

### STEVEN ANDERSON'S CHILDREN EXPOSE HIM ~ By David Cloud

### In 2024, three of Steven Anderson's oldest children have spoken out publicly about the cultic abuse in the pastor's home.

When I first learned of one of Anderson's son's testimony of abuse in the home, I decided to leave it alone and not add it to the Anderson report ("<u>What About Steven</u> <u>Anderson</u>?"), because it was only one young man's word against that of his father. But since then, that testimony has been confirmed by two other children. Further, I have since realized that many people have probably been drawn to Anderson because of what appeared to be his good Christian home. Some of his former members are publicly testifying that they feel betrayed by learning the true condition of his home.

I feel very sorry for the Anderson family. I have no ill feeling whatsoever against them. I only wish that Steven did not claim to be independent Baptist and that he would repent and step down from the ministry.



The King James Bible says he is doubly disqualified: by his heresies and by his home life.

Isaac, the second oldest Anderson child and the first speak out, is a Nazi and has a tattoo of a Nazi War Eagle across his chest. (This is ironic in light of Anderson's denial of the Jewish holocaust.) John, the third oldest, confirmed Isaac's testimony. The young men both say Anderson was abusive to their mom, that he hit her, beat her with electric cords, and railed at her. They described regular screaming and yelling between the parents and of the parents towards the children, cursing, kids being hit in the face, beaten on the back with an electric cord by the mother to the point of bleeding while the mother screamed at them, withholding meals for punishment, being sent to bed without supper. John testified, "My parents were always fighting; they were always mad at each other."

The children say that a few years ago the Andersons stopped practicing in the home the standards of separation that Anderson preached. In regard to music, movies, TV, etc., "the home became extremely de-Christianized" (John Anderson). He said, "My siblings are not being held to biblical standards. My siblings as young as 11, 12 are watching R-rated movies, listening to explicit music, which my dad is publicly against. The abuse never stopped, but the standards decreased dramatically. ... We were allowed to do whatever we wanted with our worldly friends that we made at work, as long as nobody at church found out about it."

John says, "My dad is actively enrolled at ASU [Arizona State University], and anybody who knows anything about ASU knows that it is the number one college in the U.S. for STD, I want to say number one cocaine consuming

The school officially promotes all kinds of things he disagrees with. ... It openly supports the LGBT agenda. ... Clearly he is somebody who is willing to lie to his congregation, and we can all see now that he has no intrinsic core values, and he is willing to do whatever to protect his power and to protect his role that he very much enjoys having, of being an influential pastor. My dad is somebody who is obsessed with control and obsessed with power, and he gets that dose of control and power through his ministry."

In September, Miriam, 17 and the oldest daughter, refused to return home after a visit with an uncle (Steven's brother Clint). She agrees with her two older siblings that her father is abusive, that he hit her mother, and her parents had frequent raging arguments.

Miriam said her brothers' testimonies are "100% true." She said she had suicidal thoughts beginning at age 11. She said, "I was constantly feeling like...I'm responsible for my parents' marriage, and I'm the reason why everything's going wrong, and I have to make dinner, and I have to take care of the little kids, and I have to make sure that they don't know what dad's doing to mom in the other room. And when I got to be a teenager, I kind of decided that the second I turned 18, I was out of there." She says she is a Christian only because she met a different kind of Christian than her parents.

In a tweet dated Sept. 29, Miriam shows a true Christian character and demeanor. She shows humility, kindness, and a desire for God's blessing on their family. She said her uncle and aunt only helped her when she sought refuge and that they did not "steal" her as her father has claimed. She tweeted, "I came to my uncle desperate for help and he and his family offered me refuge. In my months of living at their house, I gained nothing but respect for both my aunt and uncle. They time and time again proved their wisdom and Godliness and I will forever be grateful for the love they showed me." Miriam ends this tweet by saying, "Please continue praying for my family as we need it more than ever. Happy Sunday, I hope everyone has a blessed day."

That same day, in his Sunday sermon, Steven Anderson went on an angry tirade, even using curse words, justifying himself and condemning his children. It was the opposite of the Christian attitude of his estranged daughter. He displayed no humility, no kindness, no compassion, no tenderness, no brokenness for his own children.

Listening to this self-justifying, angry rant it is easy to believe his children's testimony that he has been an abusive husband and father.

