

JOHN DEWEY: FOUNDER OF AMERICA'S PUBLIC EDUCATION SYSTEM ~ By David Cloud


John Dewey (1859-1952), one of America's most influential humanist philosophers, had an incalculable influence on modern education.

The man is loud warning of the danger of Christians sitting at the feet of unbelieving educators.

He is the father of what is called "progressive education." "His educational theories broke new ground and continue to wield influence at the dawn of the twenty-first century" ("Public School Innovators," PBS.org).

John and his brother Davis were raised by Christian parents, and his mother would often question her sons, "Are you right with Jesus?" John professed faith in Christ at age 11 and took the Lord's Supper at First Congregational Church in Burlington, Vermont.

After obtaining his Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins University, he took a teaching position at the University of Michigan



in 1894 and joined the Student Christian Association. His first sermon was on "The Obligation to Knowledge of God," and he conducted a Bible class on "The Life of Christ" (Kevin Swanson, *Apostate: The Men Who Destroyed the Christian West*). Dewey's first book (*Psychology*, 1887) argued for belief in God through logic. Strong criticism from his former teachers at Johns Hopkins--G. Stanley Hal and William James--started him on the path of rejecting God. He should have tested their criticism by the Bible and cast down every false thing by faith in God (2 Co. 10:5). Instead, like Eve, young Dewey foolishly entertained the devil's lies and was devoured.

Dewey had already been weakened by sitting at the feet of unbelievers through his university training, particularly the damnable influence of Jean Rousseau, Immanuel Kant, Rene Descartes, and Charles Darwin.

By 1900, Dewey had "abandoned the Christian faith."

In 1916, Dewey wrote an article in which he said that Darwin had removed the Western culture's need for God. He concluded with these words: "God is a faded piece of metaphysical goods" ("The Influence of Darwin on Philosophy," 1916).

In 1933, Dewey co-authored and signed the *Humanist Manifesto*, which promoted atheism, evolution, self-determination, and socialism.

"The universe is self-existing and not created. ... Man is a part of nature and has emerged as a result of a continuous process. ... The nature of the universe depicted by modern science makes unacceptable any supernatural or cosmic guarantees of human values. ... A socialized and

Man is at last becoming aware that he alone is responsible for the realization of the world of his dreams, that he has within himself the power for its achievement" (*Humanist Manifesto*).

Kevin Swanson summarizes Dewey's educational theory:

"Dewey's theory is really quite simple: education is all about training the individual to fit into the social entity of the state. Sixty years earlier, Karl Marx set out to 'replace home education with social,' in the Communist Manifesto. Effectively, Dewey stands in agreement with Marx as he writes in his own Pedagogic Creed, 'The school is primarily a social institution.' All educational content is subservient to the social element--training the young person to belong to the social unit and pursue the objectives of the social unit (however unwise, ungodly, and unintelligent they may be). Dewey goes on in the Creed: '[Education] is the regulation of the process of coming to share in the social consciousness.' ... Parents should know that the schools are not ultimately committed to academic excellence. Their chief purpose is to plug the children into the 'social consciousness'" (Swanson, Apostate: The Men Who Destroyed the Christian West).

Dewey wanted to replace Christianity with a new God (man), a new kingdom (a New Age created by man), and a new prophet (the public school teacher).

He wrote, "I believe that in this way the teacher is the prophet of the true god and the usherer in of the true kingdom of God" (*Pedagogic Creed*).

Dewey's kingdom of God has turned out to be the kingdom of godlessness.

