brad Currell wrote in a GoFundMe campaign that has raised more than \$78,000 as of Tuesday on behalf of the Schmidt family."

18TH CENTURY BAPTISTS AND A REGENERATE CHURCH MEMBERSHIP (Friday Church News Notes, February 9, 2024, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is from A Treatise of Church Discipline, 1798: "[T]hey should be careful in the admission of members. Let there be pretty clear evidence of a work of grace. Slackness, or inattention here, has been the bane of the church, in all ages. ... The prerequisites for baptism and admission into the church are, godly experience, soundness in the faith, and a regular life. Knowledge of the first will be best obtained, by letting persons declare, in their own way, the gracious dealings of the Lord with



them, such questions being put occasionally as will assist and lead them on. 1 Peter 3:15. The second should be confined to the essentials of religion. ... And we attend to the last, as the necessary fruit, without which, their pretension to religion must be vain. Titus 2:12, 14; 3:8."

TWO HOUSES: THE CHURCH AND THE HOME (Friday Church News Notes, February 9, 2024, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - We see two houses in 1 Timothy, and they are to work together. First, we see the "house of God" (1 Ti. 3:15). This is the New Testament church. The context is a church with pastors and deacons. Its purpose is to nurture, protect, train, equip, prepare, and discipline God's people. The church is the pillar and ground of the truth (1 Ti. 3:15). It is tasked with being the headquarters of world evangelism and discipleship in this age. Second, we see thine "own house" (1 Ti. 3:4, 12; 5:8). This is the Christian home. Its purpose is to raise up a godly seed for God's glory. Children do not belong to parents; they belong to God. "Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine..." (Eze. 18:4). Malachi 2:15 says that the Lord seeks "a godly seed" from the homes. We don't need a "home church," so to speak. We need a church that ministers to the home and works together with the home. The church should build up the home, and the home should build up the church. An example of how this works in practice from the home side is Mr. and Mrs. Castleman of the Clear Creek Baptist Church in Clear Creek, Kentucky, in the early 19th century. They were saved and baptized at the same time. Pastor John Taylor testified of them as follows:



"They have raised many children. A number of them are in the Baptist church, also their grandchildren in different parts of our commonwealth. ... The old gentleman has long kept a great tannery. His apprentices have been numerous. Many of them have become professors of religion, so that **this family has been a great nursery to the Baptist church for near half a century**. The old lady being truly a mother in Israel and a fine tutoress of children..." (Taylor, *A History of Ten Baptist Churches*).

But scientists have recorded bar-headed geese regularly crossing the Himalayas at that altitude on their annual migration. Some observers have even reported seeing the geese as high as 29,000 feet (8800 m). How the geese not only survive but also vigorously flap their wings without losing a beat has been a mystery for decades. To solve this mystery, researchers decided to place trained geese in a wind tunnel and cover their faces with oxygen masks. (How they managed to fit geese with oxygen masks is a mystery for another day.) The study showed that bar-headed geese can slow their metabolism and cool their blood for high-altitude flight. Colder blood stores more oxygen. Unlike

The wisdom and welfare of the succeeding generation are intrusted with you before hand, and depend much on your conduct. The seeds of misery or happiness in this world, and that to come, are oftentimes sown very early; and, therefore, whatever may conduce to give the minds of children a relish for virtue and religion ought in the first place, to be proposed to you. ... What is learned in verse is longer retained in memory, and sooner recollected. The like sounds and the like number of syllables exceedingly assist the remembrance. And it may often happen that the end of a song, running in the mind, may be an effectual means to keep off some temptations, or to incline to some duty, when a word of scripture is not upon their thoughts. This will be a constant furniture for the minds of children, that they may have something to think upon when alone, and sing over to themselves. This may sometimes give their thoughts a divine turn, and raise a young meditation. Thus they will not be forced to seek relief for an emptiness of mind out of the loose and dangerous sonnets of the age."