Following is a preacher friend's discerning description of Anderson's Sept. 29 sermon:

"Steven Anderson's public response to the accusations of physical abuse--much of which allegedly happened at least ten years ago--was characterized by pride, anger, and lack of brokenness over the situation. He claimed that the accusations are lies, embellishments, or distortions. Even if the most serious accusations are false, there is no indication that he recognizes or takes any responsibility for seeds that might have been planted in years past that led to this situation. In his message preached on September 29th, he called his children who made the accusations his enemies and said that they were too stupid to attack him in a way that could be seen as legitimate because they were interviewed by a Satanworshipping transvestite. [The interviewer claims not to be a Satan-worshiper.] He claimed that the things he is being accused of are not condemned by the Bible. Among other things, he is accused of breaking wooden barstools in his house, beating his wife with an electrical cord, threatening to kill his son, and giving his son a gash in the head by knocking it against a concrete windowsill. He defended his qualification to be a pastor by saying he has done the job 'successfully' for 18 1/2 years and that the qualifications in 1 Timothy 3 are only for unproven, untested men who are just starting out. He spent quite a bit of time bragging about his accomplishments in the ministry and how great of a father, husband, and pastor he is. He called out a couple of pastor friends by name who criticized him and then belittled them for having small churches. He said that his track record of ruling the church of God well is evidence that he rules his own house well. He says that he has always taught free will and that people have to choose to be saved and serve God on their own. He uses Jack Hyles as an example, calling him the best preacher of the 20th century even though some of his kids didn't turn out right. He bragged about all the soulwinning that John did while he was living at home. He says that he wouldn't be surprised if John won at least 100

people to the Lord. He claims to have won 200,000 people to the Lord. He concludes his sermon with these words: 'I'm not claiming to have been perfect. I'm not claiming to have been sinless. ... I have been a great husband, a great father, and a great pastor. ... If I stopped pastoring today, it was a h\*\*l of a run. ... I'm not stepping down. I'm not sorry. I'm not repentant, 'cause I'm not guilty.'"

This is not going to end well. It has already brought great reproach to Christ. Even an atheist and a transsexual are reporting on it via YouTube. The older children are calling on Child Protective Services to intervene on behalf of the children still at home.

The only hope is that Steven and his wife obey the Bible and practice the Christianity they profess, beginning with humility, contrition, and repentance. Steven needs to step down from the ministry and focus on healing his home. It appears that this is unlikely. John said, "My dad is an extreme narcissist, has an extreme God complex; he never does anything wrong. My dad never apologized to one of his kids or to my mom. He did what he did and is not sorry, could never be wrong, nobody could question him."

That's exactly what came across in Steven's September 29 sermon.

It is very sad that Steven Anderson identifies as an independent fundamental Baptist. He has brought great reproach to that name, but he is not the first independent Baptist preacher to do this. His hero, Jack Hyles, brought reproach to the name independent Baptist that far exceeds that of Anderson. (See <u>The Hyles Effect</u>, a free eBook available from <u>www.wayoflife.org</u>.)

"Independent fundamental Baptist" is not a denomination. It is simply a name for a certain kind of church, a church that is Baptist in polity, independent of denominational control, and fundamentalist in sense of a zealous stance for the truth of God's Word. Independent fundamental Baptists come in hundreds of varieties.

I have long warned about unscriptural independent Baptist churches, but I personally owe a lot to sound fundamental Baptist churches. When I was a newborn Christian wandering for awhile in the wilderness of "Christianity," God led me to a small fundamental Baptist church where I was loved with Christ-like love and found serious doctrinal and spiritual help. I am thankful to know many



fundamental Baptist churches that are biblically sound and spiritually wholesome, where the pastors are biblically qualified, where the love of Christ reigns, where sinners can be dealt with wisely and patiently and come to understand the one true gospel of Jesus Christ and be born again (nothing in life is more important), where believers can be properly discipled and educated in God's Word, where homes can be built by the biblical pattern in a truly godly fashion in the midst of an evil generation, where children can be educated and disciplined in a compassionate, godly way, where young people can learn how to make wise decisions in God's will and avoid the moral devastation of the pop culture, where God's people can be protected from the great spiritual and moral dangers of the last days, where the saints can come to understand Bible prophecy properly

and be taught to live expectantly of the imminent Rapture, which will be followed by the rise of the antichrist, the day of the Lord, the conversion of Israel, and Christ's second coming in glory and power.

Thankfully, we do not follow a man, only the Man Christ Jesus, whose name is Immanuel, God with us. He alone is the Saviour and the Lord. He alone will never disappoint those who trust Him.



The following is a small excerpt from the study on the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches in the book <u>The History and Heritage of</u> <u>Fundamentalism and Fundamental Baptists</u>, 600 pages, www.wayoflife.org.

**The General Association of Regular Baptist Churches** (GARBC) was founded in 1929 as a reorganization of the Baptist Bible Union. It was a separatist organization from its inception, unlike its predecessors.

It was founded under the direction of Oliver W. Van Osdel, pastor of Wealthy Street Baptist Church of Grand Rapids, Michigan.

"The Baptist Bible Union came apart after the 1929 closing of its university in Des Moines. Under Van Osdel's persuasion the Baptist Bible Union met for a final time in 1932 at Belden Avenue Baptist Church in Chicago. After formally dissolving the Union, the participants formed what became the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches" (Robert Delnay, "The Origins of the GARBC Articles of Faith," garbc.org).

