
HYMNS - WESLEY'S MAGNIFICENT HYMNS ON CHRIST'S INCARNATION By David Cloud

harles Wesley's *Hymns for the Nativity of the Lord* (December 1745) proclaim, in peerless poetry, the glories of Christ's incarnation. The collection is not merely about a babe in the manger; it is about the magnificent mystery of God manifest in the flesh. This is the true message of Christmas. (The original collection consisted of 18 hymns. Three more were added to the 1810 edition.)

Hymns for the Nativity was very popular, going through about 25 printings in Wesley's lifetime. It is readily available online today.

The only well-known hymn that remains from this collection is "Come, Thou Long Expected Jesus," which was hymn number X.



In this collection, every biblical aspect of Christ's incarnation is considered. Wesley looks at Christ's nativity in light of God's eternal plan described in Eph. 1:10. The plan begins in eternity with the Triune God. The coming of Christ was prepared by God's covenant with

Abraham, the creation of Israel, and the giving of the law and the prophets. In the fulness of time, the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world (1 Jo. 4:14). The Son came willingly, was born a virgin, became the God-man (*Immanuel*), lived a sinless life, performed miracles, spoke as no man ever spoke, made the vicarious atonement for man's sin, rose from the dead, instructed His disciples to preach the gospel to the ends of the earth in the church age, ascended to heaven, sits at the right hand of the Father as our High Priest, is coming again to reign on David's throne, will judge all of the unsaved at the great white throne judgment, will make a new heaven and a new earth, will reign forever as the Head of the new creation. Then, all things will be one in Christ, both in heaven and in earth (Eph. 1:10).

In Hymns for the Nativity of the Lord, Wesley considers

- The incarnation's mystery and paradox (God made man)
- its purpose (Christ's vicarious sacrifice, resurrection, the eternal redemption of sinners, and the new creation with all things made one in Christ)
- its revelation of God (infinite power, infinite love, infinite grace and mercy, infinite wisdom, infinite holiness)
- its infinite benefits to man
- its infinite instruction for men and angels
- its endless delight as the subject of meditation
- the necessity of proclaiming it to all men

The delightful, challenging lyrics are bursting with instruction. Nearly every stanza is a perfect theological jewel. They "are sprinkled with vivid, arresting, and provocative phrases as well as soul-lifting and exhilarating thought. The spirit is that of adoration and wonder" (T. Crichton Mitchell, *Charles Wesley: Man with the Dancing Heart*, p. 196).

The words are striking, remarkable, memorable.

Consider Hymn X, "Come, thou long-expected Jesus," stanza 2. Observe the repetition of "Born" in stating the purpose of Christ's incarnation. Note the imperatives addressed to Christ: "Now bring ... Rule ... Raise." This is dramatic praying based on the promises of God's Word. Christ taught us to pray like this: "After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven,

Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven. Give us ... forgive us ... lead us ... deliver us..." (Mt. 6:9-13).

Born thy people to deliver,
Born a Child, and yet a King,
Born to reign in us for ever,
Now thy gracious kingdom bring;
By thy own eternal Spirit,
Rule in all our hearts alone,
By thy all-sufficient merit,
Raise us to thy glorious throne. (Hymn X, stanza 2)



The Cambridge Seven were students from Cambridge (one was from the Royal Military Academy) who were saved during their student years and volunteered to go to China with J. Hudson Taylor's China Inland Mission. They made this commitment during the 1883 Moody-Sankey crusade at Cambridge.