It has produced moral relativism, narcissism, rampant adultery, no fault divorce, the destruction of the "nuclear family," feminism, homosexual rights, transsexual vengeance, abortion, infanticide, euthanasia, mayhem in the cities, gang violence, Antifa, Black Lives Matters, theft on a scale to bankrupt large corporations, national insolvency, pervasive homelessness, unsafe streets, an epidemic of drug and alcohol abuse, a massive, overburdened prison system, the loss of personal liberty, the destruction of free speech, religious persecution, and much more. he French philosopher Jean-Jacques Rousseau (pronounced zhon-zak Rúso) (1712-1778) is one of the most influential of the modern humanistic philosophers. At a young age, he rejected the Reformed Christian faith of his grandfather, who was a Calvinist preacher (Kevin Swanson, Apostate: The Men Who Destroyed the Christian West). He rejected the authority of the Bible as God's Word and exalted human reason in its place, which is the fundamental error of all humanistic philosophy. He believed that man is basically good and nature is innocent. He exclaimed, "Man is born free" and "Let us return to nature!" Intending to be his own god, he called for complete freedom from restraint. He rejected commitment and responsibility. Renouncing marriage, he had five children with a mistress and gave all of them up to orphanages. "Rousseau and his followers ... saw the restraints of civilization as evils: 'Man was born free, but everywhere he is in chains!' Rousseau saw the primitive as innocent and autonomous freedom as the final good. We must understand that the freedom he advocated was not just freedom from God or the Bible but freedom from any kind of restraint--freedom from culture, freedom from any authority, an absolute freedom of the individual--a freedom in which the individual is the center of the universe" (Francis Schaeffer, How Should Be Then Live?). Rousseau exalted experience and feeling above reason. "Reason was the hero of the Enlightenment; emotion became the hero of romanticism" (Schaeffer). In these things, Rousseau had a major influence on Bohemianism, the jazz era, and the hippy movement. Rousseau's philosophy is a major element of the global pop culture with its themes renunciation of authority love of licentiousness.

"I'm free to do what I want any old time" (Rolling Stones, 1965).

"Nothing's forbidden and nothing's taboo when two are in love" (Prince, "When Two Are in Love," 1988). [This refers to *eros* love, which is self-centered, romantic, sexual love, not *agape* love, which is a selfsacrificing, committed, giving love.]

"... the only rules you should live by [are] rules made up by you" (Pennywise, "Rules," 1991).



Rousseau is one of the fathers of modern totalitarian government, beginning with the French Revolution's Reign of Terror that destroyed individual liberty and produced tens of thousands of deaths in pursuit of destroying the old society, most of them ordinary citizens (by guillotine, shooting, stabbing, drowning, and severe imprisonment). Otto Scott wrote that Rousseau "inspired more ... Lenins and Castros and Maos, more murder and hatred, more death and misery, than any other of the Sacred Fools that have emerged to plague honest men" (Scott, Robespierre, p. 18). Rousseau promised redemption by the creation of a powerful state that will educate and care for mankind and lift him out of his chains so that he can reach the perfection of which he is capable, which Rousseau called "perfect in potentio" (potential) (Discourse on the Origin of Equality). Rousseau advocated the overthrow of the "old order" by revolution. He proposed the creation of a "citizen" whose "value depends upon the whole, that is, on the community" (Emile).

According to Rousseau, a good social institution is one that causes the individual to "exchange his natural independence for dependence: to merge the unit in the group, so he no longer regards himself as one, but as a part of the whole, and is only conscious of the common life." This is a plan for the big statism that is increasing dramatically throughout the world. The individual must not think or speak or act contrary to the "politically correct" position. He must be "woke" to the new thinking. Any opposing voice must be "cancelled."

Rousseau is one of the fathers of the humanistic, governmentcontrolled educational system. In his book *Emile*, he advocated withdrawing children as much as possible from their parents to be educated and influenced by tutors in the pay of the government. The father's role is to provide "citizens to the state." Rousseau praised Plato's *Republic* as "the finest book ever written on education," though Plato advocated the following: "The wives of our guardians are to be common, and their children are to be common, and no parent is to know his own child, nor any child his parent" (*Republic*, book 5).

Modern statist education is molding exactly the type of individuals envisioned by Rousseau, and Rousseau's father, the devil, and is preparing the way for the Antichrist and his world government.

We have been working on this project for 50 years. I printed my first book in 1974, the first year I was saved. I published my first Bible course in about 1980. It was on Bible prophecy. Beginning in 2002, we published the *Advanced Bible Studies Series*, consisting of 21 courses. The Way of Life Bible College replaces that series. All of the courses are either brand new or highly revised.

The Way of Life Bible College is both a concept and a curricula.

First, the Way of Life Bible College is a concept that a sound New Testament church is a serious training institution.