From the beginning, the GARBC had a pre-tribulational stance.

In 1975, the GARBC revised its Articles of Faith to add the six-day creation and a literal global flood. Member churches are required to agree with this. This was through the influence of the pioneering work *The Genesis Flood* (1961) by Henry Morris and John Whitcomb. In 1964, the *Baptist Bulletin* had endorsed the doctrine of six-day creation and global flood in an article by Arthur Williams entitled "The Genesis Account of Creation." GARBC congregations did not tend toward Quick Prayerism. There was more emphasis on repentance and evidentiary conversion. In church polity, the emphasis was on congregational rule. There was an emphasis on expository Bible preaching.

Originally, five mission boards were approved by the GARBC: Baptist Mid-Missions, The Association of Baptists for World Evangelism (ABWE), Fellowship of Baptists for Home Missions, Hiawatha Independent Baptist Missions, and Evangelical Baptist Missions.

Approved colleges and seminaries were Western Baptist Bible College (Salem, Oregon), Faith Baptist Bible College (Ankey, Iowa) (formerly Grace Baptist Bible College of Omaha), Grand Rapids Baptist Bible College and Seminary (Grand Rapids, Michigan), Cedarville College (Cedarville, Ohio), Baptist Bible College (Clarks Summit, Pennsylvania), and Los Angeles Baptist College and Seminary (Newhall, California).

The GARBC reached a high of 1,603 fellowshipping churches in 1984.



GARBC's Slide into New Evangelicalism

By the 1980s, the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches (GARBC) was infiltrated with the contemporary evangelical philosophy. Its founding statements on separation no longer reflected the view of a growing number of its pastors.

Consider two voices from the "old GARBC" as expressed in the official literature of the 1940s and 1950s. GARBC Literature Item # 12, "The Position, Attitudes, and Objectives of Biblical Separation," by Paul Jackson: "Separation is an eternal principle. It is God's commandment that we must separate from unbelievers. Further, in the third place, it is God's commandment that we separate from our brothers when they walk in disobedience. Now I know that many men who will go along forthrightly, and shout Amen as far as we have gone, will object at this point, and say 'I believe in full fellowship with all evangelicals.' Well, God doesn't!"

GARBC Literature Item # 10, "A Limited Message or a Limited Fellowship," by David Nettleton: "Many have been carried away from full obedience by a noble-sounding motto which has been applied to Christian work, 'In essentials unity, in non-essentials liberty, and in all things charity.' Some things are not essential to salvation but they are essential to full obedience, and the Christian has no liberty under God to sort out the Scriptures into essentials and non-essentials! It is our duty to declare the whole counsel of God, and to do it wherever we are."

By the 1980s, the association's founding position was labeled "second-degree" or "secondary" separation" by a new generation and was rejected as unreasonable, impractical, and unloving.

In 1985, GARBC-approved Los Angeles Baptist College became The Masters College with John MacArthur as its president. It dropped the GARBC connection. MacArthur does not hold to the separation taught by the GARBC in its founding documents.

"There were significant rumblings by 1986 among GARBC pastors that the fellowship of churches, as well as its approved agencies, were tolerating things which were inconsistent with the GARBC's earlier formal position. The vocal response of some leaders within the Association was to disclaim any drift and to accuse those so concerned of being divisive and adding petty issues to their fundamentalist position. This response resulted in the formation and rise of **Regular Baptists for Revival**. These people urged a revival of and a return to the GARBC's former convictions. These convictions were, after all, the 'glue' which held the Regular Baptist movement together" (George Houghton, "The GARBC A Rich History and Heritage - Part 1" *Faith Pulpit*, March 2004).

In the late 1980s, Ralph Colas and Ernest Pickering resigned from the board of the GARBC-approved Association of Baptists for World Evangelism (ABWE) because of its compromise. ABWE's well-known work in Bangladesh, led by the medical doctor Viggo Olson (of Daktar fame), rejected biblical separatism for pragmatism and a larger tent of association and ministry. ABWE Bangladesh yoked together with organizations such as New Evangelical Wheaton College and the wretchedly apostate United Bible Societies. In 1988, William Commons, ABWE Director of Enlistment, praised Choices for Tomorrow's Mission: An Evangelical Perspective on Trends and Issues in Missions by David Hesselgrave of Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. This endorsed Billy Graham-style ecumenical book evangelism. In the 1990s, prominent ABWE board member Charles Ware, spoke at an ecumenical conference in Indianapolis with men representing Promise Keepers and Campus Crusade.

In 1987, Western Baptist College began allowing faculty and trustees to be members of Conservative Baptist churches in spite of the New Evangelical compromise that had permeated the Conservative Baptists by that time.