The most famous of the seven was CHARLES THOM-AS (C.T.) STUDD (1860-1931), a renowned cricketer and graduate of Eton and Cambridge. C.T.'s brothers were also cricket stars. C.T. was the captain of the famous Cambridge Eleven team in 1882. Their father, Edward, had made a fortune in India planting indigo and planned to spend the rest of his life playing. He lived in a mansion on a large estate and had his own cricket field. He gambled and raised race horses. His horse Salamander won the Grand National in 1866. This is a grueling four mile race with 30 jumps. It's called a steeplechase. In 1877, at age 56, Edward attended a D.L. Moody meeting and was saved. He gave up gambling and sold his race horses and started hosting gospel meetings in his large house. His coachman said, "All I can say is that though there's the same skin, there's a new man inside." One of his sons later wrote, "Father had been full of a thing that takes more possession of a man's heart and head than anything else, the passion for horse racing, and in the evening he was a changed man." That's a real born again salvation, and there is no other kind. Edward lived only two years after he was saved, but it was said that he did more for Christ during that time than most do in a lifetime. C.T. and his brothers didn't like the change in their father at first, but they were converted in 1878 through an evangelist associated with Moody. C.T. said, "I got down on my knees and I did say 'thank you' to God. And right then and there joy and peace came into my soul. I knew then what it was to be 'born again,' and the Bible which had been so dry to me before, became everything." Over the next six years, through the influence of secular college and sports, he got into "an unhappy backslidden state," but during his brother's illness in 1884 C.T. surrendered his life unreservedly to Christ. He turned his back on a life of wealth, pleasure, and leisure and served as a missionary in China, India, and Africa until his death. He came to the realization that a life outside of God's perfect will is meaningless. He said, "I know that cricket would not last, and honour would not last, and nothing in this world would last, but it was worthwhile living for the world to come." He wrote the poem "Only one life, 'twill soon be past, only what's done for Christ will last."

Studd described the change like this:

"The real thing came before me. ... The commands of Christ became not merely Sunday recitations, but battle calls to be obeyed, unless one would lose one's self-respect and manhood. Assent to creed was born again into decisive action of obedience. Orthodoxy became reality. Instead of saying 'Lord, Lord' in a most reverent voice many times and yet continuing deaf to the simplest commandments, I began to look upon God as really my Father and to rely upon Him as a real Father and to trust Him as such. Instead of talking about fellowship, I enjoyed it. ... I talked of God and Jesus Christ as Real, Living, Personal Friends and Relations. They have never chided me for it. If a man is willing to obey and sacrifice, he soon learns what is the blessed reality of the fellowship of God's Son Jesus Christ--familiar and social intercourse."

Before C.T. Studd went to China as a missionary, he gave away his large inheritance. He believed Jesus' promise to give him a hundredfold (Mt. 19:29), saying, "An hundredfold is a wonderful percentage; it is 10,000 percent." He said the Bank of Heaven is safer than the Bank of England. He distributed the money to evangelistic and missionary endeavors: Moody Bible Institute, George Müller's orphanages, the Salvation Army, and others. "As coolly and deliberately as a business man invests in some 'gilt-edged' securities, as being both safe and yielding good interest, so C.T. invested in the Bank of Heaven. This was no fool's plunge on his part. It was his public testimony before God and man that he believed God's Word to be the surest thing on earth, and that the hundredfold interest which God has promised in this life, not to speak of the next, is an actual reality for those who believe it and act on it" (Norman Grubb, C.T. Studd Cricketer and Pioneer).

In China, Studd married an Irish missionary named Priscilla Stewart, who was called "Scilla." She had surrendered to missionary work after her conversion. But before she was born again, Scilla was a party girl. She said, "I am a missionary now, but I was not made that way. Had you asked me to come to a meeting when I was a girl, I would have said, 'No, thank you, none of your religion for me'; for my idea of a person loving God was to have a face as long as a coffee pot."

Before their engagement, C.T. wrote to his mother as follows, "She ain't very big, and as regards her face, well, she has the beauty of the Lord her God upon her, which is worth more than all the beauty of the whole world. ... she can also play the harmonium or organ and sing a bit ... she doesn't fear the face of man or woman a little bit, I do believe, but just fires away at everybody she meets about their souls." Scilla was a Salvation Army "lassie" who participated in street evangelism.

Later, C.T. said, "I did not marry her for her pretty face; I married her for her handsome actions towards the Lord Jesus Christ and those He sent her to save. ... In fact, until this day I verily believe that of all God's many good gifts, the least of all is good looks."