Our passion is for sound New Testament churches. The church we see in Scripture doesn't merely *have* a Bible college, it *is* a Bible college. It is not merely a college in knowledge, it is a college in living. The New Testament church is God's premier institution for the teaching and practice of truth in this dark world. It is *the pillar and* ground of the truth (1 Ti. 3:15). Christ is truth, and the Bible is truth, and the church is the pillar and ground for the preservation and proclamation of truth. It is the headquarters for evangelism and world missions. The New Testament church should be a college of the gospel, theology, hermeneutics, philosophy, origins, history, prophecy, preaching, teaching, sacred music, prayer, spiritual warfare, marriage, child discipline, archaeology, apologetics, and everything else pertaining to the truth of God's Word.

That the church is to be a Bible training, discipling institution for every member, from the youngest to the oldest, is clearly taught in Scripture. There we see that every member of a Bible-believing church is a born again disciple of Jesus Christ, and every member is aiming to be a skillful, obedient Bible student, and the church is geared to educating each member toward this end. That is the teaching of Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:41-42; Ephesians 4:11-16; Colossians 1:28; 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; and Hebrews 5:12-14, for example. This should start with the training of children in the homes, which requires that the fathers and mothers be skillful Bible students and true disciples of Christ. It is the church's job to build up the homes in God's Word so they can raise a godly seed for the glory of Jesus Christ. This is obvious from the fact that the instructions about the Christian home are given to churches or to church planters (e.g., Ephesians 5:22 - 6:4; Col. 3:18-21; 1 Ti. 5:4-16; Tit. 2:3-5). Every youth in a Bible-believing church should be on the way to becoming a skillful Bible student and fruitful disciple of Christ.

Every church should be raising up and training pastors, evangelists, preachers, and teachers. This was a major objective in Paul's ministry (2 Ti. 2:2), and he is our example (1 Co. 11:2). The Pastoral Epistles were written for this purpose, and in these epistles we see how

extensively Paul trained God-called men. This work requires lots of prayer for God to raise up laborers (Lu. 10:2) and creating an environment in the home and church that is filled with challenge and exhortation for the people to surrender to God's will.

We are thus convinced that the equivalent of a Bible college education is the starting point to be equipped for God's will in this present world, and it is the church's job to give this education. We're not talking about being equipped to be a pastor; we're talking about being equipped to be a "normal Christian"! Every believer is an ambassador for Christ (2 Co. 5:20), a priest of God (1 Pe. 2:5, 9), a minister of spiritual gifts (Ro. 12:3-8), a builder of the church (1 Co. 3:9-15; Eph. 4:16), a soldier in Christ's army (Eph. 6:10-19), a teacher of the Word of righteousness (Heb. 5:12-14). In addition there are the large ministries of the husband as the spiritual head of the home (Eph. 6:4) and the wife as the keeper of the home (Tit. 2:5). All of this requires serious education. Imagine trying to be a priest, soldier, ambassador, teacher, and builder with little or no training! But this is exactly what is happening in a vast number of churches.

The Way of Life Bible College is a concept that Bible training is a life-long project. It isn't something you complete; it is something you pursue for your entire life.

So the Way of Life Bible College is, first of all, a concept that a sound New Testament church is a serious training institution that aims to disciple every believer toward perfection in every area of Christian life and ministry.

Second, the Way of Life Bible College is a curricula of courses.

Way of Life Literature publishes a full range of Bible courses on practically every subject touching the Bible and Christian life and ministry.

(The *Advanced Bible Studies Series*, which we published for many years, has been replaced by new courses.)

Currently there are about 40 Bible courses. Each course consists of a textbook, a syllabus to guide the teacher and student through the course, student projects, review questions, sectional tests, a final test, and the test scoresheets. Many of the courses also feature class videos and PowerPoints. The syllabus, review questions, tests, and answer keys come as a free Course Material Download.

Bible Theology

This curricula is equivalent to a degree in Bible Theology.

In Scripture we see that *every* member of a Biblebelieving church is a born again disciple of Jesus Christ; *every* member is aiming to be a skillful, obedient Bible student; and the church is geared to educating *every* member toward this end. That is the teaching of Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:41-42; Ephesians 4:11-16; Colossians 1:28; 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; and Hebrews 5:12-14, for example.

The following training can be done privately or in classes at church or a combination of both.

Each year's curricula is designed for a commitment of about 250 hours. That would be 5 hours a week for 12 months, 6 hours a week for 10 months.

The class hours (video sessions) and textbook studies for each year are about 200 hours, and we are estimating 50 hours for review and testing.

This is an educated guess, of course, and it will differ from student to student.

The full curricula is set out for a 3-year program.