In the 1990s, many GARBC preachers, such as Bill Rudd and Eric Strattan of Calvary Baptist Church, Muskegon, Michigan, participated in the radically ecumenical Promise Keepers, which yoked together with Roman Catholic priests. Rudd was chairman of the GARBC's Council of Eighteen leadership committee. Calvary Baptist of Muskegon is a rock & roll, loosey-goosey evangelical church today. In the biographical sketches of the "Ministry Team," all of the "Things I Like" pertain to entertainment: coffee drinking, video games, camping, hiking, football, epic movies, downhill skiing, pizza, bonfires, "explaining Star Wars to my kids, and the greatest work of cinematic art ever created: Moana." What's wrong with this? For one thing, it is a window into worldly living. There is nothing godly or biblical about Star Wars and Moana. Second, it's a window into living with a this-world focus. Imagine what Paul or Peter or John would have stated when asked "What do you like?" Calvary Baptist of Muskegon aims for "cultural renewal." There is a major focus on social-justice work. There is nothing whatsoever at the web site about biblical separation.

In 1990, Tim Jordan, Chancellor of Calvary Baptist Seminary of Lansdale, Pennsylvania, spoke at the GARBC national conference. He said, "If we produce 'biblical' reasons for cultural fundamentalism, they know you are lying. And why do they know you are lying? It's because you are! ... They're not going to do the 'emperor's clothes' thing anymore" ("Fighting the Bantam Roosters," *Sharper Iron*, June 30, 2010).

By "cultural fundamentalism," he was talking about such things as dress standards, music standards, Bible translations, smoking, drinking, dancing, and mixed swimming. Tim was saying that there is no legitimate biblical support for these things, and those who preach such standards are liars. Dan Davey, pastor of Colonial Hills Baptist Church in Virginia Beach, Virginia, and keynote speaker at the 2010 GARBC conference agreed with Jordan about the error of "cultural fundamentalism." They do not want such things to get in the way of their push for Baptist-evangelical unity.

In the 1990s, the GARBC-approved Cornerstone College (which had begun as Grand Rapids School of the Bible, founded by David Otis Fuller) was partnering with New Evangelical and charismatic organizations through its *Mission Network News*. These organizations included Baptist World Alliance, Pat Robertson's Christian Broadcasting Network, Evangelism Explosion, the *Jesus Film* Project, Luis Palau Evangelistic Association, Lutheran Bible Translators, and Youth for Christ International, which had long worked with Roman Catholics.

In June 1995, Richard Christen was elected the National Representative for the GARBC. In a "Vision Statement," Christen said, "We must allow for differences in drawing the lines of secondary separation. ... We must shape a positive outlook and image." Prior to his election, he told the gathering: "Instead of a two-foot thick wall around our GARBC, **let's build a sturdy picket fence**."

Earlier that year, Christen published an article entitled "A Reaffirmation and Clarification of Belief." It was a clever repudiation of biblical separation. Consider an excerpt:

"Distinctions do exist between evangelicals and fundamentalists. BUT LINES OF DEMARCA-TION ARE DOTTED, NOT SOLID. ... there may well be legitimate individual back-and-forth fellowship through the dotted lines, carefully orchestrated for the sake of mutual benefit and oneness in Christ's true body. ... there are times when fundamentalists may venture into the evangelical camp and evangelicals into the fundamentalist camp. ... To be a voice repudiating does not mean we have to be a people alienating. ... There are legitimate inter-cooperative efforts among evangelicals."

This ignores two important facts:

First, it ignores the rebellious character of compromise. The evangelical today is involved in deep disobedience. The Bible plainly forbids him to fellowship with heretics, but he claims he is free to do so. He claims there are advantages to doing so; therefore, he *will* do it. He follows pragmatism and ignores the clear instructions of the Scriptures. To fellowship with him in his disobedience instead of rebuking him and separating from him is to participate in his disobedience and is to say that his disobedience is not serious.

Second, it ignores the corrupting character of compromise. Compromise is a contagious disease. Compromise is an ATTITUDE of neutralism, a MOOD of positivism, a SPIRIT of non-militancy. This attitude, mood, and spirit is highly contagious. Those who refuse to practice biblical separation and persist in mingling with modern evangelicals will be affected by their compromise as certainly as night follows day. "Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners" (1 Co. 15:33). Pastors who affiliate with compromising evangelicals bring that compromise into the lives of their people.

If ever there were a time to separate plainly from the modern evangelical world it is today. Evangelicalism today is filled to the brim with heresies.

Many books have documented this sad state of affairs, such as *The Battle for the Bible* and *The Bible in Balance* by Harold Lindsell, *New Neutralism II* by John Ashbrook, *The Tragedy of Compromise* by Ernest Pickering, *Evangelicalism Divided* by Iain Murray, *The Great Evangelical Disaster* by Francis Schaeffer, *No Place for the Truth* by David Wells, and *The Coming Evangelical Crisis* edited by John Armstrong.