Before they were married, C.T. gave Scilla 3,400 British pounds he had kept back from his inheritance. He kept this because of God's Word which says, "But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an

infidel" (1 Ti. 5:8). She decided to give even that away. "She, not to be outdone, said, 'Charlie, what did the Lord tell the rich young man to do?' 'Sell all.' 'Well then, we will start clean with the Lord at our wedding.' She gave the money to the Salvation Army. In her letter to General Booth she said, "Henceforth our bank is in heaven. You see we are rather afraid--notwithstanding the great earthly safety of Messrs. Coutts and Co. and the Bank of England--we are, I say, rather afraid that they may both break on the Judgment Day."

Of course, the Lord took care of them throughout their lives. One example will suffice:

"My own family knew nothing of our circumstances, only that we were in the heart of China. The last of our supplies was finished, and there was no apparent hope of supplies of any kind coming from any human source. The mail came once a fortnight. The mailman had just set out that afternoon, and in a fortnight he would bring the return mail. The children were put to bed. Then my wife came to my room. We had looked facts in the face. If the return of the postman brought no relief, starvation stared us in the face. ... We got on our knees for that purpose. I think we must have stayed there twenty minutes before we rose again. ... Our hearts were relieved; it did not seem to us either reverence or common sense to keep on talking to God as though He were deaf or could not understand our simple language, or the extremity of our circumstances ... The mailman returned at the appointed time. ... out came another letter ... I looked at the signature first, one wholly unknown to me. 'I have,' he said, 'for some reason or other received the command of God to send you a check for 100 pounds. I have never met you, I have only heard of you, and that not often, but God has prevented me from sleeping tonight by this command."

C.T. and Scilla had four daughters: Salvation Grace Faith, Dorothy Catherine, Edith Mary, and Pauline Evangeline. C.T. believed that God gave them girls so they could show the value of females to the pagan Chinese people.

"One of the curses of China is not to let their little girls live. They say they have the trouble of bringing them up, and then when they are married, the dowry they receive does not make up for all that has been spent on them. I went into a mother's house once and found her groaning, and asked where the baby was. It was born at daylight and immediately it was

thrown into a moat, or perhaps into one of the pagodas--which are built for this purpose with a certain hole so that the wolves can jump in and get the baby when they want it" (Norman Grubbs, *C.T. Studd*).

All of their daughters lived to adulthood and married, and two were missionaries.

Studd believed in living by faith and trusting God to meet every need. He believed that all who die without faith in Christ will face eternal punishment. He said, "Some want to live within the sound of church or chapel bell; I want to run a rescue shop within a yard of hell."

In 1885, before the Cambridge Seven left England, they toured university campuses of the United Kingdom. A booklet of their testimonies was published, and Queen Victoria expressed gratitude at the receipt of a copy.

The Evangelisation of the World: A Missionary Band became a bestseller. It was distributed to every YMCA and YWCA in the United States and the British Empire. All seven men had successful missionary careers. Their example produced an explosion of student missionary volunteers. The China Inland Mission itself grew from 163 missionaries in 1885 to 800 by 1900.

The live at the end of the church age in the depths of apostasy at the end of the church age. The little leaven that began in the days of the apostles has leavened "Christendom" for two millennia, until the whole is almost leavened.

And never has it been so easy for people to come into contact with every type of heresy and goofy principle, from emerging church to flat earth, from Christian rock to New Age dieting, from theistic evolution to yoga.

When I was a new Christian, I didn't have spiritual guidance in a sound church for the first few weeks and was tossed to and fro in the sea of apostasy. I was confronted with Pentecostalism, Seventh-day Adventism, and Herbert W. Armstrongism. And in that day, to encounter heresies one had to attend a church or Bible study, visit a bookstore or library, watch "Christian" programming on television, or listen to a "Christian" radio program.

Now all one has to do is surf the web with the everpresent smartphone and scroll through a fathomless selection of error.