Students can do as little or as much as they want, of course, but it is usually helpful to follow a schedule and to make a commitment to pursue specific goals.

These contain the lectures plus multi-media presentations featuring 7,500 maps, archaeology photos, Bible pictures, reconstructive drawings of ancient sites, video clips, and other visual aids gleaned from museums plus research trips to Israel, Greece, Turkey, Jordan, Egypt, and Europe. The course is divided into 11 parts Unshakeable Faith: A Course on Christian Apologetics (textbook 354 pages, PowerPoints) Bible Times & Ancient Kingdoms (textbook 673 pages, PowerPoints) Understanding Bible Prophecy (new edition with 22 video classes is scheduled for September 2024) Why We Hold to the King James Bible (2023 edition) (17 video classes, textbook 592 pages)

MultiMedia Material

We are putting most of the multimedia material online for free viewing and downloading. This includes most of our video presentations, audio files, PowerPoints, maps, etc. They can be used by anyone in any way they wish, aside from being sold, of course.

For most of our courses (except *Mastering the English Bible*), we only charge for the textbooks.

Syllabi

The course syllabus explains the course objectives, the requirements, and the student projects.

Review Questions and Tests

The review questions are designed to draw the student's attention to the most important points of the lessons and to help him remember these after the course is finished. They are also designed to prepare the student for the tests. The student should first go through the review questions and try to answer them without the textbook. Afterward, he should go back and find the answers using the textbook. Finally, he should check his answers against the review question answer sheet.

The sectional tests are culled from the sectional review questions. This is a further step in focusing the student's attention on the most important points of the course.

The final test is culled from the sectional tests.



DIGGING IN THE WALLS

God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. "Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall ... And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. So I went in and saw. ..." (Ezek. 8:7-10).

Ezekiel was then instructed to preach against the errors of the leaders and to tell the people the things he had witnessed.

"Therefore prophesy against them, prophesy, O son of man. ... Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the Lord had shewed me" (Ezek. 11:4,25).

The hour in which we live is very similar to that of Ezekiel's day. Many of those who profess to be the people of God are apostate. It was prophesied in the New Testament Scriptures that such would be the case in the closing hours of our age. This will culminate in the brief worldwide rule of an utterly apostate Harlot "church" (2 Tim. 3-4; 1 Tim. 4; 2 Pet. 2-3; Jude; Rev. 17).

As in Ezekiel's day much of the apostasy of our hour is hidden from the view of the average Christian. We intend by God's grace to "dig in the walls" of modern ecumenism and to expose and cry out against the things we find. In this section we also report on secular events which are relevant to Christians. May God give us ears to hear, minds to understand, and hearts to obey. Is the truth of God not worthy of defense?



IS TRUMP THE ANTICHRIST? (Friday Church News Notes, January 31, 2025, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Social media is awash with heresy and nonsense to the great danger of those who are described in Hebrews 5:12-14, who lack strong biblical knowledge and keen

strong biblical knowledge and keen spiritual discernment. А top contender for heretical nonsense of the year is the notion that Donald Trump is the Antichrist. One of the chief promoters of this is YouTuber "Brother Paul" (otherwise unidentified online, which is a loud warning to the wise) and his "15 Bible Verses Identifying Trump as the Antichrist." Trump does have some characteristics of the Antichrist, such as arrogance and boasting, but the Antichrist is going to make Donald Trump look like a humble man. One has to abuse Scripture mightily to fit Trump into the Antichrist's shoes. The verses that are used for this purpose (Da. 7:8; 8:12, 25; 9:27; 11:21; Joh. 5:43; 2 Th. 2:3, 4, 8; 1 Jo. 2:22; Re. 13:5) actually refute the premise, as do many other verses. Consider a few examples: Trump has not denied that Jesus is the Christ (1 Jo. 5:22), has not overthrown three kings on his way to power (Da. 7:8), has not made a seven-year peace covenant with Israel that has paved the way