Christen's picket fence separation was a clear rejection of the old GARBC (biblical) standard of separation. The spaces within the GARBC's picket fence approach to separatism have grown wider with each passing decade and they will continue to do so. In 2020, an older preacher, retired pastor, author, said, "The GARBC are on a fast track into the new evangelical mainstream."

### Hymns - "HOW FIRM A FOUNDATION" - God Singing To Man By David Cloud

"How Firm a Foundation" appeared in the first edition of John Rippon's Selections in 1787. The author is not certain, being attributed to K. A possible candidate is R. Keene, who was the precentor or song leader at Carter Lane Baptist Church which was pastored by Rippon.

The hymn is a glorious declaration of the believer's security in Christ and the confidence that is available in every trial: sickness, poverty, deep waters, deepest distress, fiery trials, foes, and rivers of sorrow.

The original title was "Exceeding Great and Precious Promises" with a reference to 2 Peter 1:4.

It begins with the proclamation of the sufficiency of God's Word and the necessity of faith. "How firm a foundation, ye saints of the Lord, is laid for your faith in His excellent Word!" We are reminded that "faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God" (Ro. 10:17).

The hymn is packed with references to Scripture, including Ex. 14:15-16; 2 Sa. 22:17; De. 31:6-8; 33:25; Ps. 16:10; 119:28; Isa.1:25; 40:11; 43:2; 46:4; Zec. 13:9; Mt. 28:20; Ro. 8:25-29; 1 Co. 3:11; Eph. 2:19-22; Heb. 13:5; 1 Pe. 1:6-7; 4:12-13; 2 Pe. 1:4.

Four times, God says He will be with the child of God and will not forsake him. The hymn is unusual in that stanzas 2-7 are God the Father (or Jesus) singing to those "who unto the Savior for refuge have fled" and who "on Jesus hath leaned for repose."

The hymn has been sung to numerous tunes. Beginning with the 1793 edition of Rippon's Selections, two tunes were recommended: BROUGHTON and GEARD. In early American hymnals it was sung to ADESTE FIDELIS ("O Come, All Ye Faithful"). The tune FOUNDATION first appeared in an American hymnbook published by the Virginia Mennonite Joseph Fund in 1832 (*A Compilation of Genuine Church Music*). This is the tune that was used in *Sacred Harp* (1844) and *Southern Harmony* (1854) and most modern hymnals.

The hymn was sung at the funerals of Robert E. Lee, Woodrow Wilson, Theodore Roosevelt and was sung at the deathbed of Andrew Jackson. "How Firm a Foundation," 1787

#### DIGGING IN THE WALLS


God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. "Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall ... And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. So I went in and saw. ..." (Ezek. 8:7-10).

Ezekiel was then instructed to preach against the errors of the leaders and to tell the people the things he had witnessed.

"Therefore prophesy against them, prophesy, O son of man. ... Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the Lord had shewed me" (Ezek. 11:4,25).

The hour in which we live is very similar to that of Ezekiel's day. Many of those who profess to be the people of God are apostate. It was prophesied in the New Testament Scriptures that such would be the case in the closing hours of our age. This will culminate in the brief worldwide rule of an utterly apostate Harlot "church" (2 Tim. 3-4; 1 Tim. 4; 2 Pet. 2-3; Jude; Rev. 17).

As in Ezekiel's day much of the apostasy of our hour is hidden from the view of the average Christian. We intend by God's grace to "dig in the walls" of modern ecumenism and to expose and cry out against the things we find. MISSIONARY WINS NEARLY 12.000 IN SUMMER **EVANGELISTIC CAMPAIGN** Church News (Friday Notes. September 27, 2024, www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) Recently a friend sent me the prayer letter of the Darrell Ratcliff Family serving in Mexico out of First Baptist Church, Hammond, Indiana (of the late Jack Hyles fame). I don't know Darrell, but I would imagine he is a likable man with a nice Christian family. But his evangelism methodology is unscriptural, terrible, horrible, wretched, damaging to the cause of Christ, and harmful to the souls of men. The poor fellow has been brainwashed with a man-made Quick Prayerism program and he is using it on steroids, leaving a multitude of empty professions in his wake. Here is a quote from his recent prayer letter: "This summer, God gave me the privilege of taking 13 different people with me. Every few days, we were in a different church, so we were with 13 churches. Every day, we were doing something to reach others for Christ. God blessed; and, praise the Lord, we preached the Gospel to around 12,000 precious souls, with the majority of them trusting Christ as their Saviour! To