Consider the following testimonies about this danger:

"It is my observation one of the greatest dangers of the internet technology is that it brings (literally) thousands of teachers into your home. Any church member now, in the absence of serious biblical study, can hold forth on any topic by putting the verses in question in Google and then quoting his favorite teacher. The speaker has no knowledge

of the subject, no knowledge of the teacher. I had a man in our congregation who got involved with many different online 'Baptist' teachers. He adopted all kinds of silly doctrines (amillennialism, no eternal security, etc). He was at best, a baby Christian, with no time in the Word of God, but because he read all these people, he considered himself an expert. He was shocked when I told him to stop reading all those teachers. It is shocking to Americans to tell them that. Right away they say you are trying to hide something from them. Everything is a conspiracy. 'We have the right to read and learn from anything we want.' It used to be you had to put effort into finding other teachers, and a pastor who had been saved for decades and approved by a sending church had standing. But now, thanks to the internet, you can find all kinds of experts to tickle all your fancies. With the man in our assembly, it got to a point where he was bringing his smart phone and computer to church and looking up the texts we were using in real time. Then he would raise his hand and contradict me by quoting the internet teacher. Even though I could answer the childish and shallow arguments, he gave more credence to the online teachers. We threw him out. You want booze, we have a teacher for that. You want to be a pastor without meeting the qualifications, we have a teacher for that. You want to have women leaders, we have a teacher for that. You want to stop separating, we have a teacher for that. You think your pastor is a bad guy, we have a teacher for that. Anything you want, we have a teacher for that. This is one of the worst parts of new technology. It puts every heretic right at your fingertips."

"In my experience and opinion, very few Christians are mature enough in the Lord to be on social media. Social media is (along with many other things) a one-world church tool that promotes unbiblical doctrines and heresies through the use of peer pressure and exposure to philosophy of the world. It is a place where one can trust in the world's understanding and reason. It is a place where the individual can gather agreement for anything he or she wants to believe or promote from the smorgas-

bord of views. Do 'born again believers' not know the wiles of the devil?"

"I firmly believe that the internet along with social media is the chief aid in the fulfillment of 2 Timothy 3:7, 'Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.' The foundational issue is that the average professing Christian is Biblically ignorant. They know just enough to be a danger to themselves and everyone around them. They are too lazy to read their Bibles and study hard after the truth which in turn means they won't be testing everything by it."

"While we are all concerned for apathetic, carnal young people who are tempted by the allurements of the world, there also exists a danger for those young Christians who are enthusiastic in their pursuit of God. A 'novice' who is spiritually immature and has 'zeal of God, but not according to knowledge,' may be easily blown about be 'every wind of doctrine' if the local church does not fulfill its responsibility in 'the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ' (Eph. 4:12-14). We have seen several cases of young people who wish to learn more about God going to the internet for their spiritual teaching and being deceived by false teachers. There are many Calvinist pastors and hyper-

dispensationalist teachers who can sound very convincing to someone who does not have a solid foundation in the Scriptures. We understand that in the end every person must make his choice, and there will be some who 'will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables' (2 Ti. 4:3-4). But the local church must do everything it can to provide opportunities for spiritual growth that will help young Christians to become established in the faith. This must include solid preaching from the pulpit, personal discipleship, and other church events which emphasize Biblical principles more than just 'having fun' with other young people."

This danger makes it more imperative than ever that churches educate their people well in doctrinal dangers and provide sound resource material in libraries and bookstores and on the church's website.

The most important way of victory is to make all of the Lord's people serious and effectual Bible students. The equivalent of a Bible institute education is the very beginning of being the Bible student that can protect himself from error.

GOD IS LOVE ~ "BUT THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT IS LOVE..." (GALATIANS 5:22). By David Cloud

The following is excerpted from John Phillips' commentary on Galatians:

He said, 'Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great

Love! It is the sum and substance of the Christian life. It all began with love. Love flooded this sin-cursed planet even before Adams fateful fall. The Old Testament prophet first picks up and then puts down that great word from God: 'Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee' (Jer. 31:3). ...

The gospel begins on the same high note. Never have greater words been penned than these: 'God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life' (John 3:16).

Well might we sing Frederick M. Lehman's hymn 'The Love of God':

Could we with ink the ocean fill,
And were the skies of parchment made,
Were every stalk of earth a quill,
And every man a scribe by trade,
To write the love of God above,
Would drain the ocean dry.
Nor could the scroll contain the whole,
Though stretched from sky to sky."