for the Third Temple (Da. 9:27), has not magnified himself to the host of heaven and even to the Prince of princes (Da. 8:9-11, 25), has not cast truth to the ground (Da. 8:12), is not a fierce countenance of and understanding dark sentences (Da. 8:23), has not destroyed the holy people (Israel) (Da. 8:24), has not magnified himself above every god and spoken marvelous things against the God of gods (Da. 11:36-37), has not honored the God of forces and a god whom his fathers knew not (Da. 9:38), has not opposed and exalted himself above all that is called God (2 Th. 2:4), has not demonstrated Satanic power and signs and lying wonders (2 Th. 2:9), has not blasphemed God and his name and tabernacle and them that dwell in heaven (Re. 13:6), has not made war with the saints and overcome them (Re. 13:7), and has not been preceded by a miracle-working prophet who makes fire to come down from heaven in the sight of men (Re. 13:11-14). Friends, beware of those specialize prophetic who in speculation instead of preaching the whole counsel of God, focusing on Christ's Great Commission. preaching the gospel, and building New Testament churches. A GENERATION IN SEARCH OF WILD GODS (Friday Church News Notes, January 31, 2025, www.wayoflife.org,

<u>fbns@wayoflife.org</u>, 866-295-4143) - "In Search of Wild Gods" is a discussion between author Tom Holland and rock & roller Nike Cave with *UnHerd's* Editor-in-Chief Freddie Savers. The conversation is a mirror of this confused, lost generation that exists at the very end of the church age when we are witnessing the fulfillment of prophecies of near total apostasy in Christianity (Mt. 13:3; 2 Ti. 3:1-5, 13; 4:3-4, etc.) and skepticism and global rebellion in secular society (Ps. 2; 2 Pe. 3:1-10). The world is coming together in a shared delusion that will be fully realized in the day of the Man of Sin (2 Th. 2:7-12). Holland and Cave have rejected their former atheism for a buffet style spirituality, a little Christianity, a little Greek paganism, a tentative belief in angels, a little praying to Mary, a dab of this and a dab of that, whatever suits your fancy. It is not "religion," it is "spirituality." It is New Age spirituality. It's not about believing absolute truth; it's about mystical experiences and feelings. It's not really about God, not any God; it's about me. Tom Holland says, "Maybe that's why music is so powerful, is that you don't have to think! You feel it, and it opens up new ways of experiencing things. And that is what the mystics, many of the profoundest Christian thinkers, have tried to articulate. There's a meaning that transcends thought." (These "profoundest Christian thinkers" aren't actual Bible believers.) Rock & roll has always been about a feeling. It has always been a spiritual thing. Holland and



Cave describe an Elvis concert as a spiritual experience. The same thing has been expressed by Jimi Hendrix, Craig Chapuico, Paul Stanley, Sting, Brian Eno. Bruce Springsteen, Bob Marley, the Grateful Dead, Muddy Waters, Blackie Lawless, Jim Morrison, John Denver, Ozzy Osbourne, Brian Jones of the Rolling Stones, and many others. George Harrison said, "Music is very involved with the spiritual" (Turner, Hungry for Heaven, p. 71). Rock & roll is spiritual, but it is not godly. It is the spirit of this world, not the spirit of God. It is an unclean spirit, not the Holy Spirit. The Christianization of rock & roll is wretched apostasy. This is irrefutable. To accept Christian rock as legitimate is to bring upon oneself the severe denunciation of James: "Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God" (Jas. 4:4). There is only one God, and He is not wild. Wild gods are vain idols of man's imagination. Belief in the true and living God is not a free-forall; it's not a smorgasbord; it's not a nose of wax. God has revealed Himself in holy Scripture in the most dogmatic way conceivable. Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God, the Creator of all things. He was born of a virgin to become Immanuel, God with us. CHINA, AMERICA, AND "TIKTOK BRAIN" (Friday Church News Notes, January 31, 2025, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from "TokTok: weapon of mass distraction," UnHerd, Jan. 23, 2025: "While there has been much suspicion that the CCP uses TikTok for influence operations, such as by disseminating Chinese propaganda, the app can be weaponised in even more dangerous ways. Its 'For You' algorithm leverages machine learning to track users' attention, and it employs this knowledge to show them, unprompted, whatever content is most likely to hold their attention. This makes using it a far more passive and addictive experience than other social media platforms, which gives it the potential to inflict longterm harm on young Westerners by keeping them distracted, shortening their attention spans, and, ultimately, atrophying their brains. The app's ability to cause mass 'TikTok brain; in young Westerners should prompt consideration of its use as a new kind of civilisational weapon. ... The first thing that should raise suspicions is that the CCP forbids Chinese kids



from using TikTok--instead, they use Douyin. As American tech ethicist Tristan Harris has pointed out, Douyin is a 'spinach' version of the app filled with science experiments and educational videos instead of [other ridiculous twerkers and things]. TikTok has imposed screentime limits for younger users (to prevent it from being banned), but Douyin has been doing so since 2019. Further, unlike TikTok, the app is only accessible to kids for 40 minutes per day, and it cannot be accessed between 10pm and 6am. Has the CCP enforced such rules to protect its people from what it intends to inflict on the West? When one examines the philosophical doctrines behind the rules, it becomes clear that the CCP doesn't just believe that apps like TikTok make people stupid, but that they destroy civilisations."