God be all the glory! Let me share with you a personal soul-winning story. One Sunday, a church had an early evening service. With the extra time in the evening, my family and I went soul winning because they hadn't gotten to share Christ that day. God blessed in a powerful way. My wife got to win Enrique, Gabi, Jaci, and Abi to Christ. Later our son Michael won three kids-Rodrigo. Eleazer, and Mayra-to the Lord. Then Michael won an entire group of 7 more people. My wife then got to win Julissa, Edrick, and Mia. I wanted to enjoy the blessing as well, so I won 5 precious souls to the Lord. Then Michael won a family of 5 to the Lord. Then Buffy got to win 4 boys and another group of 8 people to the Lord. So that night, God gave us a great blessing, with 39 precious people reached through personal soul winning." CONCLUSION: The evangelistic zeal is commendable. The question we have is, Where are the 12,000? Where are the 39? It is a right, biblical question. We are to test everything by Scripture, and the 3,000 that were saved on Pentecost "continued stedfastly in the apostles" doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers" (Acts 2:42). All 3,000 gave clear evidence of supernatural conversion. That is biblical evangelism. To be baptized, to be growing in the Lord, and to be a faithful, participating member of a New Testament church is the "for sure" biblical evidence according to Acts 2:41-42; 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10, etc. Fifty years ago, as a young preacher and a student at Tennessee Temple, I was taught the same type of soul winning program that Darrell was taught. We used "Let's Go Soulwinning" in the evangelism class. I was at Temple to learn God's Word and serve Christ. I worked in the bus ministry and

pastored one of Highland Park's chapels. But I wasn't there to be brainwashed. By God's grace I obeyed His Word (Acts 17:21; 1 Thessalonians 5:21), proved this evangelism methodology with Scripture, and rejected it. I didn't reject evangelism; I rejected unbiblical evangelism. To all the Darrells out there, I would plead with you to listen to the King James Bible and compare it with what you have been taught. "Prove ALL things." Don't be a man follower, be a Christ follower; don't be tradition bound, be a Biblicist. Don't be a gullible fundamental Baptist mindlessly following some man-made program. I intend to prove all things and to hold fast that which is good. Note the "hold fast that which is good" part. A window into that world has been opened by a federal jury indictment of Sean "Diddy" Combs (also known as Puff Daddy and P. Diddy) for sex trafficking and prostitution. "The indictment painted an unsavory picture of Mr. Combs, 54, as an all-powerful sex fiend presiding over 'Freak Offs'" ("Sean 'Diddy,"" The Washington Times, Sept. 17, 2024). The details are too wicked to be repeated. A year ago, the hip-hop mogul was flying high and seemingly the apex of success, with a fortune estimated at \$1 billion, multiple awards, executive power, mansions, super cars, a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, everything a hip-hoper could dream of. **THE PASTOR AND HIS STUDY** (Friday Church News Notes, September 27, 2024, <u>w w w . w a y o f l i f e . o r g</u> <u>fbns@wayoflife.org</u>, 866-295-4143) The following was stated by Frederick Trestrail, speaking at Bristol Baptist College, 1860: "They must feed the flock, and to this end they must be students of God's word, which he insisted, required hard work, and this is the pastor's duty. It is your duty to study truth; to illustrate and enforce the doctrines and precepts of Christianity. This cannot be done without continued application and study. No man can preach well who does not prepare well, and this includes not leaving preparation to the last moment. And in all this, their aim is to preach Christ in His person, teachings, sufferings, and death, to preach Christ, in what He has done for man, in dying as a substitutionary sacrifice, and what He is doing now-interceding for all that come unto God by Him. And this is not just preaching the gospel to sinners, but to show all the doctrines relating to Christ's person, work, and death, and declaring these as the great truths of the Bible" (The Story of Bristol Baptist College Three Hundred Years of Ministerial Formation by Ruth Gouldbourne and Anthony Cross).

GETTYS LEAD WORSHIP AT LAUSANNE 4 (Friday Church News Notes, October 4, 2024, www.wayoflife.org,

fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Keith and Kristyn Getty led worship and conducted seminars at Lausanne IV, the ecumenical Congress on World Evangelization in Seoul, South Korea, Sept. 22-28. The Gettys are one of the most influential contemporary worship artists, and they are bridges to the one-world church because of their ecumenical philosophy and lack of true biblical boundaries. Together with Stuart Townend, who is charismatic in his doctrine and practice, they operate Getty Townend Music (GTM), which in the last several years has become increasingly popular with Bob Jones University, Majesty Music, the Wilds, and others. Over 5,000 people from 200 countries participated in Lausanne IV from a multiplicity of denominations. The 50 speakers