'God is love' (1 John 4:8). Jesus came to demonstrate the truth of that declaration. He exhibited love as a babe, as a boy, as a teenager, and as a man. He manifested love in the home, in the classroom, on the playground, in the synagogue, and at the workbench. He revealed love when tramping the highway, when on the sea, and when in the temple. Ever and always, He displayed this one great truth about God: God is love. He displayed it with every breath He breathed. He demonstrated love in action in a particularly memorable, undiluted, down-to-earth way. There was never a road too rough, never a way too long, never an appeal too faint, never a case too hard, never a sob too late, and never a day too long for His love. Now it was an aristocratic Pharisee coming to Him in the dead of night, then it was a wicked woman at a wayside well at high noon. Now it was a dead little girl, then a demon-possessed little boy. Now it was a loathsome leper, then a woman with an issue of blood. Now it was Nathanael under a fig tree, then it was Zacchaeus up a sycamore tree. Now it was a wedding that had run out of wine, then it was a funeral and a woman who had been robbed of her only son. Now it was a publican, next a peer of the realm. Now it was a hungry multitude, then some frightened disciples in the grip of a howling gate. Always, love found a way to dry the tears and calm the fears.

Love! The word breathed through His teaching. He summarized all 613 commandments of the Mosaic Law in the one word--love!

He said, 'Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets' (Mt. 22:37-40). He said to His disciples, 'A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another' (John 13:34). But He demanded even more: 'I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you' (Mt. 5:44).

Impossible? Not for Him. He loved poor, lost Herod, self-seeking Annas, crafty Caiaphas, and weak and wavering Pilate. He loved them enough to die for them. He loved Peter even as he cursed and swore and denied Him. He loved Judas even as he planted the traitor's kiss on His cheek. He loved the man who punched Him in the face, the man who crowned Him with thorns, the man who smote Him on the head with a reed, and the man who plowed His back with a scourge. He loved the soldier who dropped that heavy cross upon His lacerated back and commanded Him to get going. He loved the men who nailed Him to that tree. He loved the very men who mocked Him as He died: 'Father, forgive them,' He said (Luke 23:34). What love. 'Love that no tongue can teach, Love that no thought can reach; No love like His. God is its blessed source, Death ne'er can stop its course, Nothing can stay its force; Matchless it is.'

"Now then, says Paul, 'The fruit of the Spirit is love.' It is the love that 'many waters cannot quench' (Song 8:7), the love that 'suffers long and is kind' (1 Co. 13:4), the love that 'will not let [me] go' (Song 3:4), and the love that is 'strong as death' (Song 8:6). Impossible? Of course, it is impossible to us. But it is gloriously possible to the Holy Spirit. Indeed, that is one of His New Testament titles--He is called 'the spirit... of love' (2 Ti. 1:7).

Let us remind ourselves afresh how the Lord Jesus, as Man, lived His life on earth. He did not live His matchless life in the power of His own deity, although He could have done so because He was never less than God. He allowed the love of God His Father to flow through Him as electrical current flows through a wire, in touch with the power at one end and the need at the other end. As a result, the supernatural, sublime, and superlative love of God flowed through the Lord Jesus at all times, in all places, and under all circumstances.

That same love is to flow through the believer in the same way by means of the Holy Spirit. We cannot manufacture it; neither can the flesh imitate it. The flesh, indeed, can exhibit what it calls love, but it is flawed at best. True love is of God, for God is love. In contrast with the 'works of the flesh' is this glorious fruit of the Spirit' (John Phillips, Galatians).

DIGGING IN THE WALLS

God commanded the prophet Ezekiel to dig in the walls of Israel's temple and observe the evils being done in secret by apostate religious leaders of that day. "Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall ... And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. So I went in and saw. ..." (Ezek. 8:7-10).

Ezekiel was then instructed to preach against the errors of the leaders and to tell the people the things he had witnessed.

"Therefore prophesy against them, prophesy, O son of man. ... Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the Lord had shewed me" (Ezek. 11:4,25).