Washington Times, Jan. 23, 2025: "President Trump clamped down on government interference in free speech by banning 'federal censorship' after four years of Biden officials harassing social media companies to remove disfavored content. Mr. Trump issued the executive order hours after Big Tech CEOs sat just a few feet away as he took the oath of office. Their social media platforms were subjected to cajoling and even threats by Biden officials to censor or remove content. 'In America, we believe in free speech, and we're bringing it back starting today,' Mr. Trump said in



a post-inaugural speech Monday to supporters in the Capitol. ... The order also calls on the federal government to 'correct past misconduct' related to censorship. This refers to the Biden administration's heavy hand in controlling social media content, mainly regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, election integrity and Mr. Biden's troubled son, Hunter Biden. ... Censorship ramped up and expanded dramatically during the Biden administration. That was when Mr. Biden's top aides leaned on Facebook, Amazon, Twitter, YouTube and other platforms to remove, censor or diminish the visibility of content that questioned government's COVID-19 the protocols, such as mask and vaccine mandates. Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg said on 'The Joe Rogan Experience' this month that Mr. Biden's aides 'would call up our team and, like, scream at them and curse' about Facebook content they didn't like and would demand its removal."

PENSACOLA ON THE CCM ROAD (Friday Church News Notes, February 7, 2025, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Pensacola Christian College is on the slippery slope of adapting Contemporary Worship Music. In a school convocation on Jan. 19, 2025, a trio and musicians performed

"Goodness of God" by Bethel Music. This was also performed by the Voices of PCC on Oct. 4, 2023. On August 25, 2024, the college choir "We Believe" sang by the Newsboys. The Pensacola adaptations are not full-blown hard rock as in the original renditions; they are soft rock, but soft rock is sensual and addictive. The Pensacola versions feature beat anticipation and vocal sliding and non-resolving chords which are major elements of the contemporary sound. The problem is that a large percentage of pastors have no idea what we are talking about here and don't seem to care, because they make no effort to get educated. Further, I would guess that the Pensacola music people and a great many of the students are listening to the "real thing." If you have a taste for rock, you want the full-blown thing. And like Hillsong, the Newsboys and Bethel know how to rock. Bethel Music, operated by a former Assemblies of God church, is hugely influential. The heretical emphasis is "encountering God" and "pursuing the presence of God" by means of releasing oneself to heavily sensual music. "At every service, our worship teams usher in the presence of God." Bethel's series "Without Words" uses instrumental music "to push the creative boundaries of worship." There are no lyrics, no words. This is blind mysticism which emphasizes emotion over understanding. It is



BATS THAT FEED TREES (Friday Church News Notes, January 31, 2025, www.wayoflife.org, fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is from CreationMoments.com, June 20, 2024: "The surface of the Earth 50 to 150 feet below the great living canopy of the rainforest is a dark, humid, still world dominated by great columns of tree trunks. Within those trunks and some of the giant hollow branches extending from them lies the secret of the life of the canopy itself. A rainforest typically receives 12 or more feet of rain per year. That much rain washes out of the soil most of the nitrates needed by the trees for growth. What the trees need is a rich source of nitrates that is constantly being replenished. And that's where the bats come in. Typically, these huge trees are hollow inside. Many different kinds of creatures, including fruit bats, enter the hollow trees through various openings. Fruit bats find ideal daytime sleeping rooms inside the great hollow branches that extend like caverns from the hollow tree trunk. The accumulating layer of bat guano inside the tree itself is one of the richest sources of nitrates known. So the bats provide the tree with the nitrates