included Rick Warren of Purpose Driven fame and Billy Wilson, president of the Pentecostal Oral Roberts University. A major theme was ecumenism. Patrick Fung of OMF International said, "A divided church has no message for a divided world. God has called us to a unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." This is a great error. The statement in Ephesians 4:3 is written to a biblically sound New Testament church, not to professing Christians in general. Nowhere does Scripture call for unity between those who hold sound doctrine and those who hold heresy. To the contrary, Scripture warns of a great turning away from the faith (2 Timothy 3-4) and calls upon those who are sound in the faith to mark and avoid those who err (Romans 16:17-18; 2 Timothy 3:5). The first Congress for World Evangelization held was in Lausanne, Switzerland, in 1974, led by Billy Graham. The Lausanne movement which is a product of that congress has promoted first ecumenical unity from its inception. In 1974, participants came from every sort of compromised and apostate denomination, such as the Church of England and the Church of South India, including many associated with the radically liberal World Council of Churches. Three Roman Catholic priests were invited to attend Lausanne I (F.E.A. News & Views, Jul.-Aug. 1974). One of the speakers at Lausanne I was Malcolm

Muggeridge, who. five vears previously, in his book Jesus Rediscovered (1969),brazenly rejected Christ's virgin birth, deity, miracles, prophecies, and bodily resurrection. He wrote, "To imagine [God] having a son in any particular sense, and this son to have been born of a virgin, and to have lived on earth for thirty years or so as a man; then to have died and to have risen from the dead is, as far as I am concerned. beyond credibility" (Jesus Rediscovered, p. 95). He theorized that some "body-snatcher" stole Jesus' body. By 1974, when he spoke at Lausanne I, Muggeridge professed to be a Christian of sorts, but he was *never* sound in the faith. He still denied the divine inspiration of Scripture and Jesus' bodily resurrection. In his 1975 book Jesus: The Man Who Lives, which was supposed to be his Christian testimony, Muggeridge said it is likely that the events of the resurrection, such as the empty tomb and the stone rolled away, could not have been caught on camera, and he continued to propose the wicked body snatching theory. Muggeridge had no testimony of the new birth, stating that his "conversion" was a "lifelong journey." Yet he spoke at Lausanne and was acclaimed by prominent evangelicals as a true Christian. The ecumenical spirit of Lausanne congress the was expressed in the Lausanne Covenant, which stated that "a growing

partnership of churches will develop and the universal character of Christ's church will be more clearly exhibited." This is the false idea of a universal "church" composed of all professing Christians, which is actually the apostate "one-world church." The March 2010 edition of the Lausanne World Pulse (a joint venture between Billy Graham and the Lausanne Committee) featured an article by Chandler Im entitled "Interfaith Interface with Buddhists," calling for participating in Buddhism in order to understand it. Im said, "I strongly concur with [Lesslie] Newbigin's claim that until one has felt in one's soul the dynamic power and influence of a great religion, one has not heard or understood the message of it." This is a dangerous recommendation that is forbidden by God's Word. See 2 6:14-18. Corinthians Newbigin denied the verbal inspiration of Scripture, claiming that the Bible is "not a set of timeless truths," Evangelicals have a frightful habit of quoting rank heretics without any warning. The March 2010 issue of Lausanne World Pulse also had an article "Sharing Christ in Hindu Contexts" which stated that Hindus who "accept Christ" do not have to be baptized or identify with a church, because it "isolates them from their native community." In the September 2009 Lausanne World Pulse, Philip Noss of the American Bible Society stated that "God reveals himself through his word and through each culture." This is not what the apostles taught. "And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness. ... Little children, keep yourselves from idols" (1 John 5:19-21). Modern evangelicalism is shot through and through with heretical thinking, and even those who are

Consider D.L. Moody's Northfield School for Girls and Mount Hermon School for Boys. The evangelist's goal was to educate young people in a gospelsaturated environment to produce Christian soldiers for God's work. In 1971, the schools merged as one

He sprinkled the building's walls with holy water, anointed the chapel's 17 crucifixes with oil, incensed the altar, lit candles, and set up an image of Mary. The ceremony featured a processional in which the bishop and priests carried the relics

of St. Thomas Aquinas and St. John Henry Newman for installation in the altars ("Chapel rededicated," *Greenfield Recorder*, Mar. 7, 2022). Changes to the building include two mass altars, confessional booths, and Stations of the Cross

**SWISS GOVERNMENT** FORCEFULLY REMOVES AND TRANSITIONS CHILD (Friday Church News Notes, October 11, 2024, www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "Swiss Parents." Standing for Freedom, Oct. 1, 2024: "Parents across the West must recognize that the left has declared cultural and spiritual war on the family and that they no longer have a choice but to engage in the battle--for what's at stake is nothing short of the physical well-being of their children and the sanctity of the parent-child bond. Switzerland's Federal Supreme Court has temporarily suspended criminal charges against a couple who refused to turn over their daughter's identity documents after she was removed from their home for refusing to transition her. Coming out of the pandemic, she informed her parents that she was a boy. ... In a meeting government officials told the parents that they had committed child abuse by seeking alternative treatment and to 'just accept that you have a son.' The transgender activist organization



told the girl that the psychiatrist her chosen parents had was 'transphobe,' and she immediately stopped treatment. In April 2023, a court order removed the girl from the parents' home and placed her in government custody. The girl is now in a government home and the state regulates contact between her and her parents. ... Sadly, this story is playing out in countries around the West, including in the United States. In a case that is hauntingly similar to that of the Swiss parents, a Maryland couple, military veterans no less, have filed suit against a Washington, D.C., hospital after the hospital effectively kidnapped their autistic son when they refused to allow him to be transitioned by hospital staff. They have since lost custody of their son."