ARE CHRISTIANS THE CAUSE OF THE HOMOSEXUAL'S **PAIN?** (Friday Church News Notes, February 2024. 16. www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Many homosexuals blame Christian teaching on sexuality for their problems. The British newspaper The Independent calls this "psychological torture ... imposed from a supposedly environment" ("Christian godly Gay," Rock Star 'I'm The Independent. Aug. 16, 2014). Consider Vicky Beeching, mentioned in the "Christian rock star" report. Beginning in Sunday School, she was taught that homosexuality is such a great sin that Sodom and Gomorrah were destroyed for it. After becoming a contemporary Christian musician at age 16, she hid her homosexuality, and she believes that the resulting stress caused psychological and physical problems. When she was diagnosed with a disease at age 35 and had to take chemotherapy, she said, "I looked at my life, and thought, 'I have to come to terms with who I am." She determined to "come out" and stop "living as a shadow of a person." While the stress of living a lie and abiding in unconfessed sin will doubtless cause problems in an individual's life, the stress cannot be blamed on "the church." The cause of the stress is not the law of God but the sin. It is like being in the habit of running red lights because you are "a red-light runner by nature" and blaming the resulting anxiety and potential crash



on the naughty light. The confusion of "Christian homosexuality" is prophesied in Scripture. "This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, blasphemers, boasters, proud. disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers. incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away" (2 Timothy 3:1-5).

THE HIGH PRIEST'S BELLS (Friday Church News Notes. February 16. 2024. www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - In 2011, a small golden bell with a tiny loop at its top was found by archaeologists excavating the ancient drainage channel that ran beneath the Pilgrim's Way from the Pool of Siloam to the western side of the Temple Mount. The bell is very likely one that was made for the high priest's robe. There is no mention in the Bible or in extra-biblical Jewish historical records of a golden bell like this used in any other fashion. Attached to the hem of the high priest's beautiful blue robe were pomegranates of blue, purple, and scarlet, and golden bells (Ex. 28:33-35). The gold bells signify, first, Christ's deity. He is God and He is



man and as such He can be the Mediator between God and man. This work was signified on the day of atonement when the high priest carried the blood of the sacrifice into the holy of holies and applied it to the ark and the mercy seat (Leviticus 16). Second, the bells signify the Father's delight in the Son. The bells related particularly to the high priest's work in the Holy Place which was to the Father. Of Christ, the Father said, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (Mt. 17:5). Third, the bells signify Christ's present ministry in heaven for His redeemed people. Jewish tradition says there were 71 bells, so the sound would be heard clearly as the high priest moved about his business in the Tabernacle. As the bells enabled the people to hear the High Priest ministering in the holy of holies even though they couldn't see him, so Christ's present ministry in heaven can be"heard" by the witness of the Word of God and the testimony of the Holy Spirit (Joh. 16:12-15; Heb. 7:24-25; 1 Jo. 2:20). Fourth, the gold bells announce Christ's imminent return. As the people outside the Tabernacle heard the tinkling of the bells, they knew the high priest would soon return to pronounce God's blessing on them. "Let your moderation be known unto all men. Please continue to warn people about these movements. The movements that I am talking about are the following: New Reformed Calvinism, Acts 29 Network, 9 Marks Network, The Gospel Coalition. The Biblical Counseling movement (Association of Biblical Counselors) on the surface seems to have a very History from Genesis to the Silent Bible based focus. However, what I have discovered is that almost every counselor that is part of this group has a strong adherence to Calvinist theology, both old and new, or either/or. John MacArthur, Voddie Baucham, Steve Lawson, Justin Peters, and Mark Dever are often cited. I was fortunate to have discovered a lot of this stuff before I got in too deep and taken in by them."

THOSE ASTONISHING BEE ENGINEERS (Friday Church News Notes, February 23, 2024, www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) The following from is CreationMoments.com, Feb. 9, 2024: "The amazing structure of the honeycomb has fascinated scientists for thousands of years. In the third century, the astronomer and geometer Pappus of Alexandria became the first to offer an explanation for why the honeycomb has a hexagonal shape. Pappus explained that only three shapes could serve as candidates for a honeycomb cell--the triangle, the square and the hexagon. Any other shape would leave wasteful open spaces between the cells. Pappus noted that the hexagon holds more honey in the same space than either a square or a triangle. It also takes less wax to build, and the shared sides of the hexagonal cells reduce wax usage even further. It was not until the development of modern calculus that scientists could fully appreciate the shape of the caps at the end of the honeycomb cells. Each cell is capped with a pyramid composed of three rhombuses. Complex mathematics shows that this shape, too, requires the



least amount of wax for construction. It also allows honeycomb cells to be butted up against each other without wasting space. Modern scientists who accept evolution talk about the design of the honeycomb as a great accomplishment by the bees. However, the more sensible conclusion is obvious.