The hour in which we live is very similar to that of Ezekiel's day. Many of those who profess to be the people of God are apostate. It was prophesied in the New Testament Scriptures that such would be the case in the closing hours of our age. This will culminate in the brief worldwide rule of an utterly apostate Harlot "church" (2 Tim. 3-4; 1 Tim. 4; 2 Pet. 2-3; Jude; Rev. 17).

As in Ezekiel's day much of the apostasy of our hour is hidden from the view of the average Christian. We intend by God's grace to "dig in the walls" of modern ecumenism and to expose and cry out against the things we find. In this section we also report on secular events which are relevant to Christians. May God give us ears to hear, minds to understand, and hearts to obey. Is the truth of God not worthy of defense?



THE POPE THE FABLE MAN

- The prophesy of apostate Christianity in 2 Timothy emphasizes fables, and the Roman Catholic pope is the chief fable man. "And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables" (2 Ti. 4:4). The latest fable to be adopted by the pope is the fable of manmade global warming. On Oct. 1, Pope Leo blessed a block of melting ice as he participated in the Raising Hope for Climate Justice conference at Castel Gandolfo. The press release said the event was "a sign of the urgency of the climate crisis, marked by the hope carried through the Pope's blessing." Leo is following in the steps of Pope Francis, who in 2015 published Laudato Si, "which stressed the urgency of the climate crisis and the need for swift and unified global action." It is easy for popes to believe fables. They are described in 2 Timothy 3:13 as "deceiving and being deceived." The papacy itself is a gigantic fable (e.g., Successor of the Prince of the Apostles, sitting on Peter's throne and possessing Peter's keys, the Vicar of Christ, Pontiff. **Pontifex** Supreme Maximus, Summus Pontifex, Holy Father, His Holiness). Rome's Mary is a fable (e.g., Immaculate Concep-

tion, Perpetual Virginity, Assumption. Advocate, Benefactress, Co-Redemptrix, Protectress, Mediatrix of all grace, Our Lady of Angels, New Eve, Queen of Peace, Queen of Heaven, Marian apparitions). Other papal fables include Apostolic Succession, Transubstantiation, the Real Presence, Extreme Unction, Auricular Confession, Penance, Indulgences, Infant Baptism, Baptismal Regeneration, College of Cardinals, Intercession of Saints, Ex Cathedra Infallibility, Semper Eadem (always the same), Rosary, Scapulars, Donation of Constantine (said to be the greatest fraud in history), Decretals of Isidore, Purgatory, the True Cross, Stigmata, Veneration of Relics, and the Treasury of Merit. Anyone who joins hands with the Roman Catholic Church and treats the Pope as anything other than an arch heretic, deceiver, and blasphemer is in open disobedience to God's Word. This includes a large majority of evangelical leaders and contemporary Christian musicians. See Romans 16:17; 2 Corinthians 6:14-18; 2 Timothy 3:5; 2 John 1:9-11.

one of the primary pipelines to porn addiction for both children and young adults. Global Witness, a campaign organization that investigates the impact of Big Tech on human rights, recently conducted a number of tests to determine how quickly children could access pornography on social media platforms. According to Guardian, Global Witness the conducted one test before the implementation of the U.K.'s Online Safety Act in July, and one after. In just a few clicks, TIKTOK directed children's accounts to pornography. ... I have encountered countless young people who were first exposed to pornographic material on social media; many teenagers have told me that INSTAGRAM is a key on-ramp into pornography. If they so much as pause for a fraction of a second as they scroll past a sexually explicit image, the pause is detected by the algorithm, and more sexual content is pushed into their feed. That content escalates in explicitness, and the algorithm almost literally reels them in with a conveyor belt of sexual imagery. ... Many young men successfully had who freed themselves from pornography have told me that going onto Instagram relapses into caused addiction. **SNAPCHAT** is better. no Pornography is easily accessible within five clicks without ever leaving the app. The National Centre on Sexual Exploitation has been urging parents to keep children off of Snapchat for years, and lists the social media app as one of the worst offenders on its annual 'Dirty Dozen' list."