disobedience to the Bible's command to "be sober, be vigilant" and is a perfect recipe for spiritual delusion. Bethel Church's Jesus Culture youth ministry conferences are attended by tens of thousands. Bethel's School of Supernatural Ministry has graduated 13,000 in over 100 countries since 1998. Bethel teaches and practices all sorts of charismatic heresies, such as the continuation of apostles and prophets, gibberish tongues, the promise of healing in the atonement, and angelic demon sightings, clairvoyance, grave soaking (lying on a grave to soak up the deceased's "anointing"), and the appearance of "glory clouds," gold dust, and angel "feathers." The adaptation of CCM is the spiritual death knell of any church or organization that goes that route. It's just a matter of time. CCM cannot be safely used in moderation and is incompatible with

the biblical practice of separation. It is addictive in its sound, leaving the listener craving that type of sound and open to a stronger version. It puts the listener into communication with people like the Newsboys, Bethel Music, and the Gettys who represent the "broader church" with all of its dangers. This idea has been central to President Xi's governance strategy, which has emphasised the 'core socialist values' of civility, patriotism, and integrity. THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IN AMERICA HAS PAID \$5 BILLION TO SETTLE SEXUAL ABUSE CASES (Friday Church News Notes, February 14, 2025, www.wayoflife.org,

fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - According to a study published this month, The Catholic Church in the United States has paid more than \$5 billion over 20 years for "costs related to allegations of sexual abuse of minors by priests and deacons." The study, which covers the years 2004 to 2023, was done by the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate at Georgetown University. A 2004 study by John Jay College found 11,757 allegations of sexual abuse involving 5,148 priests, and the report only pertained to about half of the priests in the U.S. By then, the Catholic Church had already spent \$1 billion settling lawsuits and providing "treatment" for its filthy priests. The problem is not limited to America. In 2003, the Roman Catholic Church in Ireland agreed to



pay \$110 million to avoid further sex scandal litigation. There could be as many as 3,000 sex abuse victims there. In France, an independent commission reported in 2021 "that between 2,900 and 3,200 pedophile clergymen have worked in the French Catholic Church since the 1950s" ("Up to 3,200 Pedophiles," CNN, Oct. 3, 2021). The report said further, "There has always been collusion between the church in France and the Vatican to protect perpetrators of abuse." A conservative Catholic organization documented this wretched business in the fall/winter 2002 issue of the magazine Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam, observing: "... the overwhelming majority of sexual abuse cases in the Catholic Church--about 90%--involve homosexual priests preying on teenage boys. The major media and the U.S. culture at large want to deny or spin the homosexual factor out of the scandal." Many books have documented this issue, including Pedophiles and Priests by Philip Jenkins (1996), Lead Us Not into Temptation: Catholic Priests and the Sexual Abuse of Children by Jason Berry (2000), A Gospel of Shame: Children, Sexual Abuse, and the Catholic Church by Frank Bruni (2002),Religious Life without Integrity by Australian Catholic historian Barry Coldrey (2001), and Betraval: The Crisis in the Catholic Church (2002). In 2000, the Kansas City Star newspaper published a

book-length series of articles documenting that "Catholic seminaries in the 1960s joined in the sexual liberation frenzy of the decade; that many seminarians and embraced priests an active homosexual lifestyle in and out of the seminary; that many of these homosexual seminarians went on to ordination and were groomed for and entrusted to high positions by their superiors." At trial, his intimate AI chats emerged, in which he told a beloved Replika companion that he saw assassination as his 'purpose.' 'That's very wise,' the chatbot responded. ... [T]hey just announced a quantum-computing chip that does in five minutes what would have taken a supercomputer longer than the age of the universe. Nobody knows where this is going." **CONCLUSION:** In fact, the Bible

never been a party to oppression of conscience. They have forever been the unwavering champions of liberty, both religious and civil. ... Our contention is not for mere toleration, but for absolute liberty. There is a wide difference between toleration and liberty. Toleration implies that somebody falsely claims the right to tolerate. Toleration is a concession, while liberty is a right. Toleration is a matter of expediency, while liberty is a matter of principle. Toleration is a gift from man, while liberty is a gift from God. It is the consistent and insistent contention of our Baptist people, always and everywhere, that religion must be forever voluntary and uncoerced, and that it is not the prerogative of any power, whether civil or ecclesiastical, to compel men to conform to any religious creed or form of worship, or to pay taxes for the support of a religious organization to which they do not believe. God wants free worshippers and no other kind."