TEACHER WINS LAWSUIT AGAINST SCHOOL THAT FIRED HIM OVER REFUSAL **TRANSSEXUAL** TO USE "PRONOUNS" (Friday Church News Notes, October 11, 2024, www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "VA school district settles lawsuit teacher over pronouns," with American Family News, Oct. 7, 2024: "A public school district has been ordered to pay more than a

half-million dollars to a terminated high school teacher to settle his 2019 lawsuit over transgender pronouns and compelled speech. West Point Public Schools, located in East Virginia, agreed to pay fired teacher Peter Vlaming \$575,000 in damages and attorneys' fees. Vlaming, who taught French, was terminated in a 5-0 school board vote ... The student. a female who said she was male, was accommodated by the school but not by Vlaming, who cited his conscience and his Christian faith. and refused. Vlaming agreed to call the student by his new male name, but he refused to use 'he' to refer to what he knew is a biological female. ... The settlement was announced by Alliance Defending Freedom, the religious liberty law firm that has represented Vlaming since he filed a federal lawsuit. After the teacher sued, the school district appeared to win its case after a circuit court judge dismissed the lawsuit. ADF appealed the case to the Supreme Court of Virginia, which overruled the lower court and ordered the lawsuit to proceed. In the state high court's ruling, it agreed Vlaming had been terminated because the school district compelled him to do



something that violated his religious beliefs. Caleb Dalton, senior counsel at ADF, says the case is not only about free speech but also about being compelled to knowingly lie."



But you would be surprised. Scientists were. Some butterflies are protected by distinctive, bright markings that indicate they are poisonous. But what about those butterflies that are bright and tasty? Tropical birds that eat butterflies are usually fast and very agile fliers. They often have long, pointed beaks well designed to catch butterflies. It would seem that butterflies wouldn't have a chance against fasterflying birds. In truth, it's the bird that has the greatest disadvantage. The muscles that control the tasty butterfly's wing are relatively stronger in terms of lifting power than a bird's muscle. Edwards' church. First Church of Northampton, was founded by English Puritans in 1654. Its third meetinghouse was built in 1737 during Edwards ministry and the Great Awakening. The current building was constructed in 1878 after the previous one was destroyed by fire. It is considered "one of the finest examples of High Victorian Neo-Gothic architecture in America." It features stained glass windows, an organ built by Ernest Skinner, and a clock weighing 1,600 pounds. In 1988, First Church of Christ of Northampton and First Baptist Church of Northampton combined to form one church known as "The First Churches." It is a member of World Council of Churches. Though the building is beautiful and historic, the church itself is apostate. It has a form of godliness but denies the power thereof, with no supernatural new birth gospel and no belief in the divinely inspired, inerrant Scripture. First Church "has been a forerunner in welcoming LGBTQ+ people into the life of the church." In 1996, the church officially became an "Open Affirming congregation," and meaning it "invites all to worship with us, without regard to differences such as race, gender identity, ability, sexual orientation ... or any other difference that may be misunderstood as a barrier to Christian fellowship." A rainbow homosexual rights flag is featured on the church sign and the church's web site, with photos of same-sex couples. 

I sometimes recommend commentators to the church. When I do I always recommend you. And I do it without reservation. I also recommend McGee, Ironside, Pentecost, Lehman Strauss and others at times. But with all of them I point out the issues with their theological positions. I never have to do that with your work and that's a huge benefit."

Yet, the thousands of members in an ant colony never run short of supplies even though there is no central organization and not one shopping list. Modern science is discovering how the ant's astonishing system works. An ant colony depends on worker ants to bring in water and supplies. In the morning, workers search mainly for drops of dew that can be carried into the nest. Some of the water is shared with nest mates. Some of the water is delivered to the brood chambers where immature ants are still developing. This water is used to soak the ground to keep the humidity inside the chamber high. Food is likewise collected by the workers and returned to the colony to be shared with every member of the colony. Food is most often shared by regurgitation. To learn how widespread this sharing in the colony is, researchers gave one worker ant sugar water that was radioactively tagged. Within a day, some of the tagged material had been shared with every



member of the colony. Within a week, every member of the colony had an equal amount of the tag. This means that through continuous food sharing every member of the colony always has an equal amount of food. When one worker is hungry, she knows that the entire colony is hungry.