CONTEMPORARY MUSIC ARTIST ADMITS HE IMITATES THE WORLD (Friday Church News Notes, October 24, 2025, www.wayoflife.org



fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - Forrest Frank, popular contemporary Christian music artist, testified on Instagram recently that imitates the world. Christians it's hard to know where the line in the sand is between being in the world but not of the world. And as a Christian artist, you know, I dress kind of like the world. I kind of look like the world. My music can kind of sound like the world." He went on to say that he would no longer accept awards or attend awards ceremonies, such as the Dove or Grammys, because he "will not receive a trophy for something that is from Jesus and for Jesus." He needs to go a lot farther than that. As he admitted, everything about contemporary Christian music is worldly. It is worldly in appearance and sound. Scripture answers the question. Where is the line between being in the world and not of the world? It is to not be conformed to the evil things of the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life (1 John 2:15-17). That is a perfect definition of the filthy pop culture. The world's fashion is designed by rebels. It is unisex, immodest, narcissistic, slovenly. The "sound" of pop music--the

relentless back beat, the unresolving chord sequences, the crooning, the breathy whispering, the scooping and flipping, the vocal fry or popcorning--was created to proclaim a lifestyle of live as you please. Sensuality permeates every aspect of the music. Pop singers contort their voices and slip and slide around the notes because they have rejected absolute truth. Whether they are conscious of it or not, their singing style reflects the philosophy of moral relativism which permeates modern pop music. From its inception, the sound of pop music (e.g., ragtime, boogy woogy, blues, jazz, rock) has been a sensual dance sound, a barroom sound, a gambling den sound, a worldly party sound. It is a sound that is the opposite of holy and sacred and spiritual (Eph. 5:18-19; Col. 3:16). Sacred music is not fitting for a barroom, and barroom music is not fitting for the house of God. Contemporary Christian musicians will answer to God for being conformed to the world and influencing professing Christians toward worldliness. Contemporary Christian Music is a major element of end-time apostasy, which is a "live according to your lusts" Christianity (2 Timothy 4:3-4).

TURKEY EXPELS FOREIGN CHRISTIANS (Friday Church News Notes, October 24, 2025, www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143)

Oct. 17, 2025: "ADF International reports that since 2020, at least 200 foreign Christian workers and their families. totaling about 350 individuals, have been barred from entering or remaining in Turkey under the Ministry of Interior's internal security codes N-82 and G-87. The organization explained that the codes are used to deny residence permits or prevent re-entry often without charges or evidence of criminal wrongdoing. Those affected include citizens of the United States, the United Kingdom, Germany, South Korea, several Latin American nations. and various European countries, many of whom have been denied visas or deported in recent years. A June 8 ruling by Turkey's Constitutional Court dismissed an appeal from nine foreign Christians challenging the N-82 designation. The court's decision publicly listed their names, leading local media to brand them as missionaries and enemies of the state. Following the publication, online commenters reportedly called for the death penalty and referred to killing them as a religious obligation."

QUEBEC COURT ALLOWS THREE-MAN 'THROUPLE" TO ADOPT 3-YEAR-OLD GIRL (Friday Church News Notes, October 24, 2025, www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) - The following is excerpted from



"Quebec Court," The Bridgehead, Oct. 2, 2025: "April, a Quebec Superior Court iudge ruled that 'multi-parent families,' like 'throuples'--three people living in a loosely defined sexual relationship-should be granted the same rights as 'any other unit.' By 'unit,' the judge was referring to what we once recognized as the natural family: a father, mother, and their children. Social conservatives predicted that if the natural family was legally redefined by same-sex 'marriage,' it would open the door to the legal recognition of an ever-expanding number of sexual relationships. Once law was unhitched from reality, all limiting principles would be removed. At the time, social conservatives were mocked as bigots. But as the judge put it: 'limiting the legal affiliation of children to or two parents unconstitutional.' ... Meanwhile, the LGBT movement has such a vise grip on Canada's establishment that not a single federal politician or mainstream media commentator has bothered to protest--or even point out why this is wrong."

