CHATGPT LIES: FAKE GOVERNORS AND FAKE LEGAL BRIEFS



The following is excerpted from "AI Makes Up," PowerLineBlog, May 28, 2023: "This is the most interesting thing I have come across in a very long time. Artificial intelligence (or, at least, the ChatGPT program) makes stuff up. ... Tony Venhuizen, a smart guy from South Dakota, operates a web site where he writes about the history of the governors of that state. He asked ChatGPT, 'Please write a blog post discussing South Dakota's oldest and youngest governors.' ChatGPT responded with a competent description of South Dakota's oldest governor, Nils Boe. It then went on to write five paragraphs about the state's youngest governor, Crawford H. 'Chet' Taylor. ... Remarkably, however, Crawford H. 'Chet' Taylor is entirely a figment of ChatGPT's imagination. Tony Vanhuisen wrote: 'Crawford H. Chet Taylor was never Governor of South Dakota and, in fact, I can

CHATGPT SLANDERS

The following is excerpted from "ChatGPT Invented," Washington Post, April 5, 2023: "One night last week, the law professor Jonathan Turley got a troubling email. As part of a research study, a fellow lawyer in California had asked the AI chatbot ChatGPT to generate a list of legal scholars who had sexually harassed someone. Turley's name was on the list. The chatbot, created by OpenAI, said Turley had made sexually suggestive comments and attempted to touch a student while on a class trip to Alaska, citing a March 2018 article in The Washington Post as the source of the information. The problem: No such article existed. There had never been a class trip to Alaska. And Turley said he'd never been accused of harassing a student. A regular commentator in the media, Turley had sometimes asked for corrections in news stories. But this time, there was no journalist or editor to call--and no way to correct the record. ... As largely unregulated

artificial intelligence software such as ChatGPT, Microsoft's Bing and Google's Bard begins to be incorporated across the web, its propensity to generate potentially damaging falsehoods raises concerns about the spread of misinformation--and novel questions about who's responsible when chatbots mislead. ... On Wednesday, Reuters reported that Brian Hood, regional mayor of Hepburn Shire in Australia, is threatening to file the first defamation lawsuit against OpenAI unless it corrects false claims that he had served time in prison for bribery."

find no evidence of such a person, at all.' ... AI even produced a fake portrait of the fake governor. ... I came across the second instance last night via InstaPundit. Some lawyers in New York relied on AI, in the form of ChatGPT, to help them write a brief opposing a motion to dismiss based on the statute of limitations. ChatGPT *made up cases, complete with quotes and citations*, to support the lawyers' position. The presiding judge was not amused. ... The lawyers are in deep trouble. I think this is absolutely stunning. ChatGPT ... knows how to write something that reads more or less like a court decision, and to include within that decision citations to cases that on their face seem to support the brief's argument. But instead of carrying out these functions with greater or lesser skill, as one would expect, the program *makes stuff up* ... The most obvious explanation is that ChatGPT fabricates information in response to queries just for fun, or out of a sense of perversity."

GROUNDBREAKING RESEARCH PROVES PLANTS TALK

The following is excerpted from "Pop! Snap!" *NoCamels*, May 24, 2023: "For the first time ever, Israeli researchers have been able to prove that plants do indeed make noise. They picked up the popcorn-like popping sounds-which are normally beyond the hearing range of the human ear--using ultrasonic microphones. This discovery changes our understanding of the natural world, and there is much the researchers from Tel Aviv University have yet to understand. Specifically, who or what is listening to these noises, and why. And with this discovery, there is the potential to monitor whether a plant is struggling against an unseen pathogen and prevent it from spreading to an entire field, without intrusive action. Farmers may also be able to more effectively water their crops and apply insecticides. ... The



sounds the plants make vary from species to species, and are different in noise and frequency depending on the kind of stress they are under--for example when they are dehydrated, have been cut, or are infected with a virus. ... The plants emit sounds ranging between 40 and 80 kilohertz--completely out of the human hearing, which is up to 16 kilohertz. ... Expensive and sensitive recording equipment was used to capture the sounds for the first time. ... The study mainly focused on tomato and tobacco plants, but wheat, corn, cactus, and henbit (a close cousin of purple dead nettles) were also recorded. ... What Prof. Lilach Hadany, of the School of Plant Sciences and Food Security now wants to figure out now is who or what is using the information contained within the sounds, and who or what is benefiting from it. ... 'One group could be animals, like a moth laying eggs,' she says. 'It could choose between a plant emitting sounds and a plant that does not. 'The second [direction of our research] is possibly that plants may be responding to these sounds too, and preparing themselves for stress by using water more efficiently, closing their stomata [pores], and putting up a global defense against pathogens,' she says.'

CHRISTIAN POLITICIAN WINS LARGE PAY-OUT OVER FIRING BY EMPLOYER FOR HER VIEWS ON MARRIAGE

The following is excerpted from "Victory pay-out," Premier Christian News, May 2, 2023: "A Christian politician has won a substantial pay-out after she was fired by her employer for expressing her religious views on marriage online and in her

electoral manifesto. Maureen Martin--mayoral candidate for Lewisham in 2022--was sacked by London & Quadrant Housing Trust (L&Q) for gross misconduct following three complaints of 'hate speech'. The ordained minister was hounded on social media in April 2022, after stating as part of her manifesto that 'natural marriage between a man and a woman is the fundamental building block for a successful society, and the safest environment for raising children,' ahead of local elections last year. ... Speaking on Premier's News Hour Martin

explains that: 'it was the people that were unhappy with my statement that put it on Twitter, and they sort of started to troll me as it were, and make really horrible comments about me. So they made the complaint. And my employer then saw it fit to accuse me of being homophobic, and of discrimination against the LGBTQ+ community. ... They fired me, I knew they would ... I've always determined that from the very outset, I would not apologise, because as far as I'm concerned, I've been

> discriminated against because of my Christian faith. Not because I was a politician. ... With the support of the Christian Legal Centre (CLC), Martin launched legal action against L&Q arguing that her dismissal was discriminatory and in breach of her right to political speech. ... Martin said, 'It does highlight the fact you have to challenge these views, you have to challenge the judgement, you have to challenge what has happened to you, you can't just walk away. If you don't challenge, nothing's going to happen--you have to put them in a position where they have to now

make a decision. You can fire me but you can't silence me. Quite frankly, I'm now free from the shackles of 'woke' employers, of the danger of being persecuted by an employer threatening to take my livelihood because they don't like what I say.""