INCHWORM STRATEGY (Friday Church Notes, News October 24. 2025. www.wayoflife.org fbns@wayoflife.org, 866-295-4143) The following from CreationMoments.com, Sept. 25, 2025: "Some creatures simply try to uninteresting to hungry predators. Others take their roleplaying so seriously that they actually fulfill some of the same roles as their models. Loopers, or inchworms, move along the ground, or branches with twigs characteristic opening and closing of an upside-down letter U. These creatures are not true worms. Rather,



they are caterpillars. As caterpillars, they often look very much like the twigs or branches on which they move. However, their odd form of movement can give them away. Here's an experiment you can try. If you ever notice a looper on a branch, simply give the branch a gentle tap. Chances are, the looper will suddenly freeze into the same shape as a nearby twig. If you were to carefully touch the looper, you would find that it had become as stiff as a twig. A botanist reports that while studying one looper moving along a branch, an ant happened along. Ants, of course, will eat loopers. The looper froze in a horizontal position between branches. The ant walked across the looper, never noticing that its walkway was actually a potential meal. Many scientists suggest that the looper 'just happens' to be the same color as the branches on which it crawls. We ask, does it also accidentally know how to act like a twig to fool predators? The almighty hand of God is evident even in the inchworm! Ref: 'The looper-inching along from one disguise to another,' National Geographic."

Charles, who is the titular head of the Church of England, and Camilla sat in golden thrones on the raised altar of the Sistine Chapel, in front of Michelangelo's 'Last Judgment,' while Leo and the Anglican archbishop of York presided over an ecumenical service. The event marked the first time since the Reformation that the heads of the two Christian churches. divided for centuries over issues that now include the ordination of female priests, have prayed together. ... Anglicans split from the Catholic Church in 1534 when English King Henry VIII was refused a marriage annulment. While popes for decades have forged warm relations with the Church of England and the broader Anglican Communion on a path toward greater unity, the two churches remain divided. ... Later Thursday, Charles was also to formally receive a new title and recognition at a pontifical basilica that has strong, traditional ties to the Church of England, St. Paul's

Outside the Walls. 





- The following is excerpted from "New technology," World Israel News, Sept. 29, 2025: "A team of Israeli researchers has developed a breakthrough that could transform archaeology: the ability to map underground spaces without digging, Tel Aviv University announced on Monday. The university's scientists demonstrated that cosmic radiation detectors, which measure muons-subatomic particles produced when cosmic rays collide with Earth's atmosphere--can reveal hidden voids beneath ancient sites, offering a way to explore subterranean structures safely and efficiently. ... The research team, led by Prof. Erez Etzion of the Raymond and Beverly Sackler School of Physics and demonstrated Astronomy, the technology at Jeremiah's Cistern at the City of David archaeological site in Jerusalem. Using muon detectors, the team produced detailed images of underground features, including tunnels and cisterns, based on how soil absorbs cosmic radiation. The team's study was recently published in the peer-reviewed Journal of Applied Physics. ... 'The muon shower hits the ground at a fixed and known rate,' explained Prof. Etzion. 'Muons can penetrate much deeper than other particles, losing energy slowly as they pass through rock. Empty cavities allow more muons through, so by monitoring the muons, we can pinpoint voids. It's like X-ray imaging: the muons are

the X-ray beam, the underground voids are the bones, and our detectors act as the camera."

Garcia said Sewell became withdrawn and isolated in the months prior to his death, as they would later find out he was speaking with a Character.AI bot modeled after fictional Game of Thrones



character Daenerys Targaryen. '[The AI bot] initiated romantic and sexual conversations with Sewell over several months and expressed a desire for him to be with her. On the day Sewell took his life, his last interaction was not with his mother, not with his father, but with an AI chatbot on Character.AI.' Similarly, Maria Raine, the mother of Adam Raine, 16, who died by suicide in April, alleges in a lawsuit that her son ended his life after ChatGPT 'coached him to suicide.' ... Josh Hawley, R-Mo., a former said prosecutor. that if companies were human beings conducting the same kind of activity, which he described as 'grooming,' he would prosecute them. Richard Blumenthal, D-Conn., added he believes big tech is 'using our children as guinea pigs in a hightech, high-stakes experiment to make their industry more profitable."


